This morning/afternoon, we'd like to see the title of “Noah” in Genesis 6:1-22

Q1. In verse 2, “that the sons of God saw the daughters of men, that they *were* beautiful; and they took wives for themselves of all whom they chose,” who are the sons of God?

Q2. In verse 3, “And the LORD said, “My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, for he *is* indeed flesh; yet his days shall be one hundred and twenty years,” what does the period of 120 years mean?

Q3. In verse 9, “This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a just man, perfect in his generations. Noah walked with God,” what does it mean that Noah was a just & perfect man?

(Background) Genesis = Chapter 1 (Creation) + Chapter 2 (Creation in details including Adam/Eve) + Chapter 3 (Sin) + Chapter 4 (Human History began) -----the last entire Bible (redemptive history through Jesus)

1 st day (Sunday) 1:3 “light”	4 th day (Wed) 1:16 “2 great lights (Sun & Moon), Stars”	7 th day (Sabbath) 2:2 “rest”

<p><u>hundred and twenty years.</u>”</p> <p>⁴ There were <u>giants</u> on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when <u>the sons of God came in to the daughters of men</u> and they bore <i>children</i> to them. Those <i>were</i> the mighty men who <i>were</i> of old, men of renown.</p> <p>⁵ Then the LORD saw <u>that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually.</u> ⁶ And the LORD was <u>sorry</u> that He had made man on the earth, and He was grieved in His heart. ⁷ So the LORD said, “<u>I will destroy man</u> whom I have created from the face of the earth, both man and beast, creeping thing and birds of the air, for I am sorry that I have made them.” ⁸ But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.</p> <p>⁹ This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was <u>a just man, perfect</u> in his generations. Noah walked with God. ¹⁰ And Noah begot three sons: <u>Shem, Ham, and Japheth.</u></p> <p>¹¹ The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence. ¹² So God looked upon the earth, and indeed it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted their way on the earth.</p> <p>¹³ And God said to Noah, “The end of all flesh has come before Me, for the earth is filled with violence through them; and behold, I will destroy them with the earth.</p> <p>¹⁴ Make yourself an ark of gopherwood; make rooms in the ark, and cover it inside and outside with <u>pitch.</u> ¹⁵ And this is how you shall make it: The length of the ark <u>shall be three hundred cubits</u>, its width <u>fifty cubits</u>, and its height <u>thirty cubits.</u> ¹⁶ You shall make <u>a window</u> for the ark, and you shall finish it to a cubit from above; and set the door of the ark in its side. <p>earth shall die. ¹⁸ But I will establish <u>My covenant</u> with you; and you shall go into the ark—you, your sons, your wife, and your sons' wives with you.</p> <p>¹⁹ And of every living thing of all flesh you shall bring two of every <i>sort</i> into the ark, to <u>keep <i>them</i> alive with you; they shall be male and female.</u> ²⁰ Of the birds after their kind, of animals after their kind, and of every creeping thing of the earth after its kind, two of every <i>kind</i> will come to you to keep <i>them</i> alive. ²¹ And you shall take for yourself of all food that is eaten, and you shall gather <i>it</i> to yourself; and it shall be food for you and for them.”</p> <p>²² Thus Noah did; according to <u>all that God commanded him, so he did.</u></p>	<p>18= My covenant (~ promise) * Genesis 9:8-17; 12:1-3; 15:17-18</p> <p>19= keep <i>them</i> alive with you; they shall be male and female (Dinosaurs occurred 2 million years ago or 6,000 years ago? = the Piluxi River in Texas = footprints of both men & Dinosaurs <= were probably not in the ark.</p>

2=Q1= the sons of God ((1) fallen angels; (2) righteous man) * (1) Job 1:6; (2) Acts 17:28-29; Genesis 4:26; Mark 12:25

- (1) Angels: (Fallen Angels) Job 1:6 “Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came among them.” (devils= fallen angels)
- (2) Men: (Righteous man = godly line of Seth) <= ungodly line of Cain

Acts 17:28-29 “for in Him we live and move and have our being, as also some of your own poets have said, ‘For we are also His offspring.’ ²⁹ Therefore, since we are the offspring of God, we ought not to think that the Divine Nature is like gold or silver or stone, something shaped by art and man’s devising”

Genesis 4:26 “And as for Seth, to him also a son was born; and he named him Enosh. Then *men* began to call on the name of the LORD.” (with “the daughters of men” i.e., ungodly line of Cain)

Mark 12:25 “For when they rise from the dead, they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven.” (God doesn’t want angles to reproduce; Jesus didn’t say the angels didn’t have a sexual capacity.)

3= Q2=one hundred and twenty years (divine waiting period to repent) * 1 Peter 3:20

“who formerly were disobedient, when once the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while *the* ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water.”

4= giants [Nephiylim] * Numbers 13:33; 1 Samuel 17:4 =the sons of God came in to the daughters of men (fallen angels/ godly line of Seth → women/ ungodly line of Cain

(Numbers 13:33) There we saw the giants (the descendants of Anak came from the giants); and we were like grasshoppers in our own sight, and so we were in their sight.”

(1 Samuel 17:4) “And a champion went out from the camp of the Philistines, named Goliath, from Gath, whose height *was* six cubits and a span.” cubit (the distance from your elbow to the tip of your finger; span (the length from your thumb to your finger) (2 spans = 1 cubit = 1.5 ft) => 9~10 feet

5= every intent of the thoughts of his heart *was* only evil continually * Galatians 6:7-8

“Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. ⁸ For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life.”

6= sorry [sorrow] != regret * 1 Samuel 15:29 (for their sins)

“And also the Strength of Israel will not lie nor relent. For He *is* not a man, that He should relent.” (for mistake creation? < their evil)

9= Q3 = a just man, perfect * Genesis 9:20-21; Romans 1:17

(Genesis 9:20-21) “And Noah began *to be* a farmer, and he planted a vineyard. ²¹ Then he drank of the wine and was drunk, and became uncovered in his tent.”

(Romans 1:17) For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, “The just shall live by faith.”

18= My covenant (~ promise) * Genesis 9:8-17; 12:1-3; 15:17-20

(9:8-17) Then God spoke to Noah and to his sons with him, saying: ⁹“And as for Me, behold, I establish My covenant with you and with your descendants after you, ¹⁰ and with every living creature that *is* with you: the birds, the cattle, and every beast of the earth with you, of all that go out of the ark, every beast of the earth. ¹¹ Thus I establish My covenant with you: Never again shall all flesh be cut off by the waters of the flood; never again shall there be a flood to destroy the earth.”¹² And God said: “This *is* the sign of the covenant which I make between Me and you, and every living creature that *is* with you, for perpetual generations: ¹³ I set My rainbow in the cloud, and it shall be for the sign of the covenant between Me and the earth. ¹⁴ It shall be, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the rainbow shall be seen in the cloud; ¹⁵ and I will remember My covenant which *is* between Me and you and every living creature of all flesh; the waters shall never again become a flood to destroy all flesh. ¹⁶ The rainbow shall be in the cloud, and I will

look on it to remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that *is* on the earth.”¹⁷ And God said to Noah, “This *is* the sign of the covenant which I have established between Me and all flesh that *is* on the earth.”

(12:1-3) Now the LORD had said to Abram:

“Get out of your country,
 From your family
 And from your father’s house,
 To a land that I will show you.
²I will make you a great nation;
 I will bless you
 And make your name great;
 And you shall be a blessing.
³I will bless those who bless you,
 And I will curse him who curses you;
 And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

(15:17-18) And it came to pass, when the sun went down and it was dark, that behold, there appeared a smoking oven and a burning torch that passed between those pieces.¹⁸ On the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying:“To your descendants I have given this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the River Euphrates—
