Q1. In 21:1, "If someone is found slain, lying in a field in the land the LORD your God is giving you to possess, and it is not known who the killer was," what does it mean in the context? And what kind of divine nature can we observe here? And how can we the Christians apply it to our lives?

Q2. In 22:1, "If you see your fellow Israelite's ox or sheep straying, do not ignore it but be sure to take it back to its owner," what did God want from Israel? And how can we apply it to our lives?

Q3. In 22:9, "Do not plant two kinds of seed in your vineyard; if you do, not only the crops you plant but also the fruit of the vineyard will be defiled," what did God want from Israel? And how can we apply it to our lives?

(Background for context of this text on Daily Bible Reading and Studying Weekly Book Basis)

In the last time, in Deuteronomy 20:19-20, "When you besiege a city for a long time, while making war against it to take it, you shall not destroy its trees by wielding an ax against them; if you can eat of them, do not cut them down to use in the siege, for the tree of the field *is* man's *food.* ²⁰ Only the trees which you know *are* not trees for food you may destroy and cut down, to build siegeworks against the city that makes war with you, until it is subdued," God taught Israelites the conqueror to besiege a city for a long time; don't cut down fruit trees because you may eat the fruit for food but cut down only fruitless tree and use it with weapons for the war until the city is conquered.

¹ Eph 1:9-10 having made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purposed in

hold your people guilty of the blood of an innocent person." Then the bloodshed will be atoned for, ⁹ and you will have purged from yourselves the guilt of shedding innocent blood, since you have done what is right in the eyes of the LORD.	
¹⁰ When you go to war against your enemies and the LORD your God delivers them into your hands and you take captives, ¹¹ if you notice among the captives a beautiful woman and are attracted to her, you may take her as your wife. ¹² Bring her into your home and have her shave her head, trim her nails ¹³ and put aside the clothes she was wearing when captured. After she has lived in your house and mourned her father and mother for a full month, then you may go to her and be her husband and she shall be your wife. ¹⁴ If you are not pleased with her, let her go wherever she wishes. You must not sell her or treat her as a slave, since you have dishonored her.	10-14= (A captive woman from a war. If you want her to become your wife, let her weep for her parents for 1 month. You may make her your wife. Thereafter if you don't like her, make her a free woman, not a slave.)
¹⁵ If a man has two wives, and he loves one but not the other, and both bear him sons but the firstborn is the son of the wife he does not love, ¹⁶ when he wills his property to his sons, he must not give the rights of the firstborn to the son of the wife he loves in preference to his actual firstborn, the son of the wife he does not love. ¹⁷ He must acknowledge the son of his unloved wife as the firstborn by giving him a double share of all he has. That son is the first sign of his father's strength. The right of the firstborn belongs to him.	(15-17: A polygamist's actually first born son had the right of the first born, regardless of your love more for a wife; God intended a man to live with a woman on creation, but humans practiced polygamy. <i>Gen 2:24²</i>)
¹⁸ If someone has a stubborn and rebellious son who does not obey his father and mother and will not listen to them when they discipline him, ¹⁹ his father and mother shall take hold of him and bring him to the elders at the gate of his town. ²⁰ They shall say to the elders, "This son of ours is stubborn and rebellious. He will not obey us. He is a glutton and a drunkard." ²¹ Then all the men of his town are to stone him to death. You must purge the evil from among you. All Israel will hear of it and be afraid.	18-21=(A stubborn and rebellious son, e.g., a glutton/a drunkard, was subject to death penalty. Exemplary punishment before the public in Israel. It violated the 5 th commandment to honor your parents Ex 20:12 ³):

Himself, ¹⁰ that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth—in Him; *Col 2:16-17*-So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a festival or a new moon or sabbaths, ¹⁷ which are a shadow of things to come, but the substance is of Christ; *Isaiah 1:18* "Come now, and let us reason together," Says the LORD, "Though your sins are like scarlet, They shall be as white as snow;

Though they are red like crimson, They shall be as wool.; *Rom 12:1* I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your reasonable service.

service. ² Gen 2:24 Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.

³ *Ex 20:12* Honor your father and your mother, that your days may be long upon the land which the LORD your God is giving you.

²² If someone guilty of a capital offense is put to death and their body is exposed on a pole, ²³ you must not leave the body hanging on the pole overnight. Be sure to bury it that same day, because anyone who is hung on a pole is under God's curse. You must not desecrate the land the LORD your God is giving you as an inheritance.

¹If you see your fellow Israelite's ox or sheep straying, do not ignore it but be sure to take it back to its owner. ² If they do not live near you or if you do not know who owns it, take it home with you and keep it until they come looking for it. Then give it back. ³ Do the same if you find their donkey or cloak or anything else they have lost. Do not ignore it. ⁴ If you see your fellow Israelite's donkey or ox fallen on the road, do not ignore it. Help the owner get it to its feet.

⁵ A woman must not wear men's clothing, nor a man wear women's clothing, for the LORD your God detests anyone who does this.

⁶ If you come across a bird's nest beside the road, either in a tree or on the ground, and the mother is sitting on the young or on the eggs, do not take the mother with the young. ⁷ You may take the young, but be sure to let the mother go, so that it may go well with you and you may have a long life. 22-23= (Hanged body: It must not be left on the pole overnight. The hanged person on a pole is under God's curse. Jesus Christ redeemed us by bearing the curse of the law due to our sin on the cross – hanged Jesus on a pole; *Gal* $3:13^4$)

1-4=Q1(Lost/hurt thing: a finder should take a good custody of it until a true owner comes. It might be ox, sheep, donkey, cloak, or others. It is subject to 2nd the greatest commandment to love your neighbor as vourself, here neighbor's personal property. Today, you should take care of it reasonably but if you do it negligently, you'd be liable for your wrong Mark 12:31⁵)

5= (A woman should wear a woman's clothing, while a man should wear a man's clothing because our God is not the author of confusion or disorder but of peace on the creation of a man and a woman 1 Cor $14:3^{\circ}$)

6-7= (Care of wild animals: Take the young, not the mother. God wants the very good creatures world to be preserved. *Gen* $1:31^7$)

⁴ Gal 3:13 Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed *is* everyone who hangs on a tree"), ⁵ Mark 12:31 And the second, like *it*, *is* this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment

¹³ If a man takes a wife and, after sleeping with her, dislikes her ¹⁴ and slanders her and gives her a bad name, saying, "I married this woman, but when I approached her, I did not find proof of her virginity," ¹⁵ then the young woman's father and mother shall bring to the town elders at the gate proof that she was a virgin. ¹⁶ Her father will say to the elders, "I gave my daughter in marriage to this man, but he dislikes her. ¹⁷ Now he has slandered her and said, 'I did not find your daughter to be a virgin.' But here is the proof of my daughter's virginity." Then her parents shall display the cloth before the elders of the town, ¹⁸ and the elders shall take the man and punish him. ¹⁹ They shall fine him a hundred shekels of silver and give them to the vound woman's father, because this man has given an Israelite virgin a bad name. She shall continue to be his wife; he must not divorce her as long as he lives. ²⁰ If, however, the charge is true and no proof of the young woman's virginity can be found, ²¹ she shall be brought to the door of her father's house and there the men of her town shall stone her to death. She has done an outrageous thing in Israel by being promiscuous while still in her father's house. You must purge the evil from among you.

8= (a parapet, the wall attached to the edge of the flat roof of your house for safetv purpose against someone's falling from the roof)

9-11= (Don't mess up but keep whatever things are pure Phil 4:8⁸)

9=Q3 (Planting the 2 kinds of seed in your vineyard causes the mutual interference between the crops and the fruit of the vineyard)

10= (Unequal yoke between a tall ox and a short donkey would neither balance equally nor work well.)

11= (The mixing of wool and linen together creates an electrostatic phenomena, irritating you).

12= (tassels on the four corners of the cloak were required to remind of God. e.g. "the border of Jesus' garment" Luke 8:42-45⁹)

13-30= (Sexual morality to marriage)

13-21= (a husband raised his wife virginity issue - upon proof for virginity, he paid 100 shekels of silver to her father and kept her as his wife; Otherwise,

²³ If a man happens to meet in a town a virgin pledged to be married and he sleeps with her, ²⁴ you shall take both of them to the gate of that town and stone them to death—the young woman because she was in a town and did not scream for help, and the man because he violated another man's wife. You must purge the evil from among you.	22= (another man's sexual relationship with a married woman: Both were subject to death penalty, i.e., 7 th commandment against adultery <i>Ex 20:14</i> ¹¹) 23-24= (a betrothed woman or fiancée's
²⁵ But if out in the country a man happens to meet a young woman pledged to be married and rapes her, only the man who has done this shall die. ²⁶ Do nothing to the woman; she has committed no sin deserving death. This case is like that of someone who attacks and murders a neighbor, ²⁷ for the man found the young woman out in the country, and though the betrothed woman screamed, there was no one to rescue her.	sexual relationship with another man: Both were subject to death penalty) 25-27= (a raper to a fiancée: Only the raper was subject to death penalty. She was an innocent victim)
²⁸ If a man happens to meet a virgin who is not pledged to be married and rapes her and they are discovered, ²⁹ he shall pay her father fifty shekels of silver. He must marry the young woman, for he has violated her. He can never divorce her as long as he lives.	28-29=(mutual sexual relationship between a man and a woman: the man was subject to 50 shekels of silver penalty to her father and to marry her.)
³⁰ A man is not to marry his father's wife; he must not dishonor his father's bed.	30= (A man's sexual relationship with his father's wife: incest is prohibited. E.g. Reuben's incest with Jacob's 4 th wife <i>Gen</i> <i>35:22; Gen 49:4</i> ¹²)

Note: Most Christians say the Bible is important, but rarely study every word in the Bible and commit it to the Lord. So, it's better to study it and live accordingly after the Spirit for the Lord (2 Tim 2:15). This online word for global crusade in effect develops from the expositional sermon (KJV), into spiritual transformation in daily love fellowship with the Lord throughout the Bible Study (NKJV) -- *All Scripture Expositional Study from verse by verse Inductive Studies* -- of which application is the Discipleship and Spiritual Formation, closer to the image of Christ. power. The RSF, along with one Islamic commander, who believed that Allah sent him to murder and torture whoever stood in his way, decided to try and take Khartoum and the Nuba Mountains. He actually began killing people by burning them with fire. Along with many others, even one of our chaplains, Jaber, had five relatives murdered. The number of those killed in Khartoum has been estimated as high as 25,000. One young man had his face put in a frying pan and suffered severe injury; fortunately, he survived. People have snuck out during the night and tried to retrieve fallen loved ones for burial, but they, themselves, have been shot and wounded or killed. To serve as a warning, the RSF wanted to terrorize the people so they would not allow the bodies of those they murdered to be buried, causing a terrible stench. The South Sudan Army North realized that the Islamic commander and the RSF were coming to Nuba to start a new spree of killing and conquest. The RSF wanted to do what Hitler had done and wipe out an



entire race of people. The South Sudan Army North knew that all military outposts held by the Army of North Sudan would become a staging ground for the invasion of the Nuba Mountains. So, they launched preemptive strikes before it was too late.

Our chaplains number about 48 in the Nuba Mountains. They went with the Sudan People's Liberation Army North and attacked and took 11 military bases from the Islamic Sudan Army to protect the people. In the process, they captured six tanks and many military vehicles, along with large amounts of weapons and ammunition. In the process, they got everything except medical supplies.

The SPLA captured the Islamic commander and killed many of his soldiers. The civilian population was enraged because their relatives had been murdered, tortured, and raped. They took vengeance on this commander. His body was stripped and hung upside down. I saw photos of what was done to this man, and it was a terrible sight. But scripture was fulfilled in that he reaped what he had sown. Right now, in our village in Nimule, South Sudan, hunger is a real problem because of all the insecurity. People have not been able to cultivate for fear of rebels, who come and kill the men and abduct the women who are used as sex slaves. So Far Reaching Ministries (FRM) has purchased large quantities of beans and corn maize to feed the people, which is being distributed at

church on Sunday. The people are very grateful, but we have a need for more food and medical supplies. The medical supplies are for the Nuba mountains, and the food is for our village and the surrounding villages.



For about \$200, we

can give a family 100 pounds of beans and 150 pounds of corn maize, which will feed them for half a year.

FRM is also working on building a community farm. People in our village can work with our staff to grow food and be given a distribution, hopefully enough tofeed their families. We will station armed guards, so the people will not have any worry of abduction. But, until this is accomplished, we need help in feeding the families. For \$200, you can support a family to survive for six months. For \$1,000-five families, and \$10,000, you can feed 50 families. Food is very simple in South Sudan: corn maize and beans are what everyone wants, so that you can feed a lot of people for very little. I have also started having the staff provide lunch after church on Sunday mornings. Since starting this, church attendance has doubled because people are just hungry.

During the fighting, one of our chaplains was killed; he had graduated in class five and was extremely faithful to the Lord. He was First Lieutenant Ismail Khamis Kodi. From the time of his graduation, Ismail was given to the work of teaching the message of salvation to the military. A large military truck that Ismail was in was going over the mountains when the brakes gave out, and the vehicle rolled back and went off the side of the mountain. He was killed instantly, so he did not suffer. He leaves behind a wife and three daughters. Ismail worked in artillery and was considered the best man in the unit. Before Christ, he was addicted to opium, but someone told him that
