In verse 1, "And it happened, while Apollos was at Corinth, that Paul, having passed through the upper regions, came to Ephesus. And finding some disciples," explain the difference between Apollos' ministry at Corinth and here Paul's ministry at

Ephesus? And what can we learn from here?

Q2. In verse 2, "he said to them, 'Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?' So they said to him, 'We have not so much as heard whether there is a Holy Spirit," what does it mean in the context? And how can we apply it to our lives?

Q3. In verse 13, "Then some of the itinerant Jewish exorcists took it upon themselves to call the name of the Lord Jesus over those who had evil spirits, saying, 'We exorcise you by the Jesus whom Paul preaches," what can we see the hearts of the exorcists? And what can we learn here in the light of Jesus' teaching to the church of Ephesus on the book of Revelation?

(Background for context of this text on Daily Bible Reading and Studying Weekly Book Basis)

Paul was ministering here at Ephesus in his 3rd mission trip (Acts 18:23 – 21:16) from 53 to 57 AD when he wrote Galatians, 2 Corinthians, and Romans

In the last time, in Acts 18:24-28, "Now a certain Jew named Apollos, born at Alexandria, an eloquent man *and* mighty in the Scriptures, came to Ephesus. ²⁵ This man had been instructed in the way of the Lord; and being fervent in spirit, he spoke and taught accurately the things of the Lord, though he knew only the baptism of John. ²⁶ So he began to speak boldly in the synagogue. When Aquila and Priscilla heard him, they took him aside and explained to him the way of God more accurately. ²⁷ And when he desired to cross to Achaia, the brethren wrote, exhorting the disciples to receive him; and when he arrived, he greatly helped those who had believed through grace; ²⁸ for he vigorously refuted the Jews publicly, showing from the Scriptures that Jesus is the Christ." Apollos taught accurately the way of the Lord, i.e., the word of God in the gospel of Jesus Christ, at Ephesus, only with knowledge of the water baptism of John. But he learned from Aquila and Prisilla the way of God more accurately, i.e., baptism with the Holy Spirit. Then, he went to Corinth in Achaia region where Paul had taught the word of God in the gospel of Jesus Christ for 1.5 years in the light of 18:1,11, "¹ After these things Paul departed from Athens and went to Corinth. ¹¹ And he continued *there* a year and six months, teaching the word of God among them."

And finding some disciples	1= Q1 (Ephesus was the capital city in Minor Asia, with Alexandria in Egypt and Antioch in Syria. As stated above, Apollos instructed the way of the Lord, preached the gospel of Jesus Christ, or planted at Ephesus just with John's water baptism. So, some disciples the followers of Jesus, i.e., Christians, were found at Ephesus. But learning of the baptism with the Spirit from Aquila and Prisilla, Apollos taught the Scripture or watered at Corinth. Then, Paul began to teach the Scripture or water at Ephesus. So, we should go forward the whole scripture from the principles of the gospel to become more like Jesus. <i>1 Cor 3:61</i>)

They were not heard much of that because Apollos did not teach them of the baptism with the Spirit but John's water baptism only. The water baptism ceremony before the public signifies washing off sins with the word of God in the gospel or expressing repentance of unbelief and all the other sins for a baptized person to be a born-again Christian, i.e., conversion. The baptism with the Holy Spirit, as 1 st Fullness of the Holy Spirit called, causing one or continual empowering experiences, is separate from the conversion and subsequent to the conversion. (1) not only indwelling Spirit but also the fullness of the Spirit. Often the baptism with water by emersion, initiated from John the Baptist and absorbed in the name of Jesus, and the baptism with the Holy Spirit by laying hands in the name of Jesus have been conducted. With the power, we as witnesses to Jesus can minister in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and to the end of the earth. Both baptisms are conducted in the name of only one Jesus. A Christian is born again of water and the Spirit like a blowing wind. Through faith in the gospel of Jesus Christ, you call Jesus as the Lord who is in you and your body is the temple of the Spirit. such as wisdom, knowing hidden facts, healing faith,

tongue. We should not exercise any spiritual gifts for

heart will flow rivers of living water." ³⁹ But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet *given*, because Jesus was not yet glorified; *1 Cor 3:1-3*And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual *people* but as to carnal, as to babes in Christ. ² I fed you with milk and not with solid food; for until now you were not able *to receive it*, and even now you are still not able; ³ for you are still carnal. For where *there are* envy, strife, and divisions among you, are you not carnal and behaving like *mere* men?

³ Acts 8:5. 12-17⁵ Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria and preached Christ to them. ¹² But when they believed Philip as he preached the things concerning the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, both men and women were baptized. ¹³ Then Simon himself also believed; and when he was baptized he continued with Philip, and was amazed, seeing the miracles and signs which were done. ¹⁴ Now when the apostles who were at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent Peter and John to them, ¹⁵ who, when they had come down, prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit. ¹⁶ For as yet He had fallen upon none of them. They had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. ¹⁷ Then they laid hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit, Acts 9:4-5, 17-19⁴ Then he fell to the ground, and heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?"⁵ And he said, "Who are You, Lord?" Then the Lord said, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. ¹It *is* hard for you to kick against the goads. ¹⁷ And Ananias went his way and entered the house; and laying his hands on him he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, who appeared to you on the road as you came, has sent me that you may receive your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit." 18 Immediately there fell from his eyes something like scales, and he received his sight at once; and he arose and was baptized. ¹⁹ So when he had received food, he was strengthened. Then Saul spent some days with the disciples at Damascus; Acts 10:44-48 While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell upon all those who heard the word. ⁴⁵ And those of the circumcision who believed were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles also. ⁴⁶ For they heard them speak with tongues and magnify God. Then Peter answered, 47 "Can anyone forbid water, that these should not be baptized who have received the Holy Spirit just as we have?" ⁴⁸ And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord. Then they asked him to stay a few days.

¹⁴ Also there were seven sons of Sceva, a Jewish chief priest, who did so. ¹⁵ And the evil spirit answered and said, "Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are you?"¹⁶ Then the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, overpowered them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded. ¹⁷ This became known both to all Jews and Greeks dwelling in Ephesus; and fear fell on them all, and the name of the Lord Jesus was magnified. ¹⁸ And many who had believed came confessing and telling their deeds. ¹⁹ Also, many of those who had practiced magic brought their books together and burned them in

11-12 = (God worked unusual miracles both to heal the patients and to cast out evil spirit the gift of the Spirit by the hands of Paul. That is Paul received the spiritual gift of miracles from God. One believed that God was going to do it at the moment he could touch the handkerchiefs or aprons of Paul. At the touching moment, his faith was activated, with the sick body healed or the evil spirits cast out, called as active faith. Mostly faith is passive because most time faith is not fulfilled momently, e.g., Paul's faith to go to Rome in verse 21.)

13=Q3 (Jewish exorcists used the name of the Lord Jesus for their exorcism business against the word of God. God wants us undivided loyalty to Him. Ephesian Christians left the first love but they did not search where they fell, repent, and did accordingly. Today, there is no church in Ephesus, as the lampstand was removed from its place according to Jesus's statement... *Lev 20:27; Rev 2:1-5; Rev 1:20*⁷)

14-20= (Some Jewish exorcists tried to cast out the evil spirit with the use of Jesus name but were overpowered by the evil Spirit and ran away naked and wounded. Ephesians, both Jews and Greeks, feared of the Lord and lifted up the name of the Lord Jesus. Many believers spread these things of miracles and many magicians burned their books valued 50,000 pieces of silver, So, the word of the Lord spread mightily and prevailed over all the other spirits because the sword of the Spirit is the word of God *Eph* 6:17⁶)

⁷ Lev 20:27 A man or a woman who is a medium, or who has familiar spirits, shall surely be put to death; they shall stone them with stones. Their blood *shall be* upon them; *Rev 2:1-5* To the angel of the church of Ephesus write, 'These things says He who holds the seven stars in His right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands: ² "I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. The assembly of the people were confused why they had come together here. Then, Alexander the coppersmith wanted to defend that we the Jews were not responsible for Paul. But after discovering him as a Jew, they cried out Great Diana for 2 hours. Then, the city clerk persuaded them upon (1) any images of Diana or Zeus the god of the sky neither stolen nor damaged by the arrestees and (2) Demetrius & other craftsmen's right to file a lawsuit before proconsuls or magistrates in the courts. And then the assembly were scattered. <i>Mat 28:19-20; 2 Tim 4:14-15¹²</i>)

¹⁰ Acts 20:3-4 and stayed three months. And when the Jews plotted against him as he was about to sail to Syria, he decided to return through Macedonia. ⁴ And Sopater of Berea accompanied him to Asia—also Aristarchus and Secundus of the Thessalonians, and Gaius of Derbe, and Timothy, and Tychicus and Trophimus of Asia; Acts 27:1-2 And when it was decided that we should sail to Italy, they delivered Paul and some other prisoners to *one* named Julius, a centurion of the Augustan Regiment. ² So, entering a ship of Adramyttium, we put to sea, meaning to sail along the coasts of Asia. Aristarchus, a Macedonian of Thessalonica, was with us.

blasphemers of your goddess. ³⁸ Therefore, if Demetrius and his fellow craftsmen have a case against anyone, the courts are open and there are proconsuls. Let them bring charges against one another. ³⁹ But if you have any other inquiry to make, it shall be determined in the lawful assembly. ⁴⁰ For we are in danger of being called in question for today's uproar, there being no reason which we may give to account for this disorderly gathering." ⁴¹ And when he had said these things, he dismissed the assembly.
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Note: Most Christians say the Bible is important, but rarely study every word in the Bible and commit it to the Lord. So, it's better to study it and live accordingly after the Spirit for the Lord (2 Tim 2:15). This online word for global crusade in effect develops from the expositional sermon (KJV), into spiritual transformation in daily love fellowship with the Lord throughout the Bible Study (NKJV) -- *All Scripture Expositional Study from verse by verse Inductive Studies* -- of which application is the Discipleship and Spiritual Formation, closer to the image of Christ. We think that "Any human opinion is not really important rather than what God says. So, the best commentary on the Bible is the Bible per se. But the opinion to make us understand God's Word is acceptable (*2 Corinthians 10:5*)." Further, for the application, a life or spiritual experience might be helpful to understand how to apply an understood word in the text column, but it is temperately used like Paul, because nobody should think above that literal experience (2 Cor 12:6, Jer 23:28; Ne 8:8).

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

CAN I LIE TO ACHIEVE SUCCESS FOR THE GLORY OF GOD?

Throughout our ministries and daily life, we have contemplated this year whether or not we can lie in pursuit of success for the glony of God, considering various situations. We'd like to see before our verse-by-verse inductive expository studies.

If one were to lie for God, it would pervert the essence of the Scripture or the word of God. To pervert the Scripture is to pervert faith because faith is rooted in the word of God. Consequently, perverting faith leads to the perverting how we practice the word of God.....

God could deliver him. Ismail said that if God can heal me from this, He is real, and I will follow him and he did.

In one particular battle Ismail was in, his unit was being attacked by 700 Islamic enemy soldiers and his unit had only 100 men. His unit was told to attack even though they were greatly outnumbered, but he said, "Today is Sunday. Let us pray this whole day and seek our God that He will be with us." So, all the soldiers spent the



day in prayer. The next day, Ismail took his artillery gun and fired seven shots; all seven hit critical enemy positions, and within a few minutes, the enemy was in full retreat leaving the area and did not return. The men spent the day giving thanks to the Lord for His deliverance. Ismail was known for

many great feats of heroism, once capturing 16 enemy soldiers and three trucks full of military supplies. On another occasion, his position was hit by a surface-toair missile (SAM) that killed over 100 soldiers and 30 civilians. Once again, Ismail escaped uninjured, and the people said it was because of his relationship with Christ that he was delivered.

I am at the chaplain base as this letter is being written. We sent for Ismail's wife to be brought from the Nuba Mountains to the base. We will do our best to comfort her in her grief and give her the stipend that we give for each fallen chaplain, which can take care of her for years.

Ismail was around 55 years of age and served in the war for 37 years. In his life, he had brought many men and



women to Christ. He had planted a church in a radical Muslim area where the people were some of the most violent, but to this day, his church is still alive with over 200 converted Muslims.

He never knew the comforts of this world but will know great peace throughout eternity, having given his all to protect his people and serve Christ.
