

“Every Thought to the Obedience of Christ” 2 Corinthians 10:1-28 4/21/24

Today, we'd like to see the title of “Every Thought to the Obedience of Christ” in 2 Corinthians 10:1-28.

To Online Word's souls, *through MP3 or YouTube Channel*, on the earth, we'd like to suggest the 3 expositional Questions. (***Maranatha Worship Songs***_____

Q1. In verse 5, “ casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,” what does it mean? And how can we apply it to our lives?

Q2. In verse 12, “ For we dare not class ourselves or compare ourselves with those who commend themselves. But they, measuring themselves by themselves, and comparing themselves among themselves, are not wise,” what does it mean? And how can we apply it to our lives?

Q3. In verse 17, “ But ‘he who glories, let him glory in the LORD,’” what does it mean in the context? And what can we learn from here?

(Background for context of this text on Daily Bible Reading and Studying Weekly Book Basis)

In the last time, 2 Corinthians 9:15, “ Thanks *be* to God for His indescribable gift!” Paul exhorted the Christians at Corinth to be ready to donate to the Lord for the poor saints at Jerusalem according to their early desire. Then, Paul closes it off by given thanks to God for His unspeakable gift, which is really the motive for donation or giving to God. There are the gift of His son, the gift of gospel which cost Jesus' life with blood for our sins, the gift of salvation, the gift of eternal life, joy, peace, mercy, love, etc. God has given so much. All that I have is His. Lord, we've only given back what is really Yours anyhow, for Your glory, Your kingdom, Your righteousness, or Your increase.

Through chapters 10 through 13, Paul convinced his authority to its questioners at the church at Corinth. Since all authority is to Jesus in Matthew 28:18, “ And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, ‘All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth,’” the ministries within the scope of Jesus' authority are valid. Otherwise, those are invalid. Practically, any ministry within the scope of the Scripture is valid because the Scripture testifies of Jesus in John 5:39, “You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me.” So, any human words or deeds within the scope of the Scripture are valid, but those outside of the scope of, i.e., equal to, above, or against -- the Scripture are invalid. For example, Judas Iscariot was appointed as an apostle but his words and deeds outside of the scope were invalid (Matthew 10:2-4, “...the twelve apostles are these...and Judas Iscariot, who also betrayed Him.”). Nobody is authorized to alter the Scripture at all. But the Spirit of truth teaches all the Scripture which testifies of Jesus (John 14:26, “...He shall teach you all things.”)

When he is there, he is humble or lowly to minister or to serve you, not to be served by you. But when he is not there, he is bold or very firm to you who have problems, here opponents questioning Paul's authority in the context)</p> <p>2= (I ask strongly you that when I am there, I may not be bold or very firm to you as if I may be bold or very firm to those who think we walk, live, or minister after the flesh rather than after the Spirit. For example, Paul was bold or very firm to exercise the miracle, a gift of the Spirit, to make a false prophet Bar-jesus blind, because he interfered with Paul's teaching the doctrine of the Lord to Sergius Paulus the deputy of the country <i>Acts 13:6-11; Rom 8:1'</i>)</p> <p>3= (Even if we live in the flesh or physical body, we or the living souls war against the evil spirits or their head Satan, not against flesh and blood. Note spiritual realm, other spirits' realm, and physical realm² When we get entangled in the flesh or in the fleshly conflicts, Satan has an advantage over us during warring after the flesh because Satan still possesses by fraud through Adam and is not destroyed yet. But we confine the war to the Spirit, we have a definite advantage over Satan because Jesus got a victory over Satan by defeating Satan the holder of death through His resurrection from death <i>Eph 6:12</i>³)</p> <p>4=(The weapons of our warfare are not fleshly but mighty weapons in God or the Spiritual weapons such as faith, the Spirit, the word of God, prayer, etc., in order to pull down strongholds of opponents who are influenced, polluted, or ruled ultimately by Satan in this world <i>Eph 6:11-18; Luke 18:1</i>⁴)</p>

¹ *Acts 13:6-11* Now when they had gone through the island to Paphos, they found a certain sorcerer, a false prophet, a Jew whose name was Bar-Jesus, ⁷ who was with the proconsul, Sergius Paulus, an intelligent man. This man called for Barnabas and Saul and sought to hear the word of God. ⁸ But Elymas the sorcerer (for so his name is translated) withstood them, seeking to turn the proconsul away from the faith. ⁹ Then Saul, who also is called Paul, filled with the Holy Spirit, looked intently at him ¹⁰ and said, "O full of all deceit and all fraud, *you* son of the devil, *you* enemy of all righteousness, will you not cease perverting the straight ways of the Lord?" ¹¹ And now, indeed, the hand of the Lord *is* upon you, and you shall be blind, not seeing the sun for a time." And immediately a dark mist fell on him, and he went around seeking someone to lead him by the hand; *Rom 8:1* *There is* therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

⁴ *Eph 6:11-18* Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. ¹² For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual *hosts* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*. ¹³ Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. ¹⁴ Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, ¹⁵ and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; ¹⁶ above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. ¹⁷ And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; ¹⁸ praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication

Today, the thoughts and imaginations of human heart are exalted against the words of God and are evil continually. There are all kinds of opportunity to pollute your mind into spiritual adultery by so many peddling the words of God. God doesn't tempt people with evil. But God has given us the victory with the Spiritual weapons, not our own human weapons. <i>James 1:13-15; 2 Cor 2:17⁵</i>)</p> <p>6= (all disobedient people will be punished or rebuked by Paul when he gets there and then you are fully obedient <i>2 Tim 4:2⁶</i>)</p> <p>7= (Don't consider people after the outward appearance or partiality such as height, handsomeness, wealth, race, etc. but consider whether or not anyone belongs to Christ, i.e., is he or she a Christian? So we consider his or her maturity in terms of the Scripture. E.g., in Paul footstep tour and evangelism, we could minister together because of Christians even if we did not see each other previously <i>James 2:1⁷</i>)</p> <p>8=(Paul said I as an apostle was given the authority by the Lord to edify you to the body of Christ, not to tear you down. An apostle is a gift of the Spirit such as a prophet, evangelist, or a pastor and teacher. Somewhat you may feel my boasting too much about the given authority to you but I will not be ashamed of exercising my authority. <i>Eph 4:11-12⁸</i>)</p> <p>9=(Because Paul first delivered the gospel of Christ to you with other co-ministers, you might feel our overreaching beyond our given authority. But we are not so because we first preached the gospel to you the lost and we are not terrifying you by letters but are edifying you to the body of Christ or help you to grow. See verse 14.)</p> <p>10=(Opponents said Paul's letters were sincere in the sight of God in Christ and were powerful or workable in real life but the outward appearance of his physical body was weak and he was not trained/eloquent speaker like Moses' slow speaker or Jeremiah's</p>

for all the saints—; *Luke 18:1* Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart,

⁵ *James 1:13-15* Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone. ¹⁴ But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. ¹⁵ Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death. *2 Cor 2:17* For we are not, as so many, peddling the word of God; but as of sincerity, but as from God, we speak in the sight of God in Christ.

⁶ *2 Tim 4:2* Preach the word! Be ready in season *and* out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching.

E.g., Sadly, some of us are disinterested in how many times we apply the words of God to daily life, but love to tell how many times we read the Bible without manifestation of the read words of God to daily lives. <i>Ex 4:10-12; Jer 1:6; 2 Cor 11:6; 1 Cor 1:27⁹</i>)</p> <p>11= (When we get there, such an opponent will experience what we are weighty and powerful in deed rather than now in word by letter far from Corinth)</p> <p>12=Q2(Other false teachers were trying to prove their better righteousness by classifying stereo types or comparing themselves with others, as to men, rather than with the Scripture, the sword of the Spirit which is the word of God, as to the Lord. After Jesus' death with bloodshed for our sins, resurrection, and ascension, the Holy Spirit came and dwells into every believer to know the righteousness of Jesus who is imputed to each only through each faith in Jesus Christ by His grace. Any human righteousness even the scribes and Pharisees' is a filthy rag. <i>Mat 5:20; John 14:16-18; John 14:26; John 15:26; John 16:7-11; Isaiah 64:6¹⁰</i>)</p> <p>13= (Paul has boasted His works within the scope of the authority given by the Lord, because all authority is to Jesus. So, Paul will not boast His works in you beyond the given authority)</p> <p>14= (Because Paul first taught the words of God in the gospel of Christ to you with other co-ministers during 1.5 years, you might feel our overreaching beyond our given authority. Paul did not want to build where Christ was already named but desired to teach the words of God in gospel and in Scripture to the lost up to the end of the world. <i>Acts 18:1, 11; Rom</i></p>

⁹ *Ex 4:10-12* Then Moses said to the LORD, "O my Lord, I *am* not eloquent, neither before nor since You have spoken to Your servant; but I *am* slow of speech and slow of tongue."¹¹ So the LORD said to him, "Who has made man's mouth? Or who makes the mute, the deaf, the seeing, or the blind? *Have* not I, the LORD?" ¹² Now therefore, go, and I will be with your mouth and teach you what you shall say; *Jer 1:6* Then said I: "Ah, Lord GOD! Behold, I cannot speak, for I *am* a youth."; *2 Cor 11:6* Even though I *am* untrained in speech, yet I *am* not in knowledge. <p>¹⁵ not boasting of things beyond measure, <i>that is</i>, in other men's labors, but having hope, <i>that</i> as your faith is increased, we shall be greatly enlarged by you in our sphere,</p> <p>¹⁶ to preach the gospel in the <i>regions</i> beyond you, <i>and</i> not to boast in another man's sphere of accomplishment.</p> <p>¹⁷ But "he who glories, let him glory in the LORD."</p> <p>¹⁸ For not he who commends himself is approved, but whom the Lord commends.</p>	<p>15:20¹¹)</p> <p>15= (We do not boast about what other people have ministered but our sphere or the boundaries of our ministry will be extended to increase your faith, i.e., to teach the whole counsel of God because faith comes from hearing of the words of God in the Scripture <i>Rom 10:17</i>¹²)</p> <p>16= (We are teaching the words of God in the Gospel to the untouched regions up to the end of the world, in the regions beyond you, and if God wills, we are teaching the words of God in all Scripture to make disciples from there to all the nations. So, it is not to boast about another man's settled ministries <i>Acts 1:8; Mat 28:19-20</i>¹³)</p> <p>17=Q3 (If you want to glory or boast, glory or boast only about the Lord. What does it mean? We are boasting about God's works in a ministry, life, mission, or church for God, God's glory, God's kingdom, God's righteousness, or God's increase. So, we are not boasting or glorying about our wisdom, might, or riches to be perishable but about the knowledge of God, His lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness to be imperishable. So, our using perishable things in imperishable ways on the earth is wise <i>Jer 9:23-24</i>¹⁴)</p> <p>18=(When he does something well, he tells others and he is recognized by others. So that he differs from others, draws attention from others, or is proud. Why do you boast as if you had not received it from God? So, we are doing heartily as to the Lord, not to men, seeking the commendation of our Lord, not human commendation. <i>Rom 12:3; 1 Cor 4:7; James 4:10; Luke 14:11; Col 3:23</i>¹⁵)</p>

Note: Most Christians say the Bible is important, but rarely study every word in the Bible and commit it to the Lord. So, it's better to study it and live accordingly after the Spirit for the Lord (2 Tim 2:15). This online word for global crusade in effect develops from the expositional sermon

(KJV), into spiritual transformation in daily love fellowship with the Lord throughout the Bible Study (NKJV) -- *All Scripture Expository Study from verse by verse Inductive Studies* -- of which application is the Discipleship and Spiritual Formation, closer to the image of Christ. We think that "Any human opinion is not really important rather than what God says. So, the best commentary on the Bible is the Bible per se. But the opinion to make us understand God's Word is acceptable (2 Corinthians 10:5)." Further, for the application, a life or spiritual experience might be helpful to understand how to apply an understood word in the text column, but it is temperately used like Paul, because nobody should think above that literal experience (2 Cor 12:6, Jer 23:28; Ne 8:8).

In 2023, during Paul's footsteps mission tour and evangelism, several significant observations were made: Firstly, English emerged as the predominant language among people in the European Union (EU). Secondly, despite a rich Christian history, there are relatively few Christians in the midst of a post-Christian culture. Thirdly, it was noted that upon sharing the words of God, many individuals displayed unexpected curiosity or interest. Lastly, leveraging artificial intelligence (AI) tools, the dissemination of God's words can be accelerated significantly, aligning with the prophecy of Daniel 12:4b, "many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased."

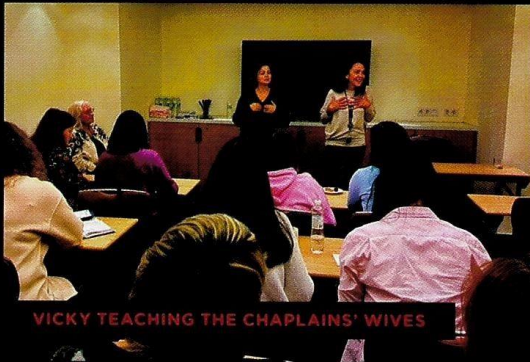
These findings serve as a compelling motivation for us, as debtors of Jesus' love, to endeavor to spread the entirety of God's words throughout the EU whenever providence allows.

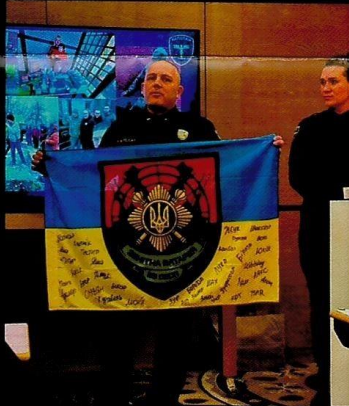
Pray for Abandoned children in Ukraine and His increase

In March of last year, we wrote about children who were being sexually abused in Central and South America, and I was truly stunned by how the body of Christ responded. You can sign up for a monthly amount of whatever you feel led to give. It could be \$25, \$50, \$75 or \$100. God could deliver him. Ismail said that if God can heal me from this, He is real, and I will follow him and he did.

In one particular battle Ismail was in, his unit was being attacked by 700 Islamic enemy soldiers and his unit had only 100 men. His unit was told to attack even though they were greatly outnumbered, but he said, "Today is Sunday. Let us pray this whole day and seek our God that He will be with us." So, all the soldiers spent the

day in prayer. The next day, Ismail took his artillery gun and fired seven shots; all seven hit critical enemy positions, and within a few minutes, the enemy was in full retreat leaving the area and did not return. The men spent the day giving thanks to the Lord for His deliverance. Ismail was known for many great feats of heroism, once capturing 16 enemy soldiers and three trucks full of military supplies. On another occasion, his position was hit by a surface-to-air missile (SAM) that killed over 100 soldiers and 30 civilians. Once again, Ismail escaped uninjured, and the people said it was because of his relationship with Christ that he was delivered.

I am at the chaplain base as this letter is being written. We sent for Ismail's wife to be brought from the Nuba

Mountains to the base. We will do our best to comfort her in her grief and give her the stipend that we give for each fallen chaplain, which can take care of her for years.

Ismail was around 55 years of age and served in the war for 37 years. In his life, he had brought many men and

women to Christ. He had planted a church in a radical Muslim area where the people were some of the most violent, but to this day, his church is still alive with over 200 converted Muslims.

He never knew the comforts of this world but will know great peace throughout eternity, having given his all to protect his people and serve Christ.
