Q1. In 62:8, "Trust in Him at all times, you people; Pour out your heart before Him; God *is* a refuge for us. *Selah*," in the context, what does it mean? And how can we apply it to our lives?

Q2. In 63:1, "O God, You *are* my God; Early will I seek You; My soul thirsts for You; My flesh longs for You In a dry and thirsty land Where there is no water," what does it mean? And what can we learn from here?

Q3. In 64:6-7, "They devise iniquities: 'We have perfected a shrewd scheme.' Both the inward thought and the heart of man are deep. <sup>7</sup> But God shall shoot at them *with* an arrow; Suddenly they shall be wounded," explain what these mean with an example. And what to learn and how to apply these to our lives are here?

(Background for context of this text on Daily Bible Reading and Studying Weekly Book Basis)

David was seeking a refuge from God alone at the risk of his life, such as in Absalom's or Saul's seeking his life.

1= (It's important to learn the secret of waiting upon God. If you find a problem waiting upon God, you don't worry but God takes care of it. Often we feel that God's promise moves more slowly than we'd like to do. Likewise, despite Abraham's belief of his heir, from his own body, to be multiplied like stars, Abrahm at 86 age got Ishmael through Hagar by flesh, and finally at 100 age Isaac the promised son. *Gen 15:4-6; Gen 16:1,16; Gen 17:17*<sup>1</sup>)

2= (Rock is a symbol of God who is faithful and omnipotent, in the light of the Deuteronomy or Daniel. *Deut 32:15; Dan 2:44-45*?)

8=Q1 (When we face a problem, difficulty, or the risk of life, we trust in Him always and pour out our heart such as sins, problems, or issues because God is a refuge. If so, God takes care of them and we don't worry about anything. Otherwise, God lets you take care of them by yourself, often falling into an unexpected worse outcome 1 John 1:9; Prov 3:5-6³)

9=(The men of lowly are not able to help us. Those are emptiness. The men of high degrees learn a false world to get wealth, power, or glory in this world. They are an illusion. On the scales of God, they are lighter than vapor, nothing, or meaningless  $Psalm\ 33:10^4$ )

The spirit has its own thirst for god or eternity. Here, David earnestly sought water in his body, the soul which is the mind controlled by the Spirit or the spiritual mind, and God. 8= (David was the hard follower of God, that God's right hand upholds David. God doesn't violate the free will which is given by God. If you seek to defend yourself, the Lord will let you. But if you will just trust in Him, He will defend you. If you are with God, God is with you. If you forsake God, God forsakes you; How big is the right hand of God? Heaven and Earth are in the distance between His thumb and His little finger; Almighty God's hand upholds David who are comforted and encouraged Gen 3:6; 2 Chro 15:2; Mat 4:19; Isaiah 40:12<sup>10</sup>)

9-11= (God's righteousness will be developed. Note in the OT time, His word was to get even and to allow to swear, while in the NT time, His word is to love even enemies and to discourage to swear. So, it's better to study it and live accordingly after the Spirit for the Lord (2 Tim 2:15). This online word for global crusade in effect develops from the expositional sermon (KJV), into spiritual transformation in daily love fellowship with the Lord throughout the Bible Study (NKJV) -- All Scripture Expositional Study from verse by verse Inductive Studies -- of which application is the Discipleship and Spiritual Formation, closer to the image of Christ. We think that "Any human opinion is not really important rather than what God says. So, the best commentary on the Bible is the Bible per se. But the opinion to make us understand God's Word is acceptable (2 Corinthians 10:5)." Further, for the application, a life or spiritual experience might be helpful to understand how to apply an understood word in the text column, but it is temperately used like Paul, because nobody should think above that actual experience (2 Cor 12:6, Jer 23:28; Ne 8:8).



### A school for Afghan refugees

Darius and Shahnaz are new believers in Iran. As they grew in their faith through regular fellowship, Darius and Shahnaz became convinced they should be reaching out and serving their local community. They soon connected with a local family of eight Afghan refugees. The father of the family could not find work and - as refugees - the children were not allowed to attend the local school. Darius and Shahnaz's house fellowship helped the father find a job and a new home. Shahnaz, a teacher by profession, gave up her job and opened their home as a school for the children of the family. All six children are now being educated, and other children excluded from the formal education system have since joined this fledgling school. The family of Afghans have all put their faith in Christ.

Food aid for destitute families More than half of the population in Afghanistan is facing acute food insecurity. In light of this, Iranian Christians from across the region have sent food parcels to scores of Christian households inside the country who are struggling. While security concerns mean that widespread food relief by Christians to the general population has not been possible, many Christian Afghan families have been giving away 10% of their food parcels to neighbors. Their desire to be generous reflects the love of Jesus in their community. Christians across the region are praying for the chance to increase food relief to Afghanistan.

### Serving protesters

Amid the protests that sprang up in September 2022 following the death of Mahsa Amini, Iranian Christians began sharing the love of Christ with protesters. Many protesters were injured as security forces viciously cracked down, and those injured often avoided accessing mainstream healthcare for fear of being arrested. Christians took care of injured people, sometimes even welcoming them into their homes for recovery. We heard of at least one injured protester and several of his family members who confessed faith in Christ as a result of the loving care he received. Some Christians went out and shared the Gospel with protesters midprotest. Still others felt called to particularly reach out and show love to Kurdish Iranians, given Mahsa Amini was Kurdish – with many coming to Christ.

### Discipleship and aid for Afghan refugees


An Iranian church is supporting a group of Afghan Christians who are among an estimated 250,000 Afghans who have fled to Pakistan since the Taliban seized power in 2021. The Christian Afghan refugees gather for regular fellowship using the Weekly Fellowship resource to shape their meetings and tune in remotely to the Sunday services of the Iranian church. The Iranian church also assists with practical needs and food parcels for these refugees in Pakistan.
