
Q1. In 30:1-2, " 'Woe to the rebellious children,' says the LORD, 'Who take counsel, but not of Me, And who devise plans, but not of My Spirit, That they may add sin to sin; <sup>2</sup> Who walk to go down to Egypt, And have not asked My advice, To strengthen themselves in the strength of Pharaoh, And to trust in the shadow of Egypt!" what do these mean? And what can we learn from here?

Q2. In 30:9-10, "That this *is* a rebellious people, Lying children, Children *who* will not hear the law of the LORD; <sup>10</sup> Who say to the seers, 'Do not see,' And to the prophets, 'Do not prophesy to us right things; Speak to us smooth things, prophesy deceits,'" what do these mean? And how can we apply these to our lives?

Q3. In 31:1, "Woe to those who go down to Egypt for help, *And* rely on horses, Who trust in chariots because *they are* many, And in horsemen because they are very strong, But who do not look to the Holy One of Israel, Nor seek the LORD!" what does it mean? And what can we learn from here?

(Background for context of this text on Daily Bible Reading and Studying Weekly Book Basis)

Rabshakeh the chief solider of Assyria ridiculed Hezekiah the king of Judah in 2 Kings 18:19,21, "<sup>19</sup> Then *the* Rabshakeh said to them, 'Say now to Hezekiah,' Thus says the great king, the king of Assyria: 'What confidence *is* this in which you trust? <sup>21</sup> Now look! You are trusting in the staff of this broken reed, Egypt, on which if a man leans, it will go into his hand and pierce it. So *is* Pharaoh king of Egypt to all who trust in him," Hezekiah first tried to negotiate with Egypt to help Judah from the invasion of Assyria who had already conquered Israel, without asking God.

1-2=Q1 (In the attack of Assyria who was cruel, Judah took human counsels to go down to Egypt which would help. When we face urgent difficulties, we tend to search an easy way out of them, without the counsel of God or without asking in prayer to the Lord. That's according to the flesh or after the flesh rather than after the Spirit or according to the Spirit because the things of the flesh cannot glorify God or please God Rom 8:4-81)

3= (Even Egypt looked light, strong, and great helper, Egypt ends in shadow, weakness, and humiliation to you because nobody is equal to God)

4= (See the above map, Judah sent her princes or leaders to the Zoan in the lower Nile River and her ambassadors to the Hanes in the higher Nile River)

5= (Judah ended in a shame and a reproach without any help or benefit from Egypt)

6-7= (God gives the warning against Egypt like the beasts of the South; God used Egyptians as Beasts; through Negev desert, which is the land of trouble and anguish with lioness, lion, viper, fiery flying serpent. Judah people would carry their riches and treasures thorough donkeys and camel for Egypt's help, but Egypt would be profitless to Judah, because Egypt would be helpless and aimless and so God has called Rahab-Hem-Shebeth or Rahab's strength is nothing. Rahab is a beast like

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Rom 8:4-8 that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us who do not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit. <sup>5</sup> For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who live according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. <sup>6</sup> For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. <sup>7</sup> Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. <sup>8</sup> So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

Now go, write it before them on a tablet,
And note it on a scroll,
That it may be for time to come,
Forever and ever:

<sup>12</sup> Therefore thus says the Holy One of Israel:

"Because you despise this word, And trust in oppression and perversity, And rely on them, Leviathan the crooked servant. Rahab which sat on the Nile River looked so powerful but was powerless or the Egyptians' strength was nothing *Isaiah 27:1; Job* 41:1<sup>2</sup>)

8= (God asks through Isaiah a writing on a scroll to be forever)

9-10 = Q2 (A rebellious people or a disobedient people desire lies, smooth things, or deceits for their itching ears, rather than the law of the Lord, right things, or truth through the seers or the prophets, like today 2 *Tim* 4:3-5<sup>3</sup>)

11= (They get out of the right way, turn aside from the path, so that the Holy One of Israel stops to work before them. God would not violate our human free-will the gift. If you are with God, God will be with you. If you forsake God, God will forsake you. But if you seek God, You will find God. 1 Chro 28:9; 2 Chron 15:1-24)

12= (God told how they were rebellious; they despise the word of God; It is observed if you love God, you would love God's word. It is heard that many say we love God but few love His word. Here, in the oppression of Assyria's attack, they trust in perversity, not in truth, and rely upon Egyptians)

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Isaiah 27:1 In that day the LORD with his sore and great and strong sword shall punish leviathan the piercing serpent, even leviathan that crooked serpent; and he shall slay the dragon that is in the sea; Job 41:1 Can you draw out Leviathan with a hook, Or snare his tongue with a line which you lower?

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> 2 *Tim 4:3-5* For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, *because* they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; <sup>4</sup> and they will turn *their* ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables. <sup>5</sup> But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.

And, "We will ride on swift horses"—

Therefore those who pursue you shall be swift!

<sup>17</sup> One thousand *shall flee* at the threat of one, At the threat of five you shall flee,

Till you are left as a pole on top of a mountain And as a banner on a hill.

<sup>18</sup> Therefore the LORD will wait, that He may be gracious to you; And therefore He will be exalted, that He may have mercy on you.

For the LORD *is* a God of justice; Blessed *are* all those who wait for Him.

<sup>19</sup> For the people shall dwell in Zion at Jerusalem; You shall weep no more. He will be very gracious to you at the sound of your cry;

When He hears it, He will answer you.

13-14= (This iniquity or sin to rebel against God or to disobey His word causes sudden destruction like (1) a high wall's breaking through a breach and a bulge and (2) the vessel broken in pieces to be useless to take fire from the fireplace or to take water from the cistern)

15-17= (God asks them to return to God and to wait for Him in quietness and confidence, and if they do so, God will take care of Assyria's invasion and save you from the invasion. But they rejected it because they would flee on the horses, which were brought from Egypt, from Assyria's invasion. However, they shall flee and their Assyrian pursuers shall be swifter than them in their 1,000 fleeing against 1 pursuer, and their fleeing against 5 pursuers, and few remnants running up to top of a mountain or a hill like a pole or a banner)

18= (God is gracious, merciful, and just. He waits for you, and exalts you. All those who wait for Him who works is blessed. Here. grace is freely given gift to you who don't deserve anything. Rebellion against God is a sin, that you deserve a punishment accordingly. Justice is calling for judgment against the sin for the punishment. Mercy is wiping out the sin for the punishment. So, if you repent the sin, God will wipe out the deserved punishment.)

19=(Hezekiah went to the house of the Lord at Jerusalem and prayed to the Lord God of Israel to deliver Judah from Sennacherib king of Assyria the invader. Then Isaiah delivered His word on <sup>20</sup> And *though* the Lord gives you

The bread of adversity and the water of affliction,

Yet your teachers will not be moved into a corner anymore, But your eyes shall see your teachers.

<sup>21</sup> Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying,

"This is the way, walk in it,"

Whenever you turn to the right hand

Or whenever you turn to the left.

<sup>22</sup> You will also defile the covering of your images of silver, And the ornament of your molded images of gold.

You will throw them away as an unclean thing;

You will say to them, "Get away!"

<sup>23</sup> Then He will give the rain for your seed

With which you sow the ground,

And bread of the increase of the earth;

It will be fat and plentiful.

In that day your cattle will feed

In large pastures.

<sup>24</sup> Likewise the oxen and the young donkeys that work the ground

Will eat cured fodder,

Which has been winnowed with the shovel and fan.

<sup>25</sup> There will be on every high mountain

And on every high hill

Rivers and streams of waters,

In the day of the great slaughter.

When the towers fall.

<sup>26</sup> Moreover the light of the moon will be as the light of the sun, And the light of the sun will be sevenfold,

As the light of seven days,

In the day that the LORD binds up the bruise of His people And heals the stroke of their wound.

which God has heard 2 Kings 19:14-20<sup>5</sup>)

20-26=(Just turn your life over to God, and God will begin to guide you and direct you. God may be showing you His love by patiently walking with you through difficulty times while God gives the bread of adversity and the water of affliction; They destroy all idols, manmade things, or whatever love more than/equal to God, and they get them away. Then, God will give plentiful blessings - rain for seed, bread of the increase, fat cattle, well eating and well working oxen and donkeys; When God gives you victory, it's going to be a restoration of the land, of rain, and rivers, and streams. God is just going to bless and remove the smog and the impurities of the air, so there will be so brightness of the moon and of the sun: God heals bruised or (elgoeg bruow

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>5</sup> 2 Kings 19:14-20And Hezekiah received the letter from the hand of the messengers, and read it; and Hezekiah went up to the house of the LORD, and spread it before the LORD. <sup>15</sup> Then Hezekiah prayed before the LORD, and said: "O LORD God of Israel, *the One* who dwells *between* the cherubim, You are God, You alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth. You have made heaven and earth. <sup>16</sup> Incline Your ear, O LORD, and hear; open Your eyes, O LORD, and see; and hear the words of Sennacherib, which he has sent to reproach the living God. <sup>17</sup> Truly, LORD, the kings of Assyria have laid waste the nations and their lands, <sup>18</sup> and have cast their gods into the fire; for they *were* not gods, but the work of men's hands—wood and stone. <sup>27</sup> Behold, the name of the LORD comes from afar, Burning *with* His anger, And *His* burden *is* heavy; His lips are full of indignation, And His tongue like a devouring fire.

<sup>28</sup> His breath is like an overflowing stream, Which reaches up to the neck,

Which reaches up to the neck,

To sift the nations with the sieve of futility;

And there shall be a bridle in the jaws of the people, Causing them to err.

<sup>29</sup> You shall have a song

As in the night when a holy festival is kept,

And gladness of heart as when one goes with a flute,

To come into the mountain of the LORD,

To the Mighty One of Israel.

<sup>30</sup> The LORD will cause His glorious voice to be heard,

And show the descent of His arm,

With the indignation of *His* anger

And the flame of a devouring fire,

With scattering, tempest, and hailstones.

Assyria will be beaten down,

As He strikes with the rod.

<sup>32</sup> And *in* every place where the staff of punishment passes, Which the LORD lays on him, *It* will be with tambourines and harps; And in battles of brandishing He will fight with it.

33 For Tophet *was* established of old, Yes, for the king it is prepared. He has made *it* deep and large; Its pyre *is* fire with much wood; The breath of the LORD, like a stream of brimstone, Kindles it. 27-30=(Now God talks about the great tribulation period against the enemies of God on the earth in the light of "His anger," "full of indignation," "His tongue like a devouring fire" but you will be rejoicing with a gladness of heart, as one who is going in to worship God, coming in to meet God)

31-32=(The Assyrians 185,000 were killed by the angle of the Lord in a certain night; Sennacherib king of Assyria ran away and was assassinated as God told here. Then Juda was worshipping God with tambourines and harps 2 Kings 19:35-376

33=(Sheol in the Hebrew word or Hades in the Greek is hell or fiery hell at death or His return in heaven. Abyss or bottomless pit is the bound place for Satan upon Jesus' return on earth. Tophet in the Hebrew or Gehenna in the Greek is the lake of fire at the Great White Throne judgment. This is the final destination of Satan, devils, and unbelievers. Death and Hades are cast thereinto. This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> death. Here

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>6</sup> 2 Kings 19:35-37 And it came to pass on a certain night that the angel of the LORD went out, and killed in the camp of the Assyrians one hundred and eighty-five thousand; and when *people* arose early in the morning, there were the corpses—all dead. <sup>36</sup> So Sennacherib king of Assyria departed and went away, returned *home*, and remained at Nineveh. <sup>37</sup> Now it came to pass, as he was worshiping in the temple of Nisroch his god, that his sons Adrammelech and Sharezer struck him down with the sword; and they escaped into the land of Ararat. Then Esarhaddon his son reigned in his place.

1=Q3 (Without seeking God, they are so bad to go down to Egypt for help for many chariots and horses. They did not obey God's word not to return to Eavpt in order to multiply horses. God loves the obedient people because they glorify God by the obedience as Jesus obeyed God to even the death of the cross and hereby Jesus glorified God. To obey His word is better than the offerings or sacrifices without the obedience. Offerings or Sacrifices must be consequences of your obedient heart because God the owner of the earth doesn't need any things but wants to be loved by you as the offerings or sacrifices merely prove your love 1 Sam 16:22; Deut 17:16; Phil 2:8, 11; Ex 19:5<sup>8</sup>)

2= (God is wise and faithful, bringing disaster against evildoers and the helpers of those sinners; God's word is never altered but is faithful forever)

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>7</sup> Mark 9:47-48 And if your eye causes you to sin, pluck it out. It is better for you to enter the kingdom of God with one eye, rather than having two eyes, to be cast into hell fire— <sup>48</sup> where 'Their worm does not die And the fire is not quenched; *Rev 20:14-15* Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. <sup>15</sup> And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire; *Rev 20:3* and he cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, so that he should deceive the nations no more till the thousand years were finished. But after these things he must be released for a little while.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>8</sup> 1 Sam 15:22 So Samuel said: "Has the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, As in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, And to heed than the fat of rams; Deut 17:16But he shall not multiply horses for himself, nor cause the people to return to Egypt to multiply horses, for the LORD has said to you, 'You shall not return that way again; Phil 2:8, 11<sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross. <sup>11</sup> and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father; Ex 19:5 Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth is Mine.

<sup>3</sup> Now the Egyptians *are* men, and not God; And their horses are flesh, and not spirit. When the LORD stretches out His hand, Both he who helps will fall, And he who is helped will fall down; They all will perish together.

<sup>4</sup> For thus the LORD has spoken to me:

"As a lion roars,
And a young lion over his prey
(When a multitude of shepherds is summoned against him,
He will not be afraid of their voice
Nor be disturbed by their noise),
So the LORD of hosts will come down
To fight for Mount Zion and for its hill.

<sup>5</sup> Like birds flying about, So will the LORD of hosts defend Jerusalem. Defending, He will also deliver *it;* Passing over, He will preserve *it.*"

<sup>6</sup> Return *to Him* against whom the children of Israel have deeply revolted.

<sup>7</sup> For in that day every man shall throw away his idols of silver and his idols of gold—sin, which your own hands have made for yourselves. <sup>8</sup> "Then Assyria shall fall by a sword not of man, And a sword not of mankind shall devour him. But he shall flee from the sword, And his young men shall become forced labor. <sup>9</sup> He shall cross over to his stronghold for fear, And his princes shall be afraid of the banner," Says the LORD, Whose fire *is* in Zion And whose furnace *is* in Jerusalem.

3= (Egypt is a type of flesh against the spirit. The helpers and the helped will fall. Here is (1) God's warning against trusting in flesh such as Egyptians and their horses and (2) God's exhortation to trust in the Lord)

4= (A lion is a figure of God; A lion eats up his prey not disturbed by many shepherds' yelling voice or noise; The Lord will come down to fight against Assyria for Mount Zion and for its hill as God did through His angel, in 30:31-32.)

5= (The birds are protecting their chicks by flying around attackers such as snakes or foxes; It's a prophecy. Close to end the World War I, Turks occupied the ancient Jerusalem. Then British forces were flying over the city of Jerusalem continually. In the night, the Turks fled away with fear from Jerusalem. So, Jerusalem was able to be protected)

6= (This is quite an indictment against rebellious Israel; Come and return to the Lord)

7-9= (in a day, they will throw away all idols, man-made things, or things which they love more than or equal to God. God miraculously delivered them from the Assyrians through the sword of angel - Assyrians were stricken and ran away with the fear of God's banner and fiery protection in Zion and in Jerusalem, in 30:31-32. Don't trust in Egyptians, their chariots, horses, or flesh, Trust God. He will direct you for ultimate victory. Even in difficulties, you may rejoice in Him who handles them in His way, His time, and His good purpose. Who can be against God?)

Note: Most Christians say the Bible is important, but rarely study every word in the Bible and commit it to the Lord. So, it's better to study it and live accordingly after the Spirit for the Lord (2 Tim 2:15). This online word for global crusade in effect develops from the expositional sermon (KJV), into spiritual transformation in daily love fellowship with the Lord throughout the Bible Study (NKJV) -- All Scripture Expositional Study from verse by verse Inductive Studies -- of which application is the Discipleship and Spiritual Formation, closer to the image of Christ. We think that "Any human opinion is not really important rather than what God says. So, the best commentary on the Bible is the Bible per se. But the opinion to make us understand God's Word is acceptable (2 Corinthians 10:5)." Further, for the application, a life or spiritual experience might be helpful to understand how to apply an understood word in the text column, but it is temperately used like Paul, because nobody should think above that actual experience (2 Cor 12:6, Jer 23:28; Ne 8:8).



# SHE WILL NEVER MARRY

I have spent many hours praying about gearing down operations in Afghanistan and have even started the process, but in my heart, I could not find peace about it. Every day we continue getting desperate pleas for help from people who are terrified.

It has been two years since the Taliban initiated their reign of terror, and the world has largely forgotten the plight of the Afghan people.

If we want to understand what has been happening in Afghanistan, we have to go back to the late 1930s with Nazi Germany to understand the terror these people are going through. The

citizens in Germany quickly learned that the laws of their country would not protect them. And the dreaded knock at the door meant that the Gestapo, who were stone cold killers, was on the other side. Torture, death, imprisonment, and all the horrors the mind can conceive were a very real possibility for normal German citizens and the Jewish people. Last week, I was asking the Lord to give me wisdom because with the stories coming in from the field, I could feel the fear of many women and families.

As I was driving to get my car washed, I felt the Lord tell me to turn on the radio. I turned on KWAVE (a Christian radio station in my area) and heard a man talking about holding a one-and-a-half-pound premature baby girl

who was not expected to live. The doctor explained that human touch is so very important to a premature newborn, so this gentleman continued holding the little girl through the night as she fought to survive. The man telling

this story said that this little girl was born in Afghanistan and was disfigured due to a cleft palate. I did not know which program was being aired or the name of the man giving his testimony, but I sensed God was trying to get my attention.
