Today, we’d like to see the title of “**Job’s Prosperity, Mockery, and Innocence**” in Job 29-31 To the souls on this Online Word *through Podcast or YouTube Channel*, on the earth, we’d like to suggest the 3 expositional Questions. (**Maranatha Worship Songs : Videos** _____)(**CCMV | A Ministry of CCAH PRESS® : Music Videos**_____)

Q1. In 29:4, “Just as I was in the days of my prime, When the friendly counsel of God was over my tent,” what does it mean in the context? And what can we learn from here

Q2. In 30:11, “Because He has loosed my bowstring and afflicted me, They have cast off restraint before me,” what does it mean? And what can we learn from here?

Q3. In 31:29, “If I have rejoiced at the destruction of him who hated me, Or lifted myself up when evil found him,” what does it mean in the context? And how can we apply it to our lives?

(**Background** for context of this text on Daily Bible Reading and Studying Weekly Book Basis)

The provided text is a summary of the Book of Job, detailing the suffering of a righteous man (i.e., a man who lives by faith) and the counsel he receives from his friends.

God’s declaration concerning him was that, “He was a perfect man. One who loved God, and hated evil” *Job 1:8*¹

The Book of Job tells the story of Job, a righteous man from the land of Uz, whom God Himself described as blameless and upright. Despite his piety, God allows Satan to test Job’s faith. As a result, Job loses all his possessions, his children, and his health, suffering from painful boils *Job 1:16, 18-19; Job 2:7*.²

Job’s three friends—Eliphaz, Bildad, and Zophar—come to mourn with him. Their main argument is that Job’s suffering must be the result of sin, and they advise him to repent. In contrast, another friend, Elihu, later suggests that suffering is sometimes a means of purifying a person, not always a punishment for sin.

Job consistently protests his innocence, maintaining that his suffering is not a consequence of any sin he has committed. He remembers his past prosperity in Chapter 29, where he is mocked by others in Chapter 30. In Chapter 31, he gives a lengthy defense of his innocence.

In the last time, Job 28:28, “And to man He said, ‘Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom, And to depart from evil is understanding.’ ”The fear of the Lord in awe, not in punishment, is correlated with knowledge, understanding, wisdom, and departing from evil. To fear the Lord in awe, you may know His word, understand it, apply it wisely to a situation, and depart from evil. So, it’s

He says, "Oh that I were as in months past, as in the days when God watched over me"</p> <p>4=Q1 Job is reflecting on a time when his life was illuminated by God's guidance. He recalls feeling God's presence and understanding the path laid out for him, as God led and counseled him with divine wisdom.</p> <p>5= Job recalls with great sadness the days when his ten children were alive and his family life was filled with goodness. He longs for the time "when my children were still around me," remembering what he had before they were all killed in a tragic accident.</p> <p>6= Job recalls a time of great prosperity when he had an abundance of olive oil, so much that it was like "rivers of oil" flowing from the grindstones used to press the olives. This imagery of cream and olive oil flowing in abundance highlights the wealth he once had in his agricultural society</p> <p>7= When Job served as a leader in his community, he would sit at the city gates, which were the traditional centers of judgment. This indicates that Job was a respected judge. However, reflecting on his past accomplishments brings him dangerously close to pride, a deceptive sin that can separate him from God. The text suggests that while it's not wrong to remember past good deeds, it's far better to focus on God's blessings, as this helps prevent pride from taking root.</p> <p>8=Job recalls a time when he was deeply respected in his community. When he entered the city gates, young men stayed quiet, and older men stood up to honor him. This shows the high regard people had for him as a leader and judge..</p>

11 When the ear heard, then it blessed me,

11= Job remembers about a time when he was a highly respected and honored leader. People sought out his counsel and wisdom, and his judgments were so sound that those who heard his words blessed him.

12= Job was a respected leader because he was a champion for the poor and the downtrodden, actively standing up for those in need.

14= It implies that Job was a judge in his community, as he was highly respected and people sought his counsel to settle disputes.

16= Job is now affirming the righteous life he lived, which was previously confirmed by God. He is recounting his virtuous deeds to demonstrate that his character and actions align with God's assessment of him as "a perfect man who loves good and hates evil."

19-20= Job is using the metaphor of a well-nourished tree to describe his former life. The tree's roots spread out to the waters, allowing it to constantly draw moisture from the stream, which symbolizes the deep and secure foundation of his past prosperity and spiritual well-being. This constant nourishment kept him strong and thriving, just as a well-watered tree flourishes. Job recalls a time in his life when he felt a sense of freshness and strength, like a tree with roots spread out to water. This imagery symbolizes his former vitality and secure foundation.

23=It describes the new vegetation of spring absorbing the last of the rains, a time when new plantings drink deeply to thrive.

25= Job remembers his past, reflecting on the days of prosperity, blessing, honor, respect, and glory. He contrasts these memories with the dramatic and painful change to his present circumstances.

¹ “But now they mock at me, *men* younger than I,

1= Job contrasts his past honor with his present shame. Once highly respected, he is now scorned even by the lowest in society, including herdsmen and their dogs. He has lost his family, wealth, health, status, and reputation. The young people who mock him forget that their strength will fade, and that God values all people equally.

7= Job describes a nomadic people as malnourished and weak, with little ability to speak. Instead of words, they made sounds like animals, “braying among the bushes” like jackals.

10= Job expresses his deep humiliation, stating that even the lowest people, whom he once considered inferior, now look down on him. He feels this is a profound insult, comparing it to being spat on, which in his culture is one of the worst forms of public disrespect.

11=Q2 Even amidst his profound pain and suffering, Job recognized that God had allowed his trials. He did not lose his faith. The Book of Job teaches us that we can maintain our trust in God, even in the face of calamity.

15= Job’s memories of his former life highlight the stark contrast between his past honor and respect and his current state of horrible mockery and suffering.

17 My bones are pierced in me at night,
 And my gnawing pains take no rest.
 18 By great force my garment is disfigured;
 It binds me about as the collar of my coat.
 19 He has cast me into the mire,
 And I have become like dust and ashes.

20 "I cry out to You, but You do not answer me;
 I stand up, and You regard me.
 21 *But* You have become cruel to me;
 With the strength of Your hand You oppose me.
 22 You lift me up to the wind and cause me to
 ride *on it*; You spoil my success.
 23 For I know *that* You will bring me *to* death,
 And *to* the house appointed for all living. 24 "Surely
 He would not stretch out *His* hand against a heap
 of ruins, If they cry out when He destroys *it*.
 25 Have I not wept for him who was in trouble?
 Has *not* my soul grieved for the poor?
 26 But when I looked for good, evil came *to me*;
 And when I waited for light, then came darkness.
 27 My heart is in turmoil and cannot rest;
 Days of affliction confront me.
 28 I go about mourning, but not in the sun;

1 "I have made a covenant with my eyes;
 Why then should I look upon a young woman?

 And count all my steps?

17= Job expresses his constant suffering by describing the physical pain that pierces his bones, causing him to be unable to sleep at night. He uses the phrase "gnawing pain" to convey a deep, persistent ache.

19= God has taken away my riches.

24= Now Job is protesting his innocence again.

28= Job describes the effect of his disease on his body: his skin has turned black, not from sun exposure, but from an internal ailment. The "not in the sun" means his "bones burning with this heat," implying a fever or deep, internal inflammation that torments him.

31= Job is saying that the sound of his flute, which should bring joy, now sounds like weeping and mourning. This reflects his deep sorrow and the profound change in his life, where even moments of potential happiness are filled with grief.

31

1-12= no sin in his heart
 1-4= Job in his suffering, affirmed his innocence by declaring that he had not even taken the first step toward the sin of adultery, having made a covenant with his eyes not to look at a woman with lust. He explained that this was a conscious choice to live a righteous, godly life, knowing that destruction is the fate of the wicked. His self-defense can be logically divided into three parts: first, that he had no sin in his heart (1-12); second, that he committed no sin against his neighbors (13-23); and third, that he had no sin against God (24-34). This declaration serves as a powerful testament to his character, which had been previously confirmed by God's own words.

⁶ Let me be weighed on honest scales,
 That God may know my integrity.
⁷ If my step has turned from the way,
 Or my heart walked after my eyes,
 Or if any spot adheres to my hands,

12= Job declares that lust is a destructive force, likening it to a fire that "consumes to destruction." This statement highlights the ruinous consequences of lust, which can lead to personal devastation, including sexually transmitted diseases like AIDS and herpes. He observes that countless people have been consumed and destroyed by their own desires.

13-23= no sin against neighbors

17= Living a life of luxury while others around you are in need is a theme addressed in the Bible, particularly in the Book of Job. Job, in his defense, asserts that he never lived a self-indulgent life while ignoring the needs of the poor and the suffering. He states that he actively cared for the needy, the fatherless, and the widow, using his wealth to help others rather than solely for his own comfort.

22= Given the symptoms described—painful boils and intense physical suffering—Job's disease may have caused his joints to separate or swell, contributing to his "gnawing pain." While the Bible doesn't specify the exact disease, the symptoms align with a severe, systemic illness that would affect a person's entire body, including their joints, leading to a breakdown of his physical health

24 "If I have made gold my hope,
Or said to fine gold, 'You are my confidence';
25 If I have rejoiced because my wealth was great,
And because my hand had gained much;

26 If I have observed the sun when it shines,
Or the moon moving *in* brightness,
27 So that my heart has been secretly enticed,
And my mouth has kissed my hand;
28 This also *would be* an iniquity *deserving*
of judgment,
For I would have denied God *who is* above.

29 "If I have rejoiced at the destruction of him who
hated me, Or lifted myself up when evil found him
30 (Indeed I have not allowed my mouth to sin
By asking for a curse on his soul);

24-34= no sin against God because of His special concerns of the least *Zechariah 7:10; Mat 25:40*³

27-28=Job is confronting his accusers, challenging them to prove their claims. He is essentially saying, "If I am guilty of the sins you have accused me of, then let me be punished." This statement is a way of declaring his innocence and challenging his friends' assertion that his suffering is a result of some hidden sin. In every era, societies have placed a high value on possessions, power, and reputation. However, true believers must cleanse themselves of the deep-seated desire to prioritize these things over their relationship with the Lord.

29=Q3 Using sarcasm, Job emphasizes that he never desired his enemies to be cursed. By doing this, he highlights his innocence and refutes the idea that his suffering is a result of any ill will he held toward others.

31= Job declares his innocence by stating that he always provided for those within his household, including his servants. He says that if he had ever eaten his meals alone while those in his care were hungry and longing for food, he would be guilty. This shows his commitment to caring for his dependents.

33-34 = Job asserted his innocence by stating that he did not try to hide his sins, unlike many people -- Adam or Adam's descendants. This is a crucial point, as we cannot hide from God. Acknowledging and confessing our sins is the only way to receive forgiveness and begin a new, forgiven life.

35-40 = Job's crying to God

He had been listening silently and becomes angry that the older, wiser men were unable to provide a satisfying answer or silence Job’s self-justification. Elihu scolds both Job and his three friends. He is upset with Job for justifying himself rather than God, and he is equally frustrated with the friends for failing to counter Job’s arguments effectively. Elihu spends several chapters introducing his speech, boasting about the profound insights he is about to share and questioning why the older men couldn’t grasp the situation. However, he becomes so caught up in his lengthy introduction and in justifying his own right to speak that he never delivers the promised solution. Instead, his discourse serves as an extended prologue to a main argument that is never fully presented</p>

Human rights lawyer and Elam team member Hamid explains how Iranian believers are being equipped to stand firm in the face of persecution. Choosing Christ can carry a high price, but - Hamid says - many believers bravely see imprisonment as an opportunity to share the Gospel.

I was born into a devout Muslim family in Iran. As a young man I was passionate about the law and attended university hoping to become a judge. But as I studied, I saw the corruption of the judiciary branch and so became a lawyer instead to try to do good for others. Disillusioned by Islam, I explored other spiritual experiences. Then one of my co-workers introduced me to Jesus and everything changed.

I attended Elam's three-month leadership training and have served the church ever since. I dedicated my life to advocating for human rights and serving those who face persecution in the Iran region. This work made me a target for persecution, so I left Iran with my family. Today, as part of the Elam team, I help fellow Iranian Christians prepare for

What is it like to be a Christian in Iran?

It can be very hard. Conversion from Islam to Christianity is illegal; many believers face arrest, torture, and long prison sentences for their ministry. But this is not a surprise for us. The Bible makes it clear that living for Jesus means facing persecution. The world hates Him, so it hates those who love Him. That doesn't make it easy, but it gives us something to remember and hold onto amid the hardships. That's why spiritual formation in this area is so important.

How do you prepare someone for persecution?

An important foundation is exploring the Biblical perspective on suffering in general and persecution in particular. The practical insight we give the students on best practices for security is important but helping them engage with God's Word has the most enduring impact.

How do you help Iranian Christians overcome fear?

Proverbs 29:25 says: "Fear of man will prove a snare, but whoever trusts in the Lord is kept safe." We study this verse and others to explore fear.


It is our privilege to serve people like Magda and Firouz. We are deeply grateful for your prayers and partnership which have allowed us to do so.



God could deliver him. Ismail said that if God can heal me from this, He is real, and I will follow him and he did.

In one particular battle Ismail was in, his unit was being attacked by 700 Islamic enemy soldiers and his unit had only 100 men. His unit was told to attack even though they were greatly outnumbered, but he said, "Today is Sunday. Let us pray this whole day and seek our God that He will be with us." So, all the soldiers spent the

day in prayer. The next day, Ismail took his artillery gun and fired seven shots; all seven hit critical enemy positions, and within a few minutes, the enemy was in full retreat leaving the area and did not return. The men spent the day giving thanks to the Lord for His deliverance. Ismail was known for many great feats of heroism, once capturing 16 enemy soldiers and three trucks full of military supplies. On another occasion, his position was hit by a surface-to-air missile (SAM) that killed over 100 soldiers and 30 civilians. Once again, Ismail escaped uninjured, and the people said it was because of his relationship with Christ that he was delivered.

I am at the chaplain base as this letter is being written. We sent for Ismail's wife to be brought from the Nuba

Mountains to the base. We will do our best to comfort her in her grief and give her the stipend that we give for each fallen chaplain, which can take care of her for years. Ismail was around 55 years of age and served in the war for 37 years. In his life, he had brought many men and

women to Christ. He had planted a church in a radical Muslim area where the people were some of the most violent, but to this day, his church is still alive with over 200 converted Muslims.


He never knew the comforts of this world but will know great peace throughout eternity, having given his all to protect his people and serve Christ.

I cannot live with myself knowing this is going on, and I am willing to spend the rest of my life protecting and caring for those who do not have the ability to protect and care for themselves.

I have always thought that if I reached an age when I was too old to travel, I would enjoy restoring a classic car. I enjoy watching shows that take an old car that is a wreck and bring it back to life. Truthfully, I would enjoy having a garage with half a dozen cars that I could slowly restore. Watching shows that bring a wreck back to a thing of beauty reminds me of how the Lord takes broken lives and restores them. But I would far more desire to save these children and set up places of refuge for the handicapped and children of all ages, including babies and toddlers. Please understand we plan on starting what does not exist in Ukraine, and when we find children who are being abused by parents, we will not allow it to continue. When the laws of the land do not protect women and children, we, as believers, answer to a higher law, God's law, and will do what is necessary to ensure these children are not harmed by parents or anyone, such as a boyfriend.

In March of last year, we wrote about children who were being sexually abused in Central and South America, and I was truly stunned by how the body of Christ responded. It was far beyond what I ever expected. Because the response was so tremendous, many children are being rescued, but now we need people to come alongside and help us build the infrastructure to save children in Ukraine. You can sign up for a monthly amount of whatever you feel led to give. It could be \$25, \$50, \$75 or \$100. And if you can give far more because of how God has blessed you, we welcome the gift and assure you that these funds will be used solely for this project. I want to let you know that as we begin this project, we cannot send you a biography and photo of a specific child. Once we have children in our care, we will send you information about a child for whom you can pray. So please consider joining us in the rescue of these children.

Hopefully, in time, we will have the ability to facilitate adoptions. It would be my heart's desire that the homes would be a place of love until we can find a family that will care for these children.



Folks, I have some investments that should bring a great return in the next couple of years, and if the Lord blesses I will willingly give it to care for these children.

The Bible says in Psalm 68:5-6 that He is a father to the fatherless and sets the lonely in families.

We will actively seek to follow every lead to find the children who are abandoned and abused. A few years ago, a couple was arrested, and when the police came, they found that the couple had a little girl. When the officers asked her what her name was, she responded, "Stupid." The child had a black eye and deep-purple

I have too much to share once again but let me just give you an update on Afghanistan first.

On our Afghanistan operation, we have rescued around 2,700 individuals. During this operation, we raised about \$5.5 million, but we will have spent close to \$6.5 million by the time our last refugees are safely resettled. Brent came to me and asked what I wanted to do when the money had run out, and I told him that we would spend what was needed to get every last person the Lord had entrusted us with to relocate to a safe country. For all of you who have given, thank you, I believe you have touched the heart of God. And I would like to give a special thanks to North Country Chapel for helping to save so many lives. Far Reaching Ministries is in the final stages of shutting down operations in Afghanistan.

In March, Luke, Vicky, and I were at the chaplain refresher course in Ukraine. The time was far better than

I could have imagined. We had brought eight pastors from the U.S., most had been with us the last time men like Pastor Lloyd Pulley, Pastor James Class, and Pastor David Mercer to name a few. The fact that many of us returned had great meaning to the Ukrainians. One of the chaplains said that the last year had been "hell on earth". And when he was traveling with his family, his son said, "Dad, where are we going?" His father replied, "Paradise!" I was told that the Radisson Resort we were staying at, in the Carpathian Mountains, was considered by many Ukrainians to be a once in a lifetime destination. One brother told me that if you had stayed at this resort, you had arrived and were considered to have lived a life worth living. It was a nice hotel, but by U.S. standards it would be considered average. But for our chaplains and their families, these retreats are a great blessing.

After the conference the pastors traveled back to the U.S.,

Second, I want to share an update on our orphanage project in Ukraine. We have found a great location that is even better than the first. It not only has room for an orphanage but future Bible school as well as a chaplain base. The property is seven acres and has a natural waterway. When the owner found out believers from the U.S. wanted to help Ukrainian orphans, he lowered the price from \$180,000 to \$140,000. We have raised the complete amount to purchase the property so that the next phase will be the construction of the first dorm for 100 children. For another \$250,000, we will be able to complete a kitchen and cafeteria, and the new children's dorm. We have already raised the first \$100,000 and only need another \$150,000 to complete the initial phase of



the project. One of the ideas is to build the buildings in an Austrian or German Bavarian style so that the children will grow up in a beautiful home and have many happy memories.



We are also looking for pastors to come to Ukraine to train the chaplains.

The third thing I need to share is that Far Reaching Ministries (FRM) has shipped a container of Bibles into China. We can share no details so as not to hamper future operations.

The fourth thing we must report is the loss of two more chaplains—Chaplain Jacob Wuoi and Chaplain John Ebele. With the death of three more chaplains in the last year, this brings the total to 76 chaplains lost since the beginning of the ministry.



Jacob joined the chaplaincy program in 2019. He fell ill one evening and was gone by morning. Being in South Sudan, he was buried the next day, and whatever took him, we will never know. Jacob had graduated in Class 11 and served for four years before he was summoned home by our Lord Jesus Christ.

Q 1. How many members or offerings are at CCAH?

A 1. People say, "How many people have been saved?" we don't know, but God knows, although we acknowledge that God has arranged over 1,000 units of communities, 7 sober living facilities, over 200 units of veteran community, KJV English & RVR Spanish Scriptures & 200 lunches per week for the homeless, and over a million online visitors (Mat 25:40 "unto one of the least of these"). It doesn't matter. It's something we leave the numbers with God. He knows those that are His and that's the important thing (e.g. David's motive for census in 1 Chro 21:1). Therefore, we don't worry about the numbers of the members and of tithes and offerings because the Lord has given the increase, He has added them to CCAH so far (1 Cor 3:7; Acts 2:47; 2 Sam 24:1-3), not as we have done at all, and CCAH is His own church (souls), the Lord's church, "Jesus is all in all," purchased with His blood (Mat 16:18; 1 Cor 6:20; Acts 20:28). Since His foolishness is wiser than men, such as all men's visions/ plans/ programs (1 Cor 1:25; Zechariah 4:6), and His thoughts unto each soul are more in number than the sand (Psalm 139:17-18), we are just active obedient followers of the Lord, venturing out in faith, "**Let CCAH go, let God.**"

And if you did indeed receive the increase, why do you boast as if you had not received it? (1 Cor 4:7) For we are not, as so many, peddling the word of God; but as of sincerity, but as from God, we speak in the sight of God in Christ (2 Cor 2:17), CCAH continues faithfully in teaching the entire Scripture simply without alteration, fellowship, communion, and prayers, being the witnesses to Christ, powered with the Spirit, in Jerusalem, all Judea, Samaria, and to the end of the earth (Acts 1:8; 2:42, 47). The truth the Word of God matters wherever - offline, indoor, outdoor, online, at sea, or in sky - and whenever - Sunday, Saturday, weekday, every day, this generation time, or the future generation time (John 5:39; 17:17). The truth shall make us free (John 8:32), from where Christ is named, where commercial capitalism is controlling, where territorial boundaries are lined, or where racial, material, or hereditary partiality underscores. Every Christian is exhorted to go to church at any convenient place unless she is against "the principles of doctrine of Christ" (Heb 6:1) because of "one church (Ekklesia) on the earth" (Eph 1:22-23). Touchable over 1,000 souls by offline and foreseeable over 1 million souls by online at CCAH are being fed by the whole counsel of God throughout the Spirit, living by every His word (1 John 2:27; Luke 4:4). CCAH does care about each soul because we believe that everybody is impartially created by God in His image (Gen 1:26) -- regardless of race, gender, age, wealth, or education such as Caucasian, male, youth, rich, Ivy league graduate, or not-- and that the eternal value of each soul is much greater than the value of any material/ temporal/ perishable things on the earth (James 3:17; Mat 16:26). When God leads, God provides (1 Chronicles 22:11). So, we don't seek money because it follows the faith in the almighty Lord by the love of God. Therefore, we never ask people for money, but would offer what we have to the Lord and pray Him to handle the issues (like Andrew rather than Philip in John 6:6-9). Individually, we can discern our each mind before the Lord, as how much love for Him can be observed (1) by the money index to divide willing expenditures to God by total expenditures (Luke 12:34; 21:2-3), as well as (2) by how much the words of God we love (John 1:1). We know that any offering to God without willing mind is not accepted by God (2 Cor 8:12). The public love money especially in capitalism society because without money capitalism would not exist. However, we as Christians should not love money but should know its nature (1 Timothy 6:10). CCAH has been controlled not by money even in the capitalism society but by sovereign almighty God. The foundation of CCAH finance has begun from a homeless person's 2 dime offering to the Lord for CCAH at the Rock Fortress facility. The willing mind part for an offering should always prevail over its money part. An offering box in a church service or a donation button on websites through CCAH is a way to express a donor's love for God by willing donation, the 1st part rather than 2nd money part, according to the Scripture (Mark 12:43; Luke 21:3-4). In fact, the fund raising or the fund seeking is not necessary for CCAH but the Lord seeking is sufficient because God is continually working through His church, CCAH, in Acts 29 (1 Chronicles 28:9; 2 Chronicles 15:1-2). We have spent offerings/donations about 40% for external ministries (for missions in Philippians 4:15-19 & for charity in Matthew 25:40) based upon our faith of "one church (Ekklesia) on the earth" -- the holy universal church, not unholy ecumenical church -- (e.g. 1st Quarter 2014, 43.15%; 4st Quarter 2013, 55.6 %; 3rd Quarter 2013, 20.11%; 2nd Quarter 2013, 55.91%; 1st Quarter, 2013 43.26%; 4th Quarter, 2012 45.57%, etc.), rather than spent them for additional social/cultural/popular internal programs. But about 60% for the internal ministries following the model of the early church in the Book of Acts is spent for sheep to be fed with spiritual food (Galatians 6:6) and for staff (1 Timothy 5:17-18).

CCAHA is **the poor in material and spirit**, but is the rich to give it away for Christ's sake, e.g., about 40% of annual offerings, with the poor hearts in spirit. The Lord is the shepherd of CCAH who is "as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things" (2 Cor 6:10).

ON OUR WAY TO CLASS A WILD ELEPHANT CROSSED THE ROAD. What a sight! Only tourists want to see wild elephants, not so with the locals, as they can be incredibly destructive, in some cases kill humans. On the Thai/Burma border many elephants come from Burma as they often are poached but are protected in Thailand. The Karen still come in numbers into Thailand for similar reasons being displaced and killed by the Burmese military. Pray for these hurting people.

SORROW GREETS US ON THE BORDER. Two horrific accidents occurred days before we arrived. Poor people often travel in the back of pick-up trucks, this was the case and all in the back were thrown out, 4 died (all young people) most hospitalized. They all lived in the Karen community (18 in one truck, 10 in the other). We became part of the pastoral team, visited 3 hospitals, bringing comfort, prayer and some financial assistance (God provided). Next came the memorial services in which the unbelievers present were all able to hear the message of eternal life available to all who put their trust in Jesus.




This mother survived the accident, but her son did not.

Pray for Ukrainians to be Protected from Explosions and for Peace in Christ

Luke and I met with Ukrainian officers in charge of training their chaplains and showed them pictures of our base and training center in South Sudan. We showed them videos of the chaplain silent drill team we use for evangelical outreach. Just like the Marine Corps silent-drill team, our men do a 15-minute drill without any verbal command. The men then share God's Word, and many soldiers get saved. I am not sure if the officers that Luke and I met with are truly saved, but both were very respectful. At the end of our conversation, the senior officer asked how I would motivate his men as their military is very demoralized.




At this moment in our conversation, I knew this was a time to give them something of substance that they could relate to. I said that at the future chaplain training school there would be a large aquarium, and on the bottom, there would be a sunken battleship with the word Moskva on it. I knew that this would be meaningful to them. You see, at one of the worst times in the war with Russia, when it looked as if all might be lost, Ukraine miraculously got two Neptune missiles working. They fired them at the Moskva, the flagship of the Russian fleet while it was in port, and amazingly, they hit the ship. Not wanting to accept defeat, the Russians pulled the ship out to sea and said it had sunk in heavy seas, but truthfully, it was the damage the Ukrainian army inflicted on the ship that sank it. This was the largest ship in the Russian fleet, and nothing like this has happened since the Second World War. I told the officers about the war in South Sudan and said that we refused to surrender when we were outmanned and outgunned but not outfought, and we won the war. The two men laughed and said that we had a great strategy for encouraging the men. Sometimes, men need to be reminded to never give up and never surrender. They need to understand that they have a God given role to protect women and children, even at the cost of one's life. See folks we do not fear men, we fear the Lord. As men we were made for battle; we were made to protect

those that cannot protect themselves. It is important that Luke and I live trusting the Lord so that those around us can see what true faith looks like. This is why we go to the frontlines. Many times, non-believers do not understand why we would go to such dangerous places, but you see this action opens the door to share about the Lord.



I was in Europe when a Russian missile hit a children's hospital and maternity ward in Ukraine, killing mothers and children. One photo, in particular, troubled me.



The photo was of a baby girl covering her ears and holding on to her mother. It is hard for me to see children afraid. Even worse, the death of a parent is devastating for a child. In an instant, the love and security they have known is gone—leaving the child utterly traumatized. Russia and Ukraine continue to be at war, but no one can justify targeting a hospital with

A school for Afghan refugees

Darius and Shahnaz are new believers in Iran. As they grew in their faith through regular fellowship, Darius and Shahnaz became convinced they should be reaching out and serving their local community. They soon connected with a local family of eight Afghan refugees. The father of the family could not find work and - as refugees - the children were not allowed to attend the local school. Darius and Shahnaz's house fellowship helped the father find a job and a new home. Shahnaz, a teacher by profession, gave up her job and opened their home as a school for the children of the family. All six children are now being educated, and other children excluded from the formal education system have since joined this fledgling school. The family of Afghans have all put their faith in Christ.

Food aid for destitute families

More than half of the population in Afghanistan is facing acute food insecurity. In light of this, Iranian Christians from across the region have sent food parcels to scores of Christian households inside the country who are struggling. While security concerns mean that widespread food relief by Christians to the general population has not been possible, many Christian Afghan families have been giving away 10% of their food parcels to neighbors. Their desire to be generous reflects the love of Jesus in their community. Christians across the region are praying for the chance to increase food relief to Afghanistan.

Serving protesters

Amid the protests that sprang up in September 2022 following the death of Mahsa Amini, Iranian Christians began sharing the love of Christ with protesters. Many protesters were injured as security forces viciously cracked down, and those injured often avoided accessing mainstream healthcare for fear of being arrested. Christians took care of injured people, sometimes even welcoming them into their homes for recovery. We heard of at least one injured protester and several of his family members who confessed faith in Christ as a result of the loving care he received. Some Christians went out and shared the Gospel with protesters mid-protest. Still others felt called to particularly reach out and show love to Kurdish Iranians, given Mahsa Amini was Kurdish - with many coming to Christ.



An Iranian church is supporting a group of Afghan Christians who are among an estimated 250,000 Afghans who have fled to Pakistan since the Taliban seized power in 2021. ONE LONG JOURNEY

When I first met Tirza in Russia, it was probably in 1994. She was from the Dutch office of a sister organization, and I was leading a team into the Russian prisons. At that time, I never thought that she would still be in my life 30 years later. When we met, Tirza spoke six languages and worked harder than any two men on my team. Today, she speaks 12 languages. She began working as an assistant to the director of the Dutch office right out of high school and had always worked for minimum wage so as not to be a burden to the ministry.

She and her husband, Hans, have been married for 37 years, as he likes to say, because they love each other. Hans wrote for a newspaper, and they humbly lived off his salary.

In the early days in Russia, when I traveled from prison to prison, it was hard to find food. I would go for weeks only eating Borsch, a Russian cabbage and beet soup.


And, often, I would only eat twice a day. When I would return to Moscow after each of my trips, I would run to the only McDonald's in the city to find food. Every month, when I would travel, I would lose at least 20 pounds, but it was never a problem; instead, it was a great joy.

I often traveled with Mark Piester, who also worked alongside Tirza in Holland. Mark, an American, had worked for years smuggling Bibles behind the Iron Curtain. He and I would spend days on trains and buses—going from prison to prison sharing Christ—most of the time in the dead of winter. I would stare out the window for hours, looking at the snow drifts and Russian countryside, but I loved every minute. I never felt alone; it was me and the Lord, and I will always remember it as the most enjoyable time of ministry. Vicky knows the look when she sees me in this state. She always says, “What part of the world are you

planning to conquer next?" I respond back and just say, "I am lost in my thoughts, Love." But she smiles back and says, "You might as well tell me." Which makes me smile at how well she knows her husband. Then I tell her what I believe is God's next plan for the ministry.

Once, I got very sick in Russia and could find no medicine, so I traveled to Holland to stay with Tirza and Hans, and they took great care of me. The Dutch climate during winter is always rainy and overcast, but I did not mind because the rainy weather has always been my favorite. I stayed in the third-story attic of Tirza and Hans's home. The attic had been turned into a nice bedroom with a window that I could open at night and listen to the rain. Tirza made great meals to nurse me back to health. When I got better, we rode bicycles to the Dutch office every morning, and we would stop at a bakery on the way to get something warm. The Dutch bakeries are the best in the world!

Tirza and Hans have been close friends of mine ever since. Hans loved American peanut butter, but it was unavailable in their home country 30 years ago. At the time, I worked at a food bank in America, and they would give me whatever food I wanted to give away. Back then, I had no money, but KLM Airlines would allow me to take two 75-pound boxes with me, so I brought Hans 140 pounds of peanut butter—my way of saying thanks to them for their hospitality. Vicky and I just recently visited them on a trip to Europe.



wife, Marlene, our love and support, and I assured them that Far Reaching Ministries would not let this mission organization falter but will be with them through this very difficult time.

I will miss Erik and his passion for the Lord.

There is a very important and terrible need that Tirza informed me of. She never asks anything for herself. A few years ago, we purchased her a new car for work. When I told Tirza that we were going to buy her a much-needed car, she spent two days trying to talk me into giving it to other missionaries, but I knew it was God's will for her to have this car. This is why when she calls and says she has a great need, I know it is from the Lord.

Tirza shared with me that in Burma, the Junta Army is attacking and killing the Karen, Karenni, and Kachin Christian people. They bomb schools and kill for no reason. The Burma Army is Buddhist-backed, which dispels the image of Buddhists as being peace-loving. But the game the soldiers love is the rape of Christian women, often in front of their husband. Many women have been raped by as many as 20 men to the point they pass out and wake up naked hours later to find that their husband was killed during the rape.

One commander raped a woman and then told 20 of his men that if they did not also rape her, he would kill them; the men did as ordered. When she was finally released, the woman went home and told her husband what happened. He was not a good man and kicked her out of the house. Because she was in so much despair, she took her own life. How I wish the woman had met

Why does CCAH use an online donation button or donation basket?

In today's world, shaped by capitalism and materialism, money has become central to human life. However, how we allocate our financial resources reflects the priorities of our heart. As Matthew 6:21 states, "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." CCAH uses a donation basket or online donation button as a way for individuals to examine their love for God, gauging it through their willingness to support His work. These tools are not for fundraising but rather to encourage believers to align their financial priorities with their faith, recognizing that where one's money goes often indicates where their heart lies.

CCA follows a Spirit-led approach, relying on God's provision rather than human efforts to seek funds. Therefore, donations at CCAH serve as a personal testament to one's love for God, and are gratefully accepted as an act of faith and commitment to advancing His kingdom. Ultimately, the KJV should be searched and studied for its accuracy to the original texts (Acts 17:11; 2 Timothy 2:15).

AI can serve as an essential tool in this journey, helping us to dive deeper into Scripture. For example, AI tools can analyze and compare different translations, provide historical context, and even offer insights into the original Greek and Hebrew languages. This can greatly enhance our understanding of the Bible and make study more efficient and effective.




Calvary Chapel Trujillo has a great team that wants to get involved in helping these young ladies. What impressed me was that Cory already had top lawyers

Ultimately, our calling is to help people not miss the life they were created for. Now, for all of you who want this life, it is crucial to understand that for every front-line combat soldier, it takes five to seventeen support soldiers to keep them in the battle. During D-Day in the Second World War, they needed 17 support soldiers for each combat soldier in battle. I want to encourage you all to be a part of this new front through prayer, financial support, or other ministry opportunities.





and actually the polar opposite of Christlikeness. God's Word is very clear; it is the love of God that compels a person to repentance. Jesus, when He spoke of Himself, said, "I am meek, gentle of heart, and I offer you eternal rest for your souls." The Lord has called us to train men to behave with selflessness, generosity, great integrity, and, above all, not to shame the name of Christ.



When my daughter was young, she told me about a classmate everyone picked on at her school. I told her to befriend this girl, sit with her at lunch, play with her, and, if others ridicule her, defend her. She said, "But Dad, if I do this, I will be unpopular." I said, "I did not raise you to be popular but to be an example of Jesus Christ to a lost world!"

In October 2024, we started a construction project in Uganda to build a new Bible school. One of the great things about Africa is that you can do so much for very little. Our existing school in Uganda was built to resemble a castle and sits on a compound that covers about 150-200 square yards. It has two three-story buildings that house 700 children, a kitchen, a dining hall, an administration block, and classrooms. If we had built the same building in the U.S., it would probably cost a fortune, but we were able to construct it for about \$300,000. We built the school to train up future leaders. I tell the community I will most likely be gone in 10-15 years, but this school will serve for years to come.

Now, my heart is to invest in the people training the leaders of the church. I want this new Bible school to house and train up to 200 students and staff. I recently met with Pastor Jerel Hagerman and Pastor Don McClure about registering this facility as a Calvary Bible Institute (CBI). In many African nations, the only training for a pastor is to learn how to listen to a sermon and repeat as much as you can in order to excite your audience. This Bible school will be a year-long resident

program, taking students verse by verse from Genesis to Revelation. We will also give practical ministry training in four areas: evangelical outreach, Children's Ministry, discipleship for adults, and counseling and visitations (spending three months in each module). In addition, students will learn about church government and financial administration, so they will have all the tools and training to build a healthy church family.

The new school will be built to have the look of a true European castle built 500 years ago. The reason this is important is that every nation has places like Cambridge

ELDERLY MAN FINDS CHRIST



one mixed martial arts (MMA) fighter in Peru, so he is famous in the nation. He told me that when he started fighting, he did not even have enough money to eat. After training when all the gym broke for a walk, because he did not have any money for food, and he did not want others to know how poor he was. After winning many fights, he started to get sponsors and could buy food and better provide for himself, but he said this was a blessing in disguise because the struggles made him stronger.

Luis' gym is only a block from Calvary Chapel Trujillo, and he was invited to visit one weekend. He met Jesus Christ and received eternal life almost immediately. Soon after, Luis felt the Lord asking him to give up fighting and serve Him, and he obeyed without question. He has completed his first year of Bible school and just started his second. He is not a prideful, aggressive, or loud fighter as one may expect; instead, I saw a brother, humble and committed to serve Christ with all his heart. Cory wants to eventually move him into full-time ministry. The Lord spoke to Vicky and me and told us to give him \$1,000. He later said that his wife had called and was looking for their last four dollars. With the gift they were able to get caught up on all their bills and they are celebrating their fourth anniversary. I believe the Lord wants us to support Luis; I would ask for 10 to 20 people to sponsor him so he can be in full-time ministry.

I want to encourage all of you to invest in others serving the Lord, and I have no doubt you will reap great treasures in heaven. Far Reaching Ministries is involved in multiple clandestine operations to save believers and innocent lives. I have shared in previous newsletters about our work in Afghanistan.

During the Afghanistan evacuation operation, we were contacted by Shannon Spann, a former CIA agent, and she asked us to help extract 28 people who worked for the agency. These were people who had worked for the U.S. government but were left behind. The entire intelligence world was caught by surprise when the withdrawal from Afghanistan was done with no advanced notice. What was done resulted in tens of thousands of men, women, and children being tortured, raped, and brutally murdered. Folks, I do not have any knowledge of the inner workings of the CIA, but I did know what would happen to these people.

During the Vietnam war both the Hmong and Montagnards indigenous people helped the CIA and the 5th Special Forces Group, which are Green Berets trained hard to fight Viet Cong forces. The Hmong and Montagnards were Christians fighting against communism, so they created deep bonds with the U.S. soldiers. When the United States pulled out of Vietnam, our government abandoned them, and they suffered horribly in what is referred to as the forgotten genocide. To others, promises made might not matter, but to me they do.

Darius: trained leader equips new believers with God's Word

Faithful Darius chased a car through the streets of his city to deliver a precious copy of the Bible. As a result, a small group of new believers is now equipped to grow in their faith.

Trained church planter Darius was halted at a red light on his bike one day when something in an adjacent car caught his eye. It was a small cross hanging from the rear-view mirror.

Darius knew this symbol was popular among the increasingly non-Islamic people of Iran and was not necessarily indicative of an active Christian faith. Yet his heart quickened.

In that moment, Darius decided to give the driver of the car the Persian Bible that was stashed in his backpack. This precious Bible was one of only ten that had escaped attention when his home was raided earlier that year by intelligence agents. Darius had spent six weeks in prison following the raid, yet his passion for giving others the Word of God had not been diminished.

As Darius was about to knock on the car window, the light turned green, and the car sped off. Undeterred, Darius gave chase on his bike. As the car stopped at a second red light, Darius was relieved to have caught up. But once more, the lights changed. Darius was starting to give up hope when he saw the car pull over.

Now hot and tired, Darius pulled over too. As he approached, he could see the driver had his head bowed. The driver looked up and lowered the window when Darius knocked. "I want to give you a gift," Darius explained breathlessly. He reached into his bag for the Bible. "This book is about Jesus," he said. "Your cross is a symbol of what He has done for us."

The face of the man - whose name was Farhad - lit up. "Do

you know what I was just doing?" Farhad asked, excitedly. "I was praying because my friends and I became Christians, but we had no idea how to find a Bible!"

Through God's providence and Darius' boldness, Farhad and his friends now have access to the Bible as well as to discipleship and fellowship resources like *Safar* and *Weekly Fellowship*. This group of new believers has been equipped to not only believe the Gospel, but to actively follow Jesus as Lord.

Farhad and his friends are one group out of many that have been equipped with the Bible and other resources to help them grow this year. Please pray for their continued walk with Christ and for Darius as he continues in ministry.




with them, but we had given them \$5,000 once to help feed them. While I could have said they are not my responsibility, I know the heart of the Lord. In the end, 17 Haitians, mostly women and children, were saved, and it cost \$411.76 for each soul. I would hope if my family were in danger and needed help, believers would not let money stop them from helping.

I heard Alistair Begg share that when he met the woman who would be his future wife, she had a bunch of guy friends who were U.S. Marines, and he said they had muscles in places that he did not even have places. It makes us laugh at his humor, but whatever he lacked in physical strength, he seems to have far more in spiritual strength. One of the great things about following Christ is if you are diligently seeking the Lord, you can be used greatly. While the Lord seems to be tasking us with caring for so many, I never lose sight that the Bible says it is the love of God that compels people to repentance, and I do care for people who are lost in darkness.

Often, Vicky tells me she never thought she could be so happy in marriage, and I love taking care of her. But, as believers, I believe that our hearts should have enough room for those who have never felt loved. Getting people to support missionaries in dangerous countries or children is very easy, but few are inclined to support the elderly. Sadly, in Ukraine many abandon their mothers and fathers, dropping them off at a home owned by Pastor Fedor, who cares for those too old to care for themselves. Many want their parents' apartment to start a life with whatever man or woman they are involved with and willingly abandon both mother and father. I want to encourage many of you to join us in caring for people like this. The Bible says as much as you do it unto them it will be done unto you.





class of chaplains in 1999. He had been in more than 20 heavy combat engagements serving Christ at the front lines, putting his life in harm's way so that others might know Christ. Michael, my senior chaplain, said that Justine had spent the great majority of his life in combat, serving others, and rose to the rank of Major. He was deeply committed to prayer because he knew that only through Christ could he reach the men. It is believed his death was the result of an old wound that he never fully recovered from. He was truly a real man of God, and we do not see his death as a loss but as a graduation to glory.

Michael said that Phillip graduated from class nine. Unlike Justine, he did not see much earthly combat but did see a tremendous amount of spiritual combat. He was known as a man of great prayer and spent his life sharing Christ and teaching God's word to the military units he was deployed to. The men respected Phillip because he lived what he taught, and they said he was on fire for Christ. During his military service, he rose to the rank of Sergeant Major. Though we believe he died of an illness, we will never truly know what took him.

In the Second World War, when Nazi Germany and the Empire of Japan were defeated, the first groups of men who came home were greeted with great celebrations and parades. By the time the other men, who had to stay after the war ended, came home six months to a year later, the parades and parties were over. They were content with seeing families and friends. For those who fought in the longest-running war in Africa, the men never came home to celebrations because the country had suffered too much from war and genocide, and the general population was traumatized from suffering through so many years of war. But it makes my heart happy to think of the reception that Phillip and Justine received when they stood before the Lord Jesus and the angels and the glory of His heavenly kingdom.

DANGEROUS PLACES PRAY FOR

Nigeria Operations:

On Christmas Eve in 2023, in typical African villages in Plateau State, Nigeria, brothers, sisters, relatives, and friends had arrived from towns and cities near and far away. As preparations were in top gear for the Christmas celebration, out of nowhere came the shout of Allah hu Akbar (God is great). Next, the sounds of AK-47s and other automatic weapons of war suddenly cut short the celebration of joy in the middle of the night.

The attacks on these villages continued throughout the night until dawn. There was no intervention by soldiers or security, so the terrorists had their field day raping, maiming, and killing as they wished. In barely 48 hours, over 200 had been killed in a cluster of villages by radical Islamic militias.

In one of the villages, following the shouts of Allah hu Akbar, about 16 close relatives, including men, women, and children, were either hacked down by double-edged swords or gunned down by AK-47s. Following the sudden massacre, their homes were destroyed and some set on fire. All the relatives were killed except for one survivor—a little girl whose mother managed to hide her just behind a window blind. Her name is Nanpa. Nanpa's father, mother, and four siblings were gruesomely murdered. Miraculously, she did not make a single noise as her father, mother, and siblings were



slaughtered by these very wicked and evil terrorists. The following day, after the terrorists had wreaked their havoc, Nanpa was rescued. When she was picked up, she was soaked from her feet to her shoulders in the blood of her parents and siblings that had flowed to where she was hiding.

Nanpa's story touched many hearts and made many cry. When a head pastor (whom we are supporting to train former Muslims to be followers of Jesus) and his wife visited the IDP camp where Nanpa was, they knew that they had to take her with them. Later, Nanpa was adopted by the pastor and his wife. When they thought the chapter of having more children was closed, God

brought them this little girl. When she was first brought into their home, she would awaken every night in terror, but through love, she has become a happy little girl again.

Far Reaching Ministries has been involved in supporting over 100 former Muslims who have converted to Christianity. Most of them had witnessed Christians be tortured and killed for the name of Christ when they refused to deny their faith. The former Muslims had seen the evil of Islam and murder and wanted nothing to do with it. They also witnessed the love and forgiveness Christians had. After leaving Islam, they were inspired to not only follow Christ but also to be trained to become missionaries. All they asked for was training and \$50 a month so they could eat while sharing their faith. What is even more remarkable was that they wanted to go back to their people, knowing that they could very well suffer torture and death. Some missionaries spoke of an incident that changed everything for them.

One of the Muslim militants, who had been the biggest killer of Christians, had come to Christ. He knew returning to his people would mean death, but he had counted the cost. An extremist told the new Christian that if he did not return to Islam, he would be tortured and skinned alive. But he told the extremist that he would not deny the One who died for him. The new Christian suffered a long, horrible night of torture, but he never wavered. The Muslims who watched said no man could have endured if God had not been with him. This act of torture backfired when over 100 of them converted to Christ after watching this brother sacrifice himself so others might know the Lord. And they have chosen to be willing to suffer the same fate.

South Sudan Operations:

We have lost two more men in South Sudan. One was Samson Ohiede, who was a great brother in the Lord. He had been sent to South Africa to train as a pilot for transport planes and as a fighter pilot. I had known him for at least 20 years, since he was a young man. He was flying passengers into Darfur from the United Arab Emirates, Canada, and the United States. As his plane

that. I may not yet know how to save these women, but I believe the Lord can give us a plan, and with prayer and determination, these women can be freed.

I am pursuing a meeting with members of the Trump administration. The new Syrian president, Ahmad al-Sharaa, desperately wants U.S. sanctions lifted. If America insisted that every abducted woman be returned before sanctions are even considered, I believe we would see quick results.




God may already be opening doors. A former F-35 fighter pilot, now a top-level official and regular guest on Tucker Carlson and Fox News, supports Far Reaching Ministries. I spoke with him, and he is committed to helping. If diplomacy fails, and I have to buy these women's freedom, I will. Please pray with me; I believe in a God who makes a way when there is none.

Since leaving Ukraine, I have committed to praying daily that God would bring an end to Putin's slaughter. For the next 40 days, would you join me personally and pray every evening with your family at dinner?

The suffering is deep and widespread. A female staff member's brother was recently killed at the front, and she and her family are in tremendous pain. Over 70,000 Ukraine soldiers are missing in action, and their wives are waiting in anguish for husbands who may never return because 99% will never be found. Without confirmation




of death, the family receives no compensation for their loved ones. One woman keeps paying her husband's phone bill, calling it daily, hoping he will answer, but he never does.

When a father dies in Ukraine, they say the family dies. Chaplains bring hope, but the weight is crushing. One mother told me her body feels like an open wound, but she goes on only for her children's sake.

In Sudan's Nuba Mountains, once again, the Islamic north is trying to take what is not theirs. Fighting has intensified, and our chaplains are under fire again. I received a video from the frontline—one man's head was gone from the chin up, and another man's body was missing from the waist up. This year alone, we have lost three more chaplains—bringing our total to over 70 who have died in service to Christ. South Sudan continues to suffer; food is scarce, and the need has become critically urgent.

I have been praying about writing a book for Ukrainian soldiers. I would probably call it *Living in the Valley of the Shadow of Death*. Next year, I will have been in South Sudan for 30 years, and I have a wealth of



In the Hope We Will Save a People Group from Extinction

Before you read this newsletter, I want to warn you that what we are sharing is beyond shocking. And if you cannot handle this, then do not read on, then call and complain.

Luke, who served internationally for 33 years, is a former Marine officer and FBI agent in intelligence. His expertise is in counterterrorism, international operations, rapid deployment, and special operations, with SEALs, Raiders, Delta, and Tier One operators. Needless to say, I give Luke difficult and critical operations. One of his key contacts is a Druze man and his family in Israel. When Luke was in the FBI, he had three immersions in the Middle East for both learning Arabic and intelligence to deal with terrorists. One of those immersions was when he met a Druze family. In Israel, the Druze community is a distinct group that neither identifies as Jewish nor Muslim but is allied with Israel and is said to have a

special "Blood-Bond" with the Jewish nation. They are citizens of Israel who serve in the Israeli military and pay taxes. They describe themselves as Muwahadin, coming from the Arabic and Hebrew word meaning as one. They share some roots with Abraham, Moses, and Muhammad, and became a new faith in the eleventh century.



Pray that we can disciple them and provide them with outreach opportunities.
