

“Be Patient” James 5:1-20 11/03/24

Today, we'd like to see the title of “Be Patient” in James 5:1-20.

To the souls on this Online Word *through Podcast or YouTube Channel*, on the earth, we'd like to suggest the 3 expositional Questions. (_____ **Maranatha Worship Songs**; Videos are watchable upon the click on the website).

Q1. In verse 1 Come now, *you* rich, weep and howl for your miseries that are coming upon *you!* what does it mean in the context? And how can we apply it to our lives?

Q2. In verse 7, “Therefore be patient, brethren, until the coming of the Lord. See *how* the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth, waiting patiently for it until it receives the early and latter rain,” what does it mean? And what can we learn from here?

Q3. In verse 15, “And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven,” what does it mean? And how can we learn from here?

(Background for context of this text on Daily Bible Reading and Studying Weekly Book Basis)

The Book of James emphasizes faith and its consequent doing because the doing proves the faith. In the last time, in James 4:17, “Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do *it*, to him it is sin, “ here is the nonfeasance or omission not to do it according to God's word to do good; Your violation of God's word is sin upon whatever misfeasance, nonfeasance, commission, or omission is, where the Lord gives you the free will, talents, and an open door *Rev 3:7*.

TEXT: NKJV [KJV]

Inductive **Explanation** in context & syntax

¹Come now, *you* rich, weep and howl for your miseries that are coming upon *you!*

¹=Q1 (Come now, you rich people, weep and groan for your miseries which are coming upon you. In the context, God warns the rich people who would oppress the least such as the poor, the fatherless, the widow, or the alien because they trust the richness, treasure, or money. They are not the poor people in spirit or not the rich people to give away to the least. The richness, treasure, or money is not per se evil but the love of it is evil. When Jesus returns, it is not needed as a tool, although today's capitalism society needs it, especially money, as a tool. A rich man who trusts in richness to enter the kingdom of God is harder than a camel to go through the eye of a needle because he doesn't trust in the Lord Jesus Christ the Savior. With man it's impossible, but with God all things are possible. So the warning to the rich man is that the miseries are going to come upon you. *Mat 25:40; Deu 24:19; Mat 5:3; 1 Tim 6:10; Isaiah 55:1; Luke 18:25-27*)

¹ *Mat 25:40* And the King will answer and say to them, ‘Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did *it* to one of the least of these My brethren, you did *it* to Me; *Deu 24:19* When you reap your harvest in your field, and forget a sheaf in the field, you shall not go back to get it; it shall be for the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, that the Lord your God may bless you in all the work of your hands. *Mat 5:3* Blessed *are* the poor in spirit, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven; *1 Tim 6:10* For the love of money is a root of all *kinds* of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows; *Isaiah 55:1* Ho! Everyone who thirsts, Come to the waters; And you who have no money, Come, buy and eat. Yes, come, buy wine and milk Without **money** and without price; *Luke 18:25-27* For it is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom

<p>² Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are moth-eaten.</p> <p>³ Your gold and silver are corroded, and their corrosion will be a witness against you and will eat your flesh like fire. You have heaped up treasure in the last days.</p> <p>⁴ Indeed the wages of the laborers who mowed your fields, which you kept back by fraud, cry out; and the cries of the reapers have reached the ears of the Lord of Sabaoth.</p> <p>⁵ You have lived on the earth in pleasure and luxury; you have fattened your hearts as in a day of slaughter. ⁶ You have condemned, you have murdered the just; he does not resist you.</p> <p>⁷ Therefore be patient, brethren, until the coming of the Lord. See <i>how</i> the farmer [husbandman] waits for the precious fruit of the earth, waiting patiently for it until it receives the early and latter rain.</p>	<p>2= (In the time of the early church which was agricultural age, not industrial age or digital age, the rich people had great barns filled with corn and grain. Your storage of corn and grain is rotten by mice as well as your garments are eaten by moth. The perishable things can't stand forever.)</p> <p>3=(On the great white throne judgment, anyone not found written in the Book of Life including the rich person who trusts in richness, not in the Lord Jesus Christ the Savior, ultimately is being cast into the lake of fire. Then your gold and silver are melted away against your possession. And you are going to cast into the lake of fire. <i>Rev 20:14-15</i>²)</p> <p>4=(You hold back the wages of the workers for your fields by intentional lie. The Lord of Sabbath has heard of their cries. God is very interested in the least people such as the poor, the fatherless, the widow, or the alien. Before the sun goes down, you shall pay the daily hired person, who is poor and needy. You shall pay the wage on time without cheating. God will come near for judgment against those who exploit wage earners. So, James speaks here how they hold back from the wages that are due and how that the Lord will hear their cry. <i>Deu 24:14-15; Lev 19:13; Mal 3:5</i>³)</p> <p>5-6= (That's the kind of wealth that James is speaking out against those who would oppress the poor and have ill-gotten gains. Those will not escape God's judgment.)</p> <p>7= Q2 (The patience or longsuffering is a character of Agape love the fruit of the Holy Spirit. In the agricultural age of the early church, there were no irrigation systems in Israel but depended upon the rain. In the feast of first fruits on 1/16 the Jewish lunar Calendar or around April, the latter rain comes. It refers Jesus' resurrection. In the feast of trumpet on 7/1 the Jewish lunar Calendar, the new lunar year, or around October, the early rain comes. It refers to "the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit," i.e., to the power of the Holy Spirit. A farmer waits patiently for the former and the latter rains for his crops. Likewise a Christian lives by faith patiently, not wandering faith, for the precious rewards when he or she meets the Lord, either in death or in rapture in verse 8. <i>Gal 5:22-23; Lev 23:10-11; 1 Cor 15:20; Lev 23:24; Tit 3:5</i>⁴)</p>
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of God." ²⁶ And those who heard it said, "Who then can be saved?" ²⁷ But He said, "The things which are impossible with men are possible with God."

² *Rev 20:14-15* Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. ¹⁵ And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.

³ *Deu 24:14-15* You shall not oppress a hired servant *who* is poor and needy, *whether* one of your brethren or one of the aliens who *is* in your land within your gates. ¹⁵ Each day you shall give *him* his wages, and not let the sun go down on it, for he *is* poor and has set his heart on it; lest he cry out against you to the Lord, and it be sin to you; *Lev 19:13* You shall not cheat your neighbor, nor rob *him*. The wages of him who is hired shall not remain with you all night until morning; *Mal 3:5* And I will come near you for judgment; I will be a swift witness Against sorcerers, Against adulterers, Against perjurers, Against those who exploit wage earners and widows and orphans, And against those who turn away an alien— Because they do not fear Me," Says the Lord of hosts.

⁴ *Gal 5:22-23* But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law; *Lev 23:10-11* Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: 'When you come into the land which I give to you, and reap its harvest, then you shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest to the priest. ¹¹ He shall wave the sheaf before the Lord, to be accepted on your behalf; on the day after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it; *1 Cor 15:20* But now Christ is risen from the dead, *and* has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep; *Lev 23:24* Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'In the seventh month, on the first *day* of the month, you shall have a sabbath-rest, a memorial of blowing of trumpets, a

<p>⁸ You also be patient. Establish your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand.</p> <p>⁹ Do not grumble against one another, brethren, lest you be condemned. Behold, the Judge is standing at the door!</p> <p>¹⁰ My brethren, take the prophets, who spoke in the name of the Lord, as an example of suffering and patience. ¹¹ Indeed we count them blessed who endure. You have heard of the perseverance of Job and seen the end <i>intended by the Lord</i>—that the Lord is very compassionate and merciful.</p>	<p>8= (We as Christians reveal God's righteousness in the gospel of Christ by living from faith to faith patiently for the precious – not burned -- rewards when the Lord is coming near. We are one day to the closer to the return of Jesus Christ, than we were yesterday. <i>Rom 1:16-17; 1 Cor 3:14-15⁵</i>.)</p> <p>9= (Grumbling, contention, or dissension is the work of the flesh against God, being subject to His judgment, and so we should live in the Spirit not in the flesh. Divine joy comes from each truly fellowship with the Father and with His Son, Jesus Christ, naturally overflowing our relationship with family and others. And so, the grumbling, contention, or dissension causes us to lose the joy of the blessings that God has bestowed. <i>Gal 5:19-21; Rom 8:7-8; Gal 5:24-26; 1 John 1:3-4⁶</i>)</p> <p>10= (Stephen was speaking in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ before the Jewish counsel, "Which of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? And they killed those who foretold the coming of the Just One..." They stoned him to death. Also Moses, Elijah, Isaiah, Jeremiah, or other prophets suffered stoned, sawn, slain, afflicted, tormented or wandered in deserts, but kept faith patiently. These are an example of suffering and patience. <i>Acts 7:52-53, 58; Heb 11:37-40⁷</i>)</p> <p>11= (Even if Job lost his possession, children, and health, he kept the faith in the Lord despite Satan's temptation, resulting in his opening his spiritual eye or seeing the Lord, and his blessings of domestic animals and many children given intentionally by the Lord who is very compassionate and merciful – The Lord forgave Job's several doubts of God. <i>Job 1:19-21; Job 2:7-10; Job 42:5, 12-13⁸</i>)</p>
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holy convocation; *Tit 3:5* not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, through the washing of regeneration and renewing of the Holy Spirit,

⁵ *Rom 1:16-17* For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek. ¹⁷ For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith; *1 Cor 3:14-15* If anyone's work which he has built on *it* endures, he will receive a reward. ¹⁵ If anyone's work is burned, he will suffer loss; but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.

⁶ *Gal 5:19-21* Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, ²⁰ idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, ²¹ envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told *you* in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God; *Rom 8:7-8* Because the carnal mind *is* enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be. ⁸ So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God. *Gal 5:24-26* And those *who are* Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. ²⁵ If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. ²⁶ Let us not become conceited, provoking one another, envying one another; *1 John 1:3-4* that which we have seen and heard we declare to you, that you also may have fellowship with us; and truly our fellowship *is* with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ. ⁴ And these things we write to you that your joy may be full.

⁷ *Acts 7:52-53, 58* ⁵² Which of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? And they killed those who foretold the coming of the Just One, of whom you now have become the betrayers and murderers, ⁵³ who have received the law by the direction of angels and have not kept *it*. ⁵⁸ and they cast *him* out of the city and stoned *him*. And the witnesses laid down their clothes at the feet of a young man named Saul; *Heb 11:37-40* They were stoned, they were sawn in two, were tempted, were slain with the sword. They wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins, being destitute, afflicted, tormented— ³⁸ of whom the world was not worthy. They wandered in deserts and mountains, *in* dens and caves of the earth. ³⁹ And all these, having obtained a good testimony through faith, did not receive the promise, ⁴⁰ God having provided something better for us, that they should not be made perfect apart from us.

⁸ *Job 1:19-21* and suddenly a great wind came from across the wilderness and struck the four corners of the house, and it fell on the young people, and they are dead; and I alone have escaped to tell you!" ²⁰ Then Job arose, tore his robe, and shaved his head; and he fell to the ground and worshiped. ²¹ And he said: "Naked I came from my mother's womb, And naked shall I return there. The Lord gave, and the Lord has taken away; Blessed be the name of the Lord."; *Job 2:7-10* So Satan went out from the presence of the Lord, and struck Job with painful boils from the sole of his foot to the crown of his head. ⁸ And he took for himself a potsherd with which to scrape himself while he sat in the midst of the ashes. ⁹ Then his wife said to him, "Do you still hold fast to your integrity? Curse God and die!"

¹⁰ But he said to her, "You speak as one of the foolish women speaks. Shall we indeed accept good from God, and shall we not accept adversity?" In all this Job did not sin with his lips; *Job 42:5, 12-13* ⁵ "I have heard of You by the hearing of the ear, But now my eye sees You. ¹² Now the Lord blessed the latter *days* of Job more than his beginning; for he had fourteen thousand sheep, six thousand camels, one thousand yoke of oxen, and one thousand female donkeys. ¹³ He also had seven sons and three daughters.

<p>12 But above all, my brethren, do not swear, either by heaven or by earth or with any other oath. But let your “Yes” be “Yes,” and your “No,” “No,” lest you fall into judgment.</p> <p>13 Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing psalms.</p> <p>14 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.</p> <p>15 And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.</p> <p>16 Confess <i>your</i> trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much.</p>	<p>12= (We don't know the future and so you should say whatever your present status of knowledge is, let your Yes be Yes and your No be No. For whatever is more than these is from the evil one. A character of God is honesty. E.g. How about a white lie or a lie for good? It's no room of God's character. And so to keep silent is better than to lie in such an unavoidable situation. <i>Mat 5:34-37; Heb 6:18⁹</i>)</p> <p>13=(Upon suffering, you may pray to the Lord because prayer begins with the Lord. When you are joyful, praise the Lord with the songs of which words are psalms or words of God in the Scripture, from freshly heart. A song from freshly heart is called as a new song. <i>Ps 33:3; Eph 5:19-21¹⁰</i>)</p> <p>14= (Jesus had 3 main ministries – teaching, preaching, and healing. So the prayer for the sick to be healed is an important ministry for church. The healer is always the Lord but God doesn't heal everybody. We don't know but that's God's business. The oil was used with medicine to wounds and with a symbol of the Spirit of God to anoint kings. Even today people praying – elders, pastors, or ministers -- anoint the sick with oil as the symbol of the Spirit. <i>Mat 9:35; Luke 10:33-34; 1 Sam 16:13¹¹</i>)</p> <p>15= Q3 (The prayer of faith means the faith of the people praying, not the faith of the sick person. The Lord will raise him up, showing the healer is the Lord. If the sick person has committed sins, showing that not every sickness is caused by a sin, he will be forgiven. E.g. the paralytic whose sins were forgiven and who was risen up by the Lord; the blind, not caused by a sin, was healed to reveal the works of the Lord <i>Mat 9:2;6-7 John 9:2-3¹²</i>)</p> <p>16= (If you commit a sin, you may pray and directly confess to the Lord for forgiveness. If you commit a sin against an individual, you should ask him or her to forgive you and pray for one another. If your sin affects the church, you should confess it publicly and pray for one another. The effective and fervent prayer is the earnest prayer in verse 17, i.e., prayer is serious because of your communication with the Lord..)</p>
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⁹ *Mat 5:34-37* But I say to you, do not swear at all: neither by heaven, for it is God's throne; ³⁵ nor by the earth, for it is His footstool; nor by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King. ³⁶ Nor shall you swear by your head, because you cannot make one hair white or black. ³⁷ But let your 'Yes' be 'Yes,' and your 'No,' 'No.' For whatever is more than these is from the evil one; *Heb 6:18* that by two immutable things, in which it is impossible for God to lie, we might have strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold of the hope set before us..

¹⁰ *Ps 33:3* Sing to Him a new song; Play skillfully with a shout of joy.; *Eph 5:19-21* speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, ²⁰ giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, ²¹ submitting to one another in the fear of God.

¹¹ *Mat 9:35* Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people; *Luke 10:33-34* But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was. And when he saw him, he had compassion. ³⁴ So he went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine; and he set him on his own animal, brought him to an inn, and took care of him; *1 Sam 16:13* Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers; and the Spirit of the Lord came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel arose and went to Ramah.

¹² *Mat 9:2,6-7* ²Then behold, they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, “Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you;” ⁶ But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins—then He said to the paralytic, “Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house.” ⁷ And he arose and departed to his house. *John 9:2-3* And His disciples asked Him, saying, “Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?” ³ Jesus answered, “Neither this man nor his parents sinned, but that the works of God should be revealed in him.

<p>17 Elijah was a man with a nature like ours [like passions as we are], and he prayed earnestly that it would not rain; and it did not rain on the land for three years and six months.</p> <p>18 And he prayed again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth produced its fruit.</p> <p>19 Brethren, if anyone among you wanders [err] from the truth, and someone turns him back,</p> <p>20 let him know that he who turns a sinner from the error of his way will save a soul from death and cover a multitude of sins.</p>	<p>17= (The sincere prayer of a man who lives by faith is answered much by the Lord, such as Elijah. Elijah's nature is like ours. Elijah had lived by faith. His prayer for no rain on the land for 3.5 years was answered by the Lord.)</p> <p>18=(Elija climbed on the top of mount Carmel, bowed down on the ground and prayed for rain. Then it was a heavy rain. <i>1 Kings 18:42-45</i>¹³)</p> <p>19= (Brothers in Christ. The truth is Jesus. The entirety of His word is truth. If anyone turns the person who wanders from the truth to righteousness or life by faith, he will be given incorruptible rewards by the Lord like the a star forever and ever. <i>John 14:6; Psalm 119:160; Dan 12:3; Rom 10:17</i>¹⁴)</p> <p>20=(When he brings an unbeliever back to the Lord through the gospel of Christ, the unbeliever is saved from eternal death and is cleansed from a multitude of his known sins and all his unrighteousness. Let the one bringing know that. <i>1 John 1:9</i>¹⁵)</p>
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Note: Most Christians say the Bible is important, but rarely study every word in the Bible and commit it to the Lord. So, it's better to study it and live accordingly after the Spirit for the Lord (2 Tim 2:15). This online word for global crusade in effect develops from the expository sermon (KJV), into spiritual transformation in daily love fellowship with the Lord throughout the Bible Study (NKJV) -- *All Scripture Expository Study from verse by verse Inductive Studies* -- of which application is the Discipleship and Spiritual Formation, closer to the image of Christ. Also the whole verses of NIV as a reference are observed equally to KJV and NKJV for every online word. We think that "Any human opinion is not really important rather than what God says. So, the best commentary on the Bible is the Bible per se. But the opinion to make us understand God's Word is acceptable (2 Corinthians 10:5)." Further, for the application, a life or spiritual experience might be helpful to understand how to apply an understood word in the text column, but it is temperately used like Paul, because nobody should think above that literal experience (2 Cor 12:6, Jer 23:28; Ne 8:8).

¹³ *1 Kings 18:42-45* So Ahab went up to eat and drink. And Elijah went up to the top of Carmel; then he bowed down on the ground, and put his face between his knees, ⁴³ and said to his servant, "Go up now, look toward the sea." So he went up and looked, and said, "There is nothing." And seven times he said, "Go again."

⁴⁴ Then it came to pass the seventh time, that he said, "There is a cloud, as small as a man's hand, rising out of the sea!" So he said, "Go up, say to Ahab, 'Prepare your chariot, and go down before the rain stops you.'"

⁴⁵ Now it happened in the meantime that the sky became black with clouds and wind, and there was a heavy rain. So Ahab rode away and went to Jezreel.

¹⁴ *John 14:6* Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me; *Psalm 119:160* The entirety of Your word is truth, And every one of Your righteous judgments endures forever; *Dan 12:3*. Those who are wise shall shine Like the brightness of the firmament, And those who turn many to righteousness Like the stars forever and ever; *Rom 10:17*. So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

¹⁵ *1 John 1:9* If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

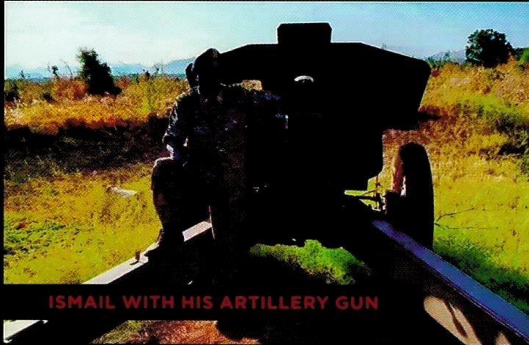

God could deliver him. Ismail said that if God can heal me from this, He is real, and I will follow him and he did.

In one particular battle Ismail was in, his unit was being attacked by 700 Islamic enemy soldiers and his unit had only 100 men. His unit was told to attack even though they were greatly outnumbered, but he said, "Today is Sunday. Let us pray this whole day and seek our God that He will be with us." So, all the soldiers spent the

day in prayer. The next day, Ismail took his artillery gun and fired seven shots; all seven hit critical enemy positions, and within a few minutes, the enemy was in full retreat leaving the area and did not return. The men spent the day giving thanks to the Lord for His deliverance. Ismail was known for many great feats of heroism, once capturing 16 enemy soldiers and three trucks full of military supplies. On another occasion, his position was hit by a surface-to-air missile (SAM) that killed over 100 soldiers and 30 civilians. Once again, Ismail escaped uninjured, and the people said it was because of his relationship with Christ that he was delivered.

I am at the chaplain base as this letter is being written. We sent for Ismail's wife to be brought from the Nuba

Mountains to the base. We will do our best to comfort her in her grief and give her the stipend that we give for each fallen chaplain, which can take care of her for years.

Ismail was around 55 years of age and served in the war for 37 years. In his life, he had brought many men and

women to Christ. He had planted a church in a radical Muslim area where the people were some of the most violent, but to this day, his church is still alive with over 200 converted Muslims.

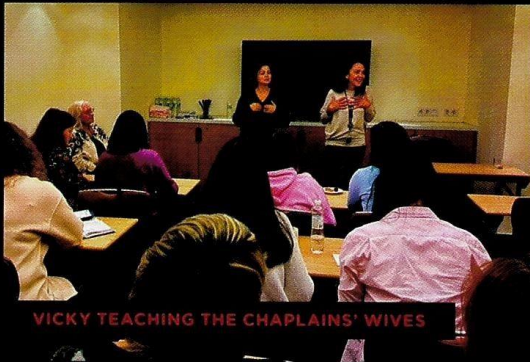
He never knew the comforts of this world but will know great peace throughout eternity, having given his all to protect his people and serve Christ.

Please understand we plan on starting what does not exist in Ukraine, and when we find children who are being abused by parents, we will not allow it to continue. When the laws of the land do not protect women and children, we, as believers, answer to a higher law, God's law, and will do what is necessary to ensure these children are not harmed by parents or anyone, such as a boyfriend.

In March of last year, we wrote about children who were being sexually abused in Central and South America, and I was truly stunned by how the body of Christ responded. It was far beyond what I ever expected. Because the response was so tremendous, many children are being rescued, but now we need people to come alongside and help us build the infrastructure to save children in Ukraine. You can sign up for a monthly amount of whatever you feel led to give. It could be \$25, \$50, \$75 or \$100. And if you can give far more because of how God has blessed you, we welcome the gift and assure you that these funds will be used solely for this project. I want to let you know that as we begin this project, we cannot send you a biography and photo of a specific child. Once we have children in our care, we will send you information about a child for whom you can pray. So please consider joining us in the rescue of these children.

Hopefully, in time, we will have the ability to facilitate adoptions. It would be my heart's desire that the homes would be a place of love until we can find a family that will care for these children.

Folks, I have some investments that should bring a great return in the next couple of years, and if the Lord blesses I will willingly give it to care for these children.

The Bible says in Psalm 68:5-6 that He is a father to the fatherless and sets the lonely in families.

We will actively seek to follow every lead to find the children who are abandoned and abused. A few years ago, a couple was arrested, and when the police came, they found that the couple had a little girl. When the officers asked her what her name was, she responded, "Stupid." The child had a black eye and deep-purple

WHEN MY HEART IS OVERWHELMED

I have too much to share once again but let me just give you an update on Afghanistan first.

On our Afghanistan operation, we have rescued around 2,700 individuals. During this operation, we raised about \$5.5 million, but we will have spent close to \$6.5 million by the time our last refugees are safely resettled. Brent came to me and asked what I wanted to do when the money had run out, and I told him that we would spend what was needed to get every last person the Lord had entrusted us with to relocate to a safe country. For all of you who have given, thank you, I believe you have touched the heart of God. And I would like to give a special thanks to North Country Chapel for helping to save so many lives. Far Reaching Ministries is in the final stages of shutting down operations in Afghanistan.

In March, Luke, Vicky, and I were at the chaplain refresher course in Ukraine. The time was far better than

I could have imagined. We had brought eight pastors from the U.S., most had been with us the last time men like Pastor Lloyd Pulley, Pastor James Class, and Pastor David Mercer to name a few. The fact that many of us returned had great meaning to the Ukrainians. One of

the chaplains said that the last year had been "hell on earth". And when he was traveling with his family, his son said, "Dad, where are we going?" His father replied, "Paradise!" I was told that the Radisson Resort we were staying at, in

the Carpathian Mountains, was considered by many Ukrainians to be a once in a lifetime destination. One brother told me that if you had stayed at this resort, you had arrived and were considered to have lived a life worth living. It was a nice hotel, but by U.S. standards it would be considered average. But for our chaplains and their families, these retreats are a great blessing.

After the conference the pastors traveled back to the U.S.,

Second, I want to share an update on our orphanage project in Ukraine. We have found a great location that is even better than the first. It not only has room for an orphanage but future Bible school as well as a chaplain base. The property is seven acres and has a natural waterway. When the owner found out believers from the U.S. wanted to help Ukrainian orphans, he lowered the price from \$180,000 to \$140,000. We have raised the complete amount to purchase the property so that the next phase will be the construction of the first dorm for 100 children. For another \$250,000, we will be able to complete a kitchen and cafeteria, and the new children's dorm. We have already raised the first \$100,000 and only need another \$150,000 to complete the initial phase of



the project. One of the ideas is to build the buildings in an Austrian or German Bavarian style so that the children will grow up in a beautiful home and have many happy memories.

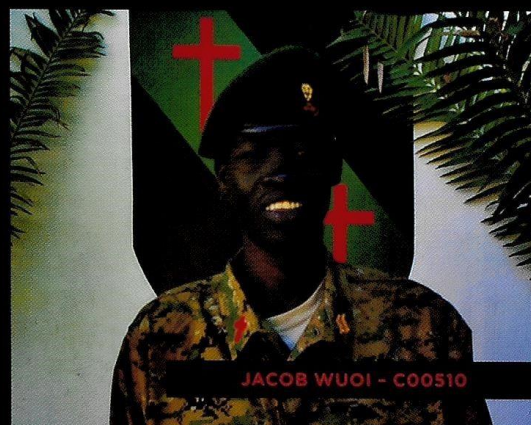

We are also looking for pastors to come to Ukraine to train the chaplains.

The third thing I need to share is that Far Reaching Ministries (FRM) has shipped a container of Bibles into China. We can share no details so as not to hamper future operations.

The fourth thing we must report is the loss of two more chaplains—Chaplain Jacob Wuoi and Chaplain John Ebele. With the death of three more chaplains in the last year, this brings the total to 76 chaplains lost since the beginning of the ministry.



Jacob joined the chaplaincy program in 2019. He fell ill one evening and was gone by morning. Being in South Sudan, he was buried the next day, and whatever took him, we will never know. Jacob had graduated in Class 11 and served for four years before he was summoned home by our Lord Jesus Christ.

Q 1. How many members or offerings are at CCAH?

A 1. People say, "How many people have been saved?" we don't know, but God knows, although we acknowledge that God has arranged over 1,000 units of communities, 7 sober living facilities, over 200 units of veteran community, KJV English & RVR Spanish Bibles & 200 lunches per week for the homeless, and over a million online visitors (Mat 25:40 "unto one of the least of these"). It doesn't matter. It's something we leave the numbers with God. He knows those that are His and that's the important thing (e.g. David's motive for census in 1 Chro 21:1). Therefore, we don't worry about the numbers of the members and of tithes and offerings because the Lord has given the increase, He has added them to CCAH so far (1 Cor 3:7; Acts 2:47; 2 Sam 24:1-3), not as we have done at all, and CCAH is His own church (souls), the Lord's church, "Jesus is all in all," purchased with His blood (Mat 16:18; 1 Cor 6:20; Acts 20:28). Since His foolishness is wiser than men, such as all men's visions/ plans/ programs (1 Cor 1:25; Zechariah 4:6), and His thoughts unto each soul are more in number than the sand (Psalm 139:17-18), we are just active obedient followers of the Lord, venturing out in faith, "**Let CCAH go, let God.**"

And if you did indeed receive the increase, why do you boast as if you had not received it? (1 Cor 4:7) For we are not, as so many, peddling the word of God; but as of sincerity, but as from God, we speak in the sight of God in Christ (2 Cor 2:17), CCAH continues faithfully in teaching the entire Bible simply without alteration, fellowship, communion, and prayers, being the witnesses to Christ, powered with the Spirit, in Jerusalem, all Judea, Samaria, and to the end of the earth (Acts 1:8; 2:42, 47). The truth the Word of God matters wherever - offline, indoor, outdoor, online, at sea, or in sky - and whenever - Sunday, Saturday, weekday, every day, this generation time, or the future generation time (John 5:39; 17:17). The truth shall make us free (John 8:32), from where Christ is named, where commercial capitalism is controlling, where territorial boundaries are lined, or where racial, material, or hereditary partiality underscores. Every Christian is exhorted to go to church at any convenient place unless she is against "the principles of doctrine of Christ" (Heb 6:1) because of "one church (Ekklesia) on the earth" (Eph 1:22-23). Touchable over 1,000 souls by offline and foreseeable over 1 million souls by online at CCAH are being fed by the whole counsel of God throughout the Spirit, living by every His word (1 John 2:27; Luke 4:4). CCAH does care about each soul because we believe that everybody is impartially created by God in His image (Gen 1:26) -- regardless of race, gender, age, wealth, or education such as Caucasian, male, youth, rich, Ivy league graduate, or not-- and that the eternal value of each soul is much greater than the value of any material/ temporal/ perishable things on the earth (James 3:17; Mat 16:26). When God leads, God provides (1 Chronicles 22:11). So, we don't seek money because it follows the faith in the almighty Lord by the love of God. Therefore, we never ask people for money, but would offer what we have to the Lord and pray Him to handle the issues (like Andrew rather than Philip in John 6:6-9). Individually, we can discern our each mind before the Lord, as how much love for Him can be observed (1) by the money index to divide willing expenditures to God by total expenditures (Luke 12:34; 21:2-3), as well as (2) by how much the words of God we love (John 1:1). We know that any offering to God without willing mind is not accepted by God (2 Cor 8:12). The public love money especially in capitalism society because without money capitalism would not exist. However, we as Christians should not love money but should know its nature (1 Timothy 6:10). CCAH has been controlled not by money even in the capitalism society but by sovereign almighty God. The foundation of CCAH finance has begun from a homeless person's 2 dime offering to the Lord for CCAH at the Rock Fortress facility. The willing mind part for an offering should always prevail over its money part. An offering box in a church service or a donation button on websites through CCAH is a way to express a donor's love for God by willing donation, the 1st part rather than 2nd money part, according to the Scripture (Mark 12:43; Luke 21:3-4). In fact, the fund raising or the fund seeking is not necessary for CCAH but the Lord seeking is sufficient because God is continually working through His church, CCAH, in Acts 29 (1 Chronicles 28:9; 2 Chronicles 15:1-2). We have spent offerings/donations about 40% for external ministries (for missions in Philipians 4:15-19 & for charity in Matthew 25:40) based upon our faith of "one church (Ekklesia) on the earth" -- the holy universal church, not unholy ecumenical church -- (e.g. 1st Quarter 2014, 43.15%; 4th Quarter 2013, 55.6 %; 3rd Quarter 2013, 20.11%; 2nd Quarter 2013, 55.91%; 1st Quarter, 2013 43.26%; 4th Quarter, 2012 45.57%, etc.), rather than spent them for additional social/cultural/popular internal programs. But about 60% for the internal ministries following the model of the early church in the Book of Acts is spent for sheep to be fed with spiritual food (Galatians 6:6) and for staff (1 Timothy 5:17-18).

CCAHA is **the poor in material and spirit**, but is the rich to give it away for Christ's sake, e.g., about 40% of annual offerings, with the poor hearts in spirit. The Lord is the shepherd of CCAH who is "as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things" (2 Cor 6:10).

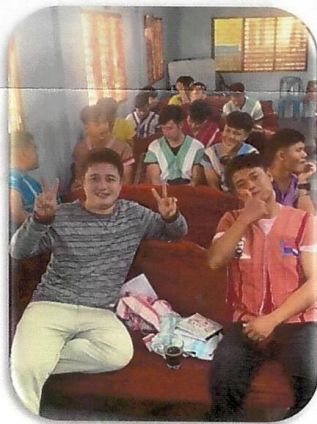
ON OUR WAY TO CLASS A WILD ELEPHANT CROSSED THE ROAD. What a sight! Only tourists want to see wild elephants, not so with the locals, as they can be incredibly destructive, in some cases kill humans. On the Thai/Burma border many elephants come from Burma as they often are poached but are protected in Thailand. The Karen still come in numbers into Thailand for similar reasons being displaced and killed by the Burmese military. Pray for these hurting people.

SORROW GREETES US ON THE BORDER. Two horrific accidents occurred days before we arrived. Poor people often travel in the back of pick-up trucks, this was the case and all in the back were thrown out, 4 died (all young people) most hospitalized. They all lived in the Karen community (18 in one truck, 10 in the other). We became part of the pastoral team, visited 3 hospitals, bringing comfort, prayer and some financial assistance (God provided). Next came the memorial services in which the unbelievers present were all able to hear the message of eternal life available to all who put their trust in Jesus.

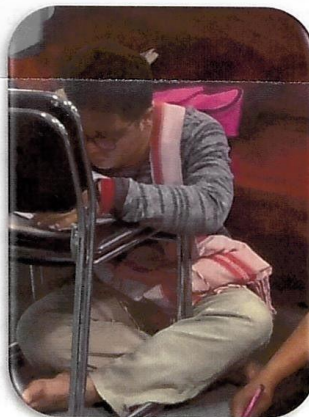


This mother survived the accident, but her son did not.

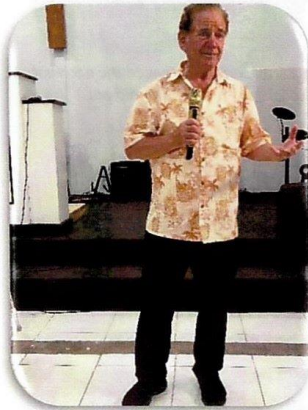

So, when we talk, we just use the word, "M" instead of the whole word. Pray for Christian Indonesians, for boldness in their witness and God's protection.

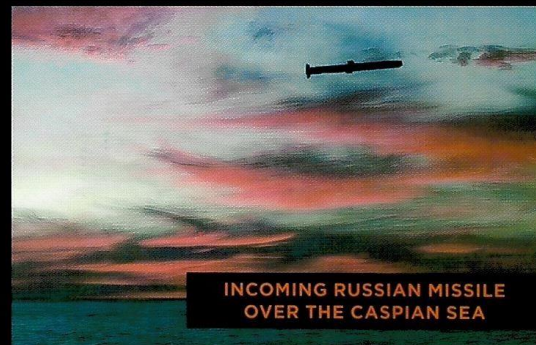
Pray for Ukrainians to be Protected from Explosions and for Peace in Christ

Luke and I met with Ukrainian officers in charge of training their chaplains and showed them pictures of our base and training center in South Sudan. We showed them videos of the chaplain silent drill team we use for evangelical outreach. Just like the Marine Corps silent-drill team, our men do a 15-minute drill without any verbal command. The men then share God's Word, and many soldiers get saved. I am not sure if the officers that Luke and I met with are truly saved, but both were very respectful. At the end of our conversation, the senior officer asked how I would motivate his men as their military is very demoralized.

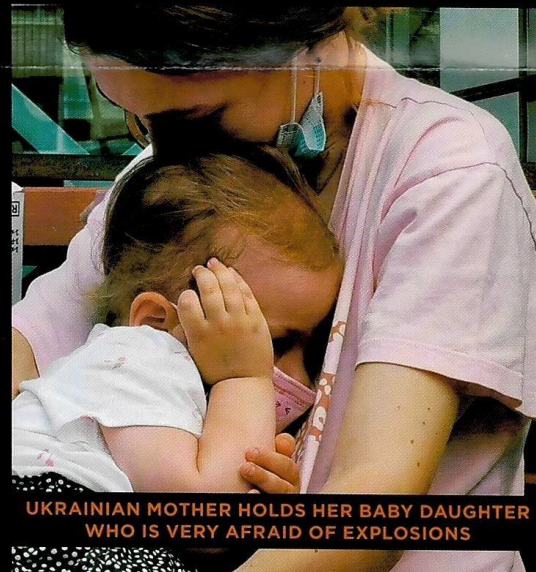


At this moment in our conversation, I knew this was a time to give them something of substance that they could relate to. I said that at the future chaplain training school there would be a large aquarium, and, on the bottom, there would be a sunken battleship with the word Moskva on it. I knew that this would be meaningful to them. You see, at one of the worst times in the war with Russia, when it looked as if all might be lost, Ukraine miraculously got two Neptune missiles working. They fired them at the Moskva, the flagship of the Russian fleet while it was in port, and amazingly, they hit the ship. Not wanting to accept defeat, the Russians pulled the ship out to sea and said it had sunk in heavy seas, but truthfully, it was the damage the Ukrainian army inflicted on the ship that sank it. This was the largest ship in the Russian fleet, and nothing like this has happened since the Second World War. I told the officers about the war in South Sudan and said that we refused to surrender when we were outmanned and outgunned but not outfought, and we won the war. The two men laughed and said that we had a great strategy for encouraging the men. Sometimes, men need to be reminded to never give up and never surrender. They need to understand that they have a God given role to protect women and children, even at the cost of one's life. See folks we do not fear men, we fear the Lord. As men we were made for battle; we were made to protect

those that cannot protect themselves. It is important that Luke and I live trusting the Lord so that those around us can see what true faith looks like. This is why we go to the frontlines. Many times, non-believers do not understand why we would go to such dangerous places, but you see this action opens the door to share about the Lord.



I was in Europe when a Russian missile hit a children's hospital and maternity ward in Ukraine, killing mothers and children. One photo, in particular, troubled me.

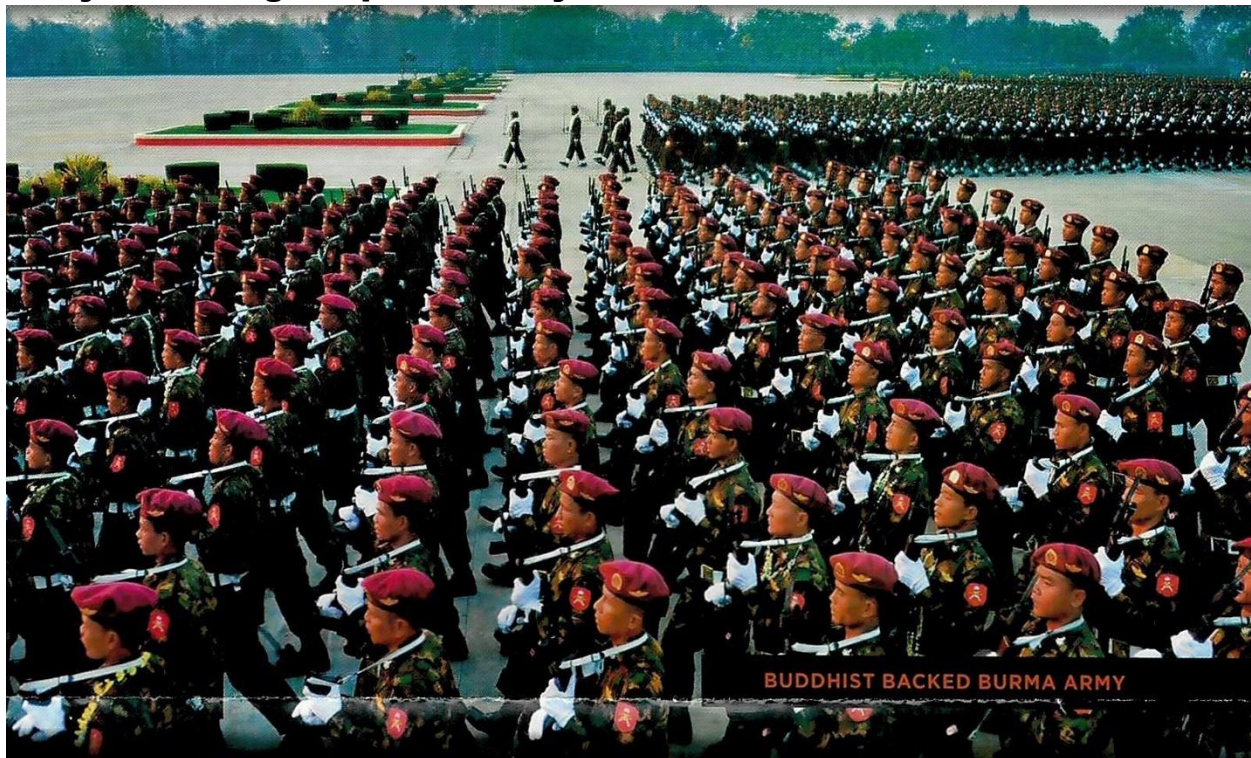

ONE LONG JOURNEY

When I first met Tirza in Russia, it was probably in 1994. She was from the Dutch office of a sister organization, and I was leading a team into the Russian prisons. At that time, I never thought that she would still be in my life 30 years later. When we met, Tirza spoke six languages and worked harder than any two men on my team. Today, she speaks 12 languages. She began working as an assistant to the director of the Dutch office right out of high school and had always worked for minimum wage so as not to be a burden to the ministry. She and her husband, Hans, have been married for 37 years, as he likes to say, because they love each other. Hans wrote for a newspaper, and they humbly lived off his salary.

In the early days in Russia, when I traveled from prison to prison, it was hard to find food. I would go for weeks only eating Borsch, a Russian cabbage and beet soup.

And, often, I would only eat twice a day. When I would return to Moscow after each of my trips, I would run to the only McDonald's in the city to find food. Every month, when I would travel, I would lose at least 20 pounds, but it was never a problem; instead, it was a great joy.

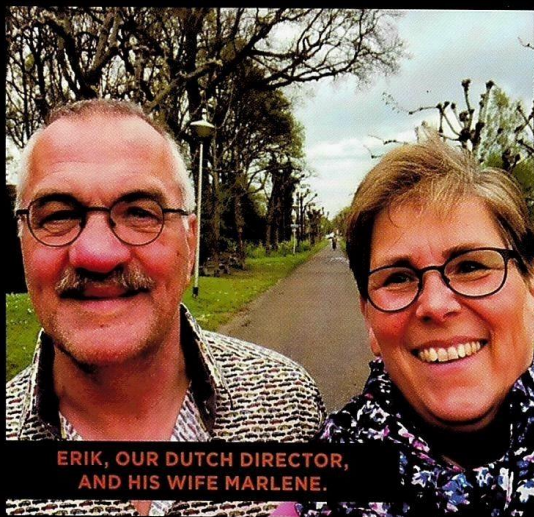

I often traveled with Mark Piester, who also worked alongside Tirza in Holland. Mark, an American, had worked for years smuggling Bibles behind the Iron Curtain. He and I would spend days on trains and buses—going from prison to prison sharing Christ—most of the time in the dead of winter. I would stare out the window for hours, looking at the snow drifts and Russian countryside, but I loved every minute. I never felt alone; it was me and the Lord, and I will always remember it as the most enjoyable time of ministry. Vicky knows the look when she sees me in this state. She always says, “What part of the world are you

planning to conquer next?" I respond back and just say, "I am lost in my thoughts, Love." But she smiles back and says, "You might as well tell me." Which makes me smile at how well she knows her husband. Then I tell her what I believe is God's next plan for the ministry.

Once, I got very sick in Russia and could find no medicine, so I traveled to Holland to stay with Tirza and Hans, and they took great care of me. The Dutch climate during winter is always rainy and overcast, but I did not mind because the rainy weather has always been my favorite. I stayed in the third-story attic of Tirza and Hans's home. The attic had been turned into a nice bedroom with a window that I could open at night and listen to the rain. Tirza made great meals to nurse me back to health. When I got better, we rode bicycles to the Dutch office every morning, and we would stop at a bakery on the way to get something warm. The Dutch bakeries are the best in the world!

Tirza and Hans have been close friends of mine ever since. Hans loved American peanut butter, but it was unavailable in their home country 30 years ago. At the time, I worked at a food bank in America, and they would give me whatever food I wanted to give away. Back then, I had no money, but KLM Airlines would allow me to take two 75-pound boxes with me, so I brought Hans 140 pounds of peanut butter—my way of saying thanks to them for their hospitality. Vicky and I just recently visited them on a trip to Europe.

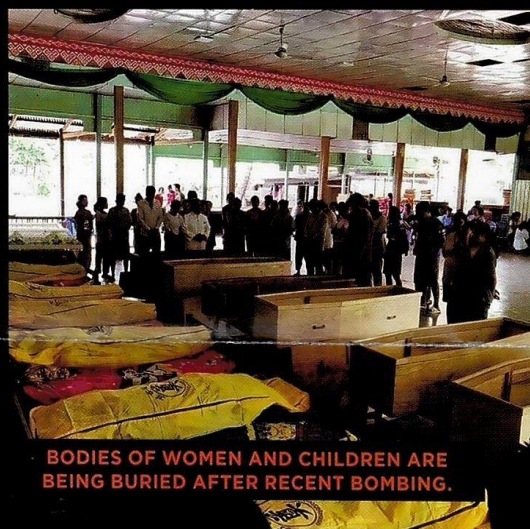

Tirza shared with me that in Burma, the Junta Army is attacking and killing the Karen, Karenni, and Kachin Christian people. They bomb schools and kill for no reason. The Burma Army is Buddhist-backed, which dispels the image of Buddhists as being peace-loving. But the game the soldiers love is the rape of Christian women, often in front of their husband. Many women have been raped by as many as 20 men to the point they pass out and wake up naked hours later to find that their husband was killed during the rape.

One commander raped a woman and then told 20 of his men that if they did not also rape her, he would kill them; the men did as ordered. When she was finally released, the woman went home and told her husband what happened. He was not a good man and kicked her out of the house. Because she was in so much despair, she took her own life. How I wish the woman had met

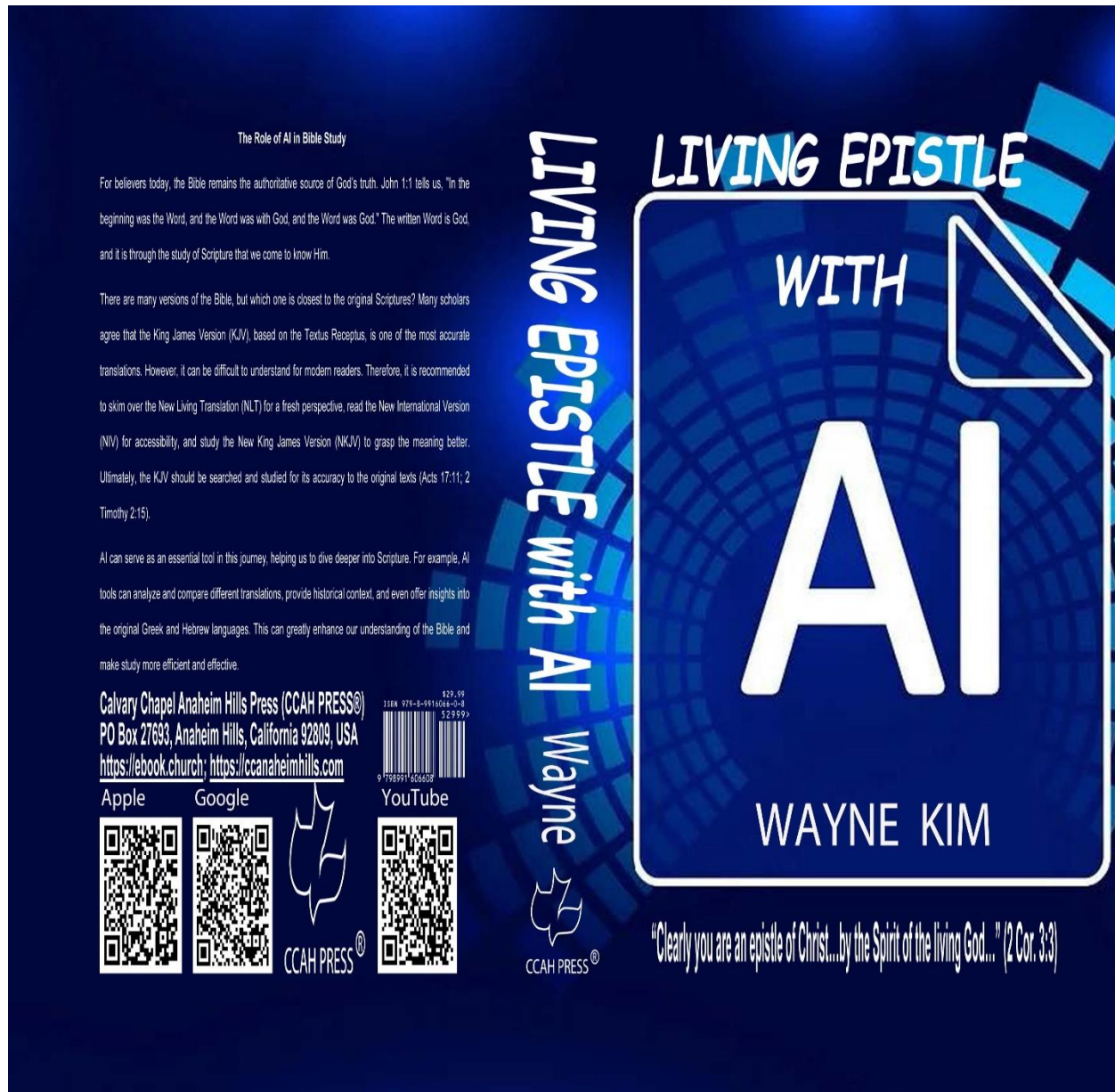
3. A Donation Basket or Online Donation Button as a Reflection of Your Love for God

Jason and Britny came home from the mission field for a couple of years, but both realized that they did not belong in the U.S. They prayed and decided to go and start a new work in the country of Georgia.

Recently, Vicky and I flew into Tbilisi, the capital of Georgia, and Jason picked us up and drove us to the hotel. We were having a pastors' conference with pastors from a closed country to encourage them in their respective ministries. The subject of the conference: Preparing for Persecution.

The country of Georgia is rich in history and in the middle of Tbilisi is a castle that dates back to the year 400 A.D. And the Caspian Mountains are one of the most beautiful mountain ranges I have ever seen. The Georgian flag has five crosses on it to testify to their Christian roots.
