In the last time in Matthew 21: 42, 45-46, "<sup>42</sup> Jesus said to them, Have you never read in the Scriptures: 'The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone. This was the LORD's doing, And it is marvelous in our eyes'? <sup>45</sup>Now when the chief priests and Pharisees heard His parables, they perceived that He was speaking of them. <sup>46</sup> But when they sought to lay hands on Him, they feared the multitudes, because they took Him for a prophet," the chief priests and Pharisees understood the parables, trying to take Jesus. But they feared the people who considered Jesus as a prophet.

No one comes to enter the kingdom of heaven except acceptance of Christ or the faith in the gospel of Jesus Christ. Then, in the gospel, the righteousness is continually revealed from

Omniscient Jesus knew their wicked heart but asked them to show Jesus the tax money, a Roman denarius which was a laborer's daily wage. And Tiberius Caesar image inscribed on the coin indicated that the coin is Caesar's. So, Caesar's is to Caesar and God's is to God. This answer avoided the plot to put Jesus to death because the "Yes" would upset Israelites and the "No" would upset Rome, either answer at the risk of His life. They were marveled, leaving away.)

They asked the hypothetical question of whose wife upon resurrection when she had married consequent husband 7 brothers in decedent order without offspring and she had finally died according to Mosaic law. In OT time, it practiced so because widows had likely no other ways to support themselves without this practice. E.g., Er, Judah's firstborn son, married Tamar. Upon Er's death, Onan, Er's younger brother, was told to marry Tamar by Judah. But a successive marriage rightful man may sell his rights to the other close relative like Boaz the buyer's marriage with Ruth the widow of Mahlon. Gen 38:6-8; Deu 25:5-6; Ruth 4:8-105)

Further, for the application, a life or spiritual experience might be helpful to understand how to apply an understood word in the text column, but it is temperately used like Paul, because nobody should think above that actual experience (2 Cor 12:6, Jer 23:28; Ne 8:8).

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Truth matters, regardless of online, offline, indoor, or outdoor services. The most love of God the truth may be expressed with a donation, regardless of direct, mail, or online ways.





Christianity is real or practical unlike other religions – mystical, theoretical, or impractical, that we may search the references to the Scripture the powerful and living word of God from the archeological discoveries or the history. The used science (the study to prove issue by issue in seen physical world) is a means to know sovereign God's creation and the true word of God, not an end (e.g., DNA test ancestry; "the circle of earth" in Isaiah 40:22). Science should not be overemphasized due to ignorance because science often adopts a hypothesis or theory for a particular issue to be proved by experiments, observations, or simulations with probability 95% (5% error), 99% (1% error), 90% (10% error) under other fixed conditions. True God has no error at all in the light of 1 john 4:6, "We are of God. He who knows God hears us; he who is not of God does not hear us. By this we know the spirit of truth and the spirit of error." For example, a big bang theory is the theory or hypothesis to prove the big bang for the beginning of cosmos at a certain time, which means it has not been proved. The certain time is described in the Scripture as "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. <sup>2</sup> The earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters" (Genesis 1:1-2). Nobody is allowed to alter the Scripture by God in the light of Deuteronomy 4:2, "You shall not add to the word which I command you, nor take from it, that you may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you." although believers in history alleged the earth as flat, the scripture states "the circle of earth" in Isaiah 40:22.
