- Q1. In Isaiah 9:6, "For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace," what does it mean? And how can we apply it to our lives?
- Q2. In Isaiah 28: 26 & 29, "²⁶ For He instructs him in right judgment, His God teaches him," and "²⁹ This also comes from the LORD of hosts, *Who* is wonderful in counsel *and* excellent in guidance," what do these verses mean in this context? And what can we learn from here?
- Q3. How has His Counsel been done to Calvary Chapel Anaheim Hills (CCAH) the global church (His sheep), in the light of Paul's last words to Timothy before his martyrdom, and to each one of us individually on this 2022 Christmas day?

(Background)

Without Jesus, everybody's life would be hopeless because our physical life is not forever. Without Jesus, Christmas would be meaningless because Christmas is Jesus' birthday. We know that God created everybody equally in His image. In 2022, over 8 billion people live on the earth. Over 2 billion people are Christians, while over 5 billion people are still Non-Christians. About 4 billion people earn less than \$6 per day. The majority people of the world are literally struggling for daily bread. How about the lost sheep, eternally lost sheep the over 5 billion, more than double of saved sheep, the over 2 billion sheep?

Now we are seeing specially what's His counsel to this global church, CCAH, and to each of us individually, on 2022 Christmas day.

He was descended from David's lineage and His attributes are wonderful, counselor, mighty God, everlasting Father in whom He is, and Prince of Peace – the Ruler of Peace – because of the peace only in Jesus, not the tribulation in the world. *Isaiah 7:14; John 1:1-5, 14; John 8:12; Luke 2:7, Luke 1:32, John 3:16, John 6:38-39; John 14:10; John 16:33*¹)

25:1 = You are my God.... exalt You...praise Your name.... wonderful things.... Your counsels of old ... faithfulness and truth (Isaiah the prophet is calling the Lord as his God, as well as each believer can call; he lifts up, honors, praises, or worships Him and His name. His counsels to bring His words of old to us in diversities of operations such as prophecy, promise, law, testimony, way, precept, judgment, word, commandment, statute, etc – see Psalm 119. He has kept faithfully His words which are true. 1 Cor 12:6; Ps 119:1,176²)

28:26=Q2 in right judgment [to discretion]; His God teaches him (God instructs/ teaches/ counsels/ guides/directs individually, giving a specific talent to each of us properly -- not to a group of us in lump improperly; God's revelation can be divided with the 3 types in the sight of the Scripture –(1) General revelation – God generally reveals Himself to everyone through His creatures (Rom 1:20); (2) Special revelation – God specially reveals Himself to His own special people or every Christian through All Scripture (1 Peter 2:9; 2 Timothy 3:16-17); and (3) Individual revelation – God reveals Himself differently to each individual Christian in order to profit all the body of Christ (1 Cor 12:4-7³).)

2 Timothy 3:16-4:5

3:16 All Scripture *is* given by inspiration of God, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, ¹⁷ that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work.

4:1 I charge *you* therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and

27= black cummin [fitches]...not threshed....a threshing sledge...a cart wheel....But....with a stick (the black cummnin or fitches are small sized incense seeds, smaller than the cummin. So that the cummins are threshed properly with a stick to the black cummin and with a rod to the cumin differently, not a threshing sledge nor a car wheel improperly; We can observe God's proper counsel/ guidance to each individual believer)

28= Bread flour [Bread corn] must be ground..... not thresh it forever....break...with his cartwheel...crush it with his horsemen (To make bread flour, the threshed – not forever -- corn, wheat, or barley must be ground, not broken with cartwheel, nor crushed with horse; it's observed that different ways are suitable to different individuals)

29=Q2 This.... comes from the Lord of hosts ...wonderful in counsel...excellent in guidance [in working] (This proper guidance/counsel comes from the Lord. Because He is wonderful and excellent, His counsel is wonderful and His guidance is excellent; And so, every believer should be guided and counseled by the Lord, i.e., not according to the flesh will for self-interests but according to God's will, plan, or purpose for His kingdom, His righteousness, or His glory; Now think the end of the path of each our life - Have I done God's will? Have I brought forth much fruit? Is God pleased and satisfied with me like Jeremiah or Paul? At the time to meet the Lord in heaven. God may call me "Good and faithful servant" - that's successful life in eternity, not in vanity: If I never sowed eternal value things or spiritual things, or I spent my whole life time for myself, such as my self- interests of money, power, glory, entertainment, or success, those things would be burned out at that time, like withering grass or fading flower. That's wasted life which God doesn't recognize. How Tragic I would be indeed! Galatians 6:8; Matthew 25:21; John 15:8; Jer 20:9; 2 Tim 4:8⁴);)

Q3= How has His Counsel been done to CCAH (His sheep), in the light of Paul's last words to Timothy before his martyrdom, and to each one of us individually on this 2022 Christmas day? (His sheep at CCAH have been nourished from His whole counsel through co-ministers who preach, convince, rebuke, exhort, and teach with all long suffering, wherever the Spirit leads – Anaheim Hills, West Anaheim, Norwalk, Riverside, Moreno Valley, Hemet, and Social Media – for the people in community, the addicted, homeless, seniors, and the needy; Also social media sheep through online, YouTube, and books published by CCAH PRESS® have been nourished from the same Counsel of God. We don't see them but it

⁴ *Galatians 6:8* For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life; *Matthew 25:21* His lord said to him, 'Well *done*, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. His kingdom: ² <u>Preach</u> the word! Be ready in season *and* out of season. <u>Convince</u>, <u>rebuke</u>, <u>exhort</u>, <u>with all longsuffering</u> and <u>teaching</u>. ³ For the time will come when they will <u>not endure sound doctrine</u>, but according to their own desires, *because* they have <u>itching ears</u>, they will heap up <u>for themselves</u> <u>teachers</u>; ⁴ and they will <u>turn their ears away from the truth</u>, and be turned aside to fables. ⁵ But you be <u>watchful in all things</u>, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, <u>fulfill your ministry</u>.

doesn't mean they are not there. Truth matters regardless of online, offline, indoor, or outdoor services. Each of us is looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of our faith, for the joy, desiring to be called at the end of life as "Good and Faithful Servant." And future generations would be nourished through the same Word on the published books, filed in US Congress library in the same & one Spirit. Now all other local churches sheep are the one united body of Christ unless they are not against the sound doctrine of Christ. So, on 2022 Christmas day, we as Christians are looking unto Jesus by loving the least one - - about 4 billion people literally struggling for daily food at less than \$6 per day and the over 5 billion lost sheep more than double of saved the over 2 billion sheep; Finally, how about His Counsel of each of us individually on 2022 Christmas Season? (Open Question - See my heart! e.g., God counsels me individually to keep on simply teaching every word of God wherever and whenever the Spirit leads) Heb 12:2; Eph 1:22-23; Mat

Note: Most Christians say the Bible is important, but rarely study every word in the Bible and commit it to the Lord. So, it's better to study it and live accordingly after the Spirit for the Lord (2 Tim 2:15). This online word for global crusade in effect develops from the expositional sermon (KJV), into spiritual transformation in daily love fellowship with the Lord throughout the Bible Study (NKJV) -- *All Scripture Expositional Study from verse by verse Inductive Studies* -- of which application is the Discipleship and Spiritual Formation, closer to the image of Christ. We think that "Any human opinion is not really important rather than what God says. So, the best commentary on the Bible is the Bible per se. But the opinion to make us understand God's Word is acceptable (2 Corinthians 10:5)." Further, for the application, a life or spiritual experience might be helpful to understand how to apply an understood word in the text column, but it is temperately used like Paul, because nobody should think above that actual experience (2 Cor 12:6, Jeremiah 23:28).


