

“Zelophehad’s Daughters” Numbers 27-29 12/28/25

Today, we’d like to see the title of “Zelophehad’s Daughters” in Numbers 27-29. To the souls on this Online Word *through Podcast or YouTube Channel*, on the earth, we’d like to suggest the 3 expositional Questions. (**Maranatha Worship Songs : Videos** _____) (**CCMV | A Ministry of CCAH PRESS® : Music Videos** _____)

“God owns the earth(Ex 19:5); He seeks not money, but love for Him.”

Q1. In 27:7 “The daughters of Zelophehad speak *what is* right; you shall surely give them a possession of inheritance among their father’s brothers, and cause the inheritance of their father to pass to them,” what does it mean in the context? And what can we learn from here?

Q2. In 28:16, “On the fourteenth day of the first month *is* the Passover of the Lord,” what does it mean in the context? And how can we apply it to our lives?

Q3. In 29:35, “On the eighth day you shall have a sacred assembly. You shall do no customary work,” what does it mean in the context? And how can we apply it to our lives?

(Background for context of this text on Daily Bible Reading and Studying Weekly Book Basis)

In the last time, Numbers 26: 64-65, “But among these there was not a man of those who were numbered by Moses and Aaron the priest when they numbered the children of Israel in the Wilderness of Sinai. ⁶⁵ For the Lord had said of them, “They shall surely die in the wilderness.” So there was not left a man of them, except Caleb the son of Jephunneh and Joshua the son of Nun,” The 1st census was taken 40 years earlier, as recorded in Numbers 1. It counted all the Israelite men who were 20 years old and older at that time—those eligible for military service. Over the next 38 years of wandering in the wilderness, that entire generation died, just as God had said against complaining tribes from the 12 spies’ reports. By the time of the 2nd census, not a single man who had been counted in the first one remained alive—except for Joshua and Caleb. Moses was still alive but would not enter the land. This 2nd census marked a new beginning for a new generation. Despite the passing of nearly four decades and the loss of a whole generation, God’s laws and the spiritual foundation of the nation stayed the same and were not lost, broken, or altered, i.e., remained intact. The nation was being prepared once again for the promised land—with a new people, but the same calling and covenant. So, the word of God in which there is God’s laws, commandments, covenant, spiritual structure, etc. endures forever. *Num 14:22-23; 1 Peter 1:22-25; Mat 5:18*

Inductive Explanation in context & syntax

<p>27</p> <p>¹Then came the daughters of Zelophehad the son of Hopher, the son of Gilead, the son of Machir, the son of Manasseh, from the families of Manasseh the son of Joseph; and these <i>were</i> the names of his daughters: Mahlah, Noah, Hoglah, Milcah, and Tirzah. ² And they stood before Moses, before Eleazar the priest, and before the leaders and all the congregation, <i>by</i> the doorway of the tabernacle of meeting, saying: ³“Our father died in the wilderness; but he was not in the company of those who gathered together against the Lord, in company with Korah, but he died in his own sin; and he had no sons. ⁴ Why should the name of our father be removed from among his family because he had no son? Give us a possession among our father's brothers.”</p> <p>⁵ So Moses brought their case before the Lord.</p> <p>⁶ And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying:</p>	<p>27</p> <p>1-11 (The Laws of Inheritance)</p> <p>3= “He died in his own sin” means that he died a natural death, bearing personal guilt. His death came under the same national judgment pronounced on Israel for believing the faithless spies</p> <p>4= Up to this point, Hebrew law granted inheritance rights only to sons. When Zelophehad died without sons, his five daughters came to Moses to request their father's inheritance, arguing that their father's name should not be lost simply because he had no male heirs. This marked an early appeal for justice and equal consideration, showing that the call for equal gender rights is not new but has existed from ancient times.</p> <p>5= This is a powerful example of godly leadership. When an issue arose that God had not directly addressed, Moses did not act on his own judgment but brought the matter before the Lord. He</p>

<p>7 “The daughters of Zelophehad speak <i>what is</i> right; you shall surely give them a possession of inheritance among their father’s brothers, and cause the inheritance of their father to pass to them. 8 And you shall speak to the children of Israel, saying: ‘If a man dies and has no son, then you shall cause his inheritance to pass to his daughter. 9 If he has no daughter, then you shall give his inheritance to his brothers. 10 If he has no brothers, then you shall give his inheritance to his father’s brothers. 11 And if his father has no brothers, then you shall give his inheritance to the relative closest to him in his family, and he shall possess it.’ ” And it shall be to the children of Israel a statute of judgment, just as the Lord commanded Moses.</p> <p>12 Now the Lord said to Moses: “Go up into this Mount Abarim, and see the land which I have given to the children of Israel. 13 And when you have seen it, you also shall be gathered to your people, as Aaron your brother was gathered. 14 For in the Wilderness of Zin, during the strife of the congregation, you rebelled against My command to hallow Me at the waters before their eyes.” (These <i>are</i> the waters of Meribah, at Kadesh in the Wilderness of Zin.)</p> <p>15 Then Moses spoke to the Lord, saying:</p> <p>16 “Let the Lord, the God of the spirits of all flesh, set a man over the congregation,</p>	<p>recognized that God was in charge, and the people knew it as well. Instead of making a quick decision, Moses sought God’s wisdom. How much better our decisions would be if we did the same—bringing difficult matters to the Lord and asking, “What does God say about this?” Therefore, Moses presented their case before the Lord.</p> <p>7-8= Q1 God instructed Moses that if a man died without sons, his inheritance was to pass to his daughters. However, they were required to marry within their own tribe so that the inheritance would remain within the tribal boundaries and preserve the established territorial divisions (<i>Numbers 36:10–12</i>¹).</p> <p>12-23 (The Inauguration of Joshua)</p> <p>14= This is why Moses was not permitted to lead Israel into the Promised Land. In the wilderness of Zin, when the people complained about the lack of water, God commanded Moses to speak to the rock so that it would bring forth water. Instead, Moses rebuked the people in anger, struck the rock twice, and acted in disobedience. Although water flowed, Moses failed to represent God properly and did not honor Him before the people. Because of this, God declared that Moses would not bring the congregation into the land (<i>Numbers 20:8–12</i>²).</p> <p>16= Here Jehovah is called “the God of the spirits of all flesh.” This emphasizes that the true essence of a person is the spirit, not the body/ flesh. The body is a temporary dwelling—a tent—given by God through which the spirit expresses itself and communicates with others. While the body returns to the ground, the spirit is permanent and returns to God who gave it. Thus, He is rightly called the God of the spirits of all humanity.</p>

¹ *Numbers 36:10–12* Just as the Lord commanded Moses, so did the daughters of Zelophehad; ¹¹ for Mahlah, Tirzah, Hoglah, Milcah, and Noah, the daughters of Zelophehad, were married to the sons of their father’s brothers. ¹² They were married into the families of the children of Manasseh the son of Joseph, and their inheritance remained in the tribe of their father’s family.

² *Numbers 20:8–12* “Take the rod; you and your brother Aaron gather the congregation together. Speak to the rock before their eyes, and it will yield its water; thus you shall bring water for them out of the rock, and give drink to the congregation and their animals.” ⁹ So Moses took the rod from before the Lord as He commanded him.

¹⁰ And Moses and Aaron gathered the assembly together before the rock; and he said to them, “Hear now, you rebels! Must we bring water for you out of this rock?” ¹¹ Then Moses lifted his hand and struck the rock twice with his rod; and water came out abundantly, and the congregation and their animals drank.

¹² Then the Lord spoke to Moses and Aaron, “Because you did not believe Me, to hallow Me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore you shall not bring this assembly into the land which I have given them.”

<p>17 who may go out before them and go in before them, who may lead them out and bring them in, that the congregation of the Lord may not be like sheep which have no shepherd.”</p> <p>18 And the Lord said to Moses: “Take Joshua the son of Nun with you, a man in whom <i>is</i> the Spirit, and lay your hand on him;</p> <p>19 set him before Eleazar the priest and before all the congregation, and inaugurate him in their sight. 20 And you shall give <i>some</i> of your authority to him, that all the congregation of the children of Israel may be obedient. 21 He shall stand before Eleazar the priest, who shall inquire before the Lord for him by the judgment of the Urim. At his word they shall go out, and at his word they shall come in, he and all the children of Israel with him—all the congregation.”</p> <p>22 So Moses did as the Lord commanded him. He took Joshua and set him before Eleazar the priest and before all the congregation. 23 And he laid his hands on him and inaugurated him, just as the Lord commanded by the hand of Moses.</p> <p>28</p> <p>1 Now the Lord spoke to Moses, saying,</p> <p>2 “Command the children of Israel, and say to them, ‘My offering, My food for My offerings made by fire as a sweet aroma to Me, you shall be careful to offer to Me at their appointed time.’”</p>	<p>17= Moses asked the Lord to appoint a new leader over the people, and God responded by choosing Joshua. Moses understood that without a godly leader the people would become like sheep without a shepherd—vulnerable and soon scattered. Scripture shows that Israel’s dispersions and captivities came because unfaithful shepherds cared for themselves rather than the flock. This theme is echoed in the prophecy concerning Jesus: “Strike the shepherd, and the sheep will be scattered” (Zechariah 13:7). Knowing his own death was near, Moses pleaded with God to place a faithful shepherd over the people. <i>Zech 13:7</i>³</p> <p>18= Joshua was to be ordained by God, with Moses laying his hands on him as a public act. This symbolized the transfer of leadership in full view of the people, ensuring clarity of authority and preventing any dispute or power struggle after Moses’ death.</p> <p>19= Moses obeyed the Lord by presenting Joshua before Eleazar the priest and the entire congregation, marking a clear transition to a new generation of leadership. Aaron had died, Eleazar now served as high priest, and Moses was nearing his death, so authority was formally passed to Joshua. Joshua and Eleazar were to lead together, as Moses and Aaron had done. As high priest, Eleazar would inquire of the Lord using the Urim and Thummim—a black/white stone. Though the exact method is unknown, God communicated His will through them, and the people sought divine guidance through the priest.</p> <p>28</p> <p>1-8 (Daily Offerings)</p> <p>2= The offerings were to be brought to the Lord every day of the year without fail and presented according to the prescribed rituals under the supervision of the priests. Yet the value of these offerings depended on the heart of the worshiper, for worship without a prepared and thankful heart is meaningless, while worship offered in gratitude delights God.(e.g. God wants your love for God in the offering.)</p>

³ *Zech 13:7* Awake, O sword, against My Shepherd, Against the Man who is My Companion,” Says the Lord of hosts. “Strike the Shepherd, And the sheep will be scattered; Then I will turn My hand against the little ones.

³“And you shall say to them, ‘This *is* the offering made by fire which you shall offer to the Lord: two male lambs in their first year without blemish, day by day, as a regular burnt offering.

⁴ The one lamb you shall offer in the morning, the other lamb you shall offer in the evening, ⁵ and one-tenth of an ephah of fine flour as a grain offering mixed with one-fourth of a hin of pressed oil. ⁶ *It is* a regular burnt offering which was ordained at Mount Sinai for a sweet aroma, an offering made by fire to the Lord. ⁷ And its drink offering *shall be* one-fourth of a hin for each lamb; in a holy *place* you shall pour out the drink to the Lord as an offering. ⁸ The other lamb you shall offer in the evening; as the morning grain offering and its drink offering, you shall offer *it* as an offering made by fire, a sweet aroma to the Lord.

⁹ ‘And on the Sabbath day two lambs in their first year, without blemish, and two-tenths *of an ephah* of fine flour as a grain offering, mixed with oil, with its drink offering— ¹⁰ *this is* the burnt offering for every Sabbath, besides the regular burnt offering with its drink offering.

¹¹ ‘At the beginnings of your months you shall present a burnt offering to the Lord: two young bulls, one ram, and seven lambs in their first year, without blemish; ¹² three-tenths *of an ephah* of fine flour as a grain offering, mixed with oil, for each bull; two-tenths *of an ephah* of fine flour as a grain offering, mixed with oil, for the one ram; ¹³ and one-tenth *of an ephah* of fine flour, mixed with oil, as a grain offering for each lamb, as a burnt offering of sweet aroma, an offering made by fire to the Lord. ¹⁴ Their drink offering shall be half a hin of wine for a bull, one-third of a hin for a ram, and one-fourth of a hin for a lamb; *this is* the burnt offering for each month throughout the months of the year. ¹⁵ Also one kid of the goats as a sin offering to the Lord shall be offered, besides the regular burnt offering and its drink offering.

¹⁶ ‘On the fourteenth day of the first month *is* the Passover of the Lord. ¹⁷ And on the fifteenth day of this month *is* the feast; unleavened bread shall be eaten for seven days. ¹⁸ On the first day *you shall have* a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work. ¹⁹ And you shall present an offering made by fire as a burnt offering to the Lord: two young bulls, one ram, and seven lambs in their first year. Be sure they are without blemish. ²⁰ Their grain offering shall be of fine flour mixed with oil: three-tenths *of an*

4= Every day of the year, two one-year-old lambs were to be offered—one in the morning and one in the evening—accompanied by fine flour mixed with oil as grain offerings, the regular burnt offering for a pleasing aroma to the Lord, and a drink offering poured out to Him. On the Sabbath, two additional lambs were offered, maintaining the daily offerings alongside these special sacrifices.

5= Ephah is 3/5 bushel; 21.12 liters; about 5 gallons; Hin is 1 gallon, 3.79 liters

9-10 (Sabbath Offerings)

9-10= Extra offerings, in addition to the regular daily 2 lambs, were made on the Sabbath because it was a special day of rest and worship, commemorating both creation (Exodus 20:8–11) and Israel’s deliverance from Egypt (Deuteronomy 5:12–15). Its significance naturally called for additional sacrifices. *Ex 20:8-11; Deu 5:12-15⁴*

11-15 (Monthly Offerings)

16-25 (Offerings at Passover)

16=Q2 The Passover lamb was a type of Jesus Christ, which is why it had to be without blemish—symbolizing His sinlessness. As Peter said, we are redeemed not with perishable silver or gold but by the precious blood of Christ, the spotless Lamb. God made Him, who knew no sin, to be sin for us, so that through Him we might become the righteousness of God. And the consequent offerings, in addition to the daily offerings, were to be made

⁴ *Ex 20:8-11* “Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy. ⁹ Six days you shall labor and do all your work, ¹⁰ but the seventh day *is* the Sabbath of the Lord your God. *In it* you shall do no work: you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger who *is* within your gates. ¹¹ For *in* six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that *is* in them, and rested the seventh day. You shall afflict your souls; you shall not do any work. ⁸ You shall present a burnt offering to the Lord as a sweet aroma: one young bull, one ram, <i>and</i> seven lambs in their first</p>	<p>for 7 consecutive days called as the Feast of Unleavened bread. <i>1 Peter 1:18-19</i>⁵</p> <p>26-31 (Offerings at the Feast of Weeks)</p> <p>26= The Feast of Weeks or Pentecost occurred seven Sabbaths, or seven weeks, after Passover, with the following day—the fiftieth day—celebrated as the Feast of Weeks.</p> <p>29</p> <p>1-6 (Offerings at the Feast of Trumpets)</p> <p>1= The seventh month, roughly corresponding to October, included several significant holidays on Israel's calendar. On the first day of the agricultural new year, special offerings were made. Among these were three major feasts—the Feast of Trumpets, the Feast of Tabernacles, and the Day of Atonement—designed to refresh the mind and body and to renew commitment to God.</p> <p>2= On special days, additional offerings included one young bull, one ram, and seven lambs, alongside the two daily lambs. When a holiday coincided with a new moon, the total number of animals offered could become quite large.</p> <p>7-11 (Offerings on the Day of Atonement)</p>

⁵ *1 Peter 1:18-19* knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, *like* silver or gold, from your aimless conduct *received* by tradition from your fathers, ¹⁹ but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

Be sure they are without blemish. ⁹ Their grain offering *shall be of* fine flour mixed with oil: three-tenths *of an ephah* for the bull, two-tenths for the one ram, ¹⁰ and one-tenth for each of the seven lambs; ¹¹ also one kid of the goats as a sin offering, besides the sin offering for atonement, the regular burnt offering with its grain offering, and their drink offerings.

¹² 'On the fifteenth day of the seventh month you shall have a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work, and you shall keep a feast to the Lord seven days. ¹³ You shall present a burnt offering, an offering made by fire as a sweet aroma to the Lord: thirteen young bulls, two rams, *and* fourteen lambs in their first year. They shall be without blemish. ¹⁴ Their grain offering *shall be of* fine flour mixed with oil: three-tenths *of an ephah* for each of the thirteen bulls, two-tenths for each of the two rams, ¹⁵ and one-tenth for each of the fourteen lambs; ¹⁶ also one kid of the goats as a sin offering, besides the regular burnt offering, its grain offering, and its drink offering.

¹⁷ 'On the second day *present* twelve young bulls, two rams, fourteen lambs in their first year without blemish, ¹⁸ and their grain offering and their drink offerings for the bulls, for the rams, and for the lambs, by their number, according to the ordinance; ¹⁹ also one kid of the goats as a sin offering, besides the regular burnt offering with its grain offering, and their drink offerings.

²⁰ 'On the third day *present* eleven bulls, two rams, fourteen lambs in their first year without blemish, ²¹ and their grain offering and their drink offerings for the bulls, for the rams, and for the lambs, by their number, according to the ordinance; ²² also one goat as a sin offering, besides the regular burnt offering, its grain offering, and its drink offering.

²³ 'On the fourth day *present* ten bulls, two rams, *and* fourteen lambs in their first year, without blemish, ²⁴ and their grain offering and their drink offerings for the bulls, for the rams, and for the lambs, by their number, according to the ordinance; ²⁵ also one kid of the goats as a sin offering, besides the regular burnt offering, its grain offering, and its drink offering.

²⁶ 'On the fifth day *present* nine bulls, two rams, *and* fourteen lambs in their first year without blemish, ²⁷ and their grain offering and their drink offerings for the bulls, for the rams, and for the lambs, by their number, according to the ordinance; ²⁸ also one goat as a sin offering, besides the regular burnt offering, its grain offering, and its drink offering.

²⁹ 'On the sixth day *present* eight bulls, two rams, *and* fourteen lambs in their first year without blemish, ³⁰ and their grain offering and their drink offerings for the bulls, for the rams, and for the lambs, by their number, according to the ordinance; ³¹ also one goat as a sin offering, besides the regular burnt offering, its grain offering, and its drink offering.

12-40 (Offerings at the Feast of Tabernacles)

By contrast, the direct will of God reflects His perfect plan: seeking His kingdom first, surrendering daily, living in prayer, meditating on Scripture, and trusting Him for provision. This is illustrated by the example of a father who offers his son milk for health, but the boy insists on drinking cola. The father permits the cola (permissive will), but the milk represents the father's true intention for his son's well-being (direct will). In the same way, Christians who rely on the Spirit instead of human strategies walk in God's direct will. This path leads to lasting joy, eternal fruit, a strong testimony for Christ, and a vibrant church marked by genuine worship and fellowship, as it eagerly awaits the Lord's return. Therefore, let us study Scripture inductively, verse by verse, that we may be conformed to the likeness of Jesus Christ.

Calvary Chapel Anaheim Hills (CAAH), through its publishing arm CCAH PRESS®, is a poor church in materials and in spirit compared to other local churches. Despite this, it is deeply committed to serving not just a community but also those in need, providing free Bibles, food, and support to the most marginalized members of society—including drug addicts, the homeless, the elderly, veterans, and the indigent. Although CCAH does not own or possess a dedicated physical building, it utilizes at least seven different locations out of 15 available places each week to hold services and ministries. Each week, approximately 2,000 people are connected to the church’s work. Beyond its local reach, CCAH connects globally through its mobile apps on Google Play and the Apple App Store. Over the past years, church representatives have traveled to Europe, Latin America, Africa, and Asia. Recently, an online supporter generously donated to sustain the teaching of God’s Word, recognizing that CCAH’s 15 ministers provide verse-by-verse inductive Bible teaching—unlike most local churches, which focus on brief topical messages—while faithfully preaching the gospel of Jesus Christ anytime and anywhere.

Note: The open, connected members of CCAH should not be discouraged by the fact that the church neither owns nor possesses a physical building. This actually frees the fellowship from the burden of mortgage or rental payments tied to maintaining such a property. Instead, we are reminded that we ourselves are the church—not a building—as we gather together in Jesus’ name. At present, the Lord has graciously provided at least seven meeting places among fifteen available each week. And if the Lord desires for CCAH to have a permanent building in the future, He will provide it in His time, for CCAH belongs wholly to Jesus, who is all in all.

“

MY JOB IS TO HELP IRANIAN CHRISTIANS PREPARE TO FACE PERSECUTION

Human rights lawyer and Elam team member Hamid explains how Iranian believers are being equipped to stand firm in the face of persecution. Choosing Christ can carry a high price, but - Hamid says - many believers bravely see imprisonment as an opportunity to share the Gospel.

Hamid, can you share your story with us?

I was born into a devout Muslim family in Iran. As a young man I was passionate about the law and attended university hoping to become a judge. But as I studied, I saw the corruption of the judiciary branch and so became a lawyer instead to try to do good for others. Disillusioned by Islam, I explored other spiritual experiences. Then one of my co-workers introduced me to Jesus and everything changed.

I attended Elam's three-month leadership training and have served the church ever since. I dedicated my life to advocating for human rights and serving those who face persecution in the Iran region. This work made me a target for persecution, so I left Iran with my family. Today, as part of the Elam team, I help fellow Iranian Christians prepare for

What is it like to be a Christian in Iran?

It can be very hard. Conversion from Islam to Christianity is illegal; many believers face arrest, torture, and long prison sentences for their ministry. But this is not a surprise for us. The Bible makes it clear that living for Jesus means facing persecution. The world hates Him, so it hates those who love Him. That doesn't make it easy, but it gives us something to remember and hold onto amid the hardships. That's why spiritual formation in this area is so important.

How do you prepare someone for persecution?

An important foundation is exploring the Biblical perspective on suffering in general and persecution in particular. The practical insight we give the students on best practices for security is important but helping them engage with God's Word has the most enduring impact.

How do you help Iranian Christians overcome fear?

Proverbs 29:25 says: "Fear of man will prove a snare, but whoever trusts in the Lord is kept safe." We study this verse and others to explore fear.


It is our privilege to serve people like Magda and Firouz. We are deeply grateful for your prayers and partnership which have allowed us to do so.



God could deliver him. Ismail said that if God can heal me from this, He is real, and I will follow him and he did.

In one particular battle Ismail was in, his unit was being attacked by 700 Islamic enemy soldiers and his unit had only 100 men. His unit was told to attack even though they were greatly outnumbered, but he said, "Today is Sunday. Let us pray this whole day and seek our God that He will be with us." So, all the soldiers spent the

day in prayer. The next day, Ismail took his artillery gun and fired seven shots; all seven hit critical enemy positions, and within a few minutes, the enemy was in full retreat leaving the area and did not return. The men spent the day giving thanks to the Lord for His deliverance. Ismail was known for many great feats of heroism, once capturing 16 enemy soldiers and three trucks full of military supplies. On another occasion, his position was hit by a surface-to-air missile (SAM) that killed over 100 soldiers and 30 civilians. Once again, Ismail escaped uninjured, and the people said it was because of his relationship with Christ that he was delivered.

I am at the chaplain base as this letter is being written. We sent for Ismail's wife to be brought from the Nuba

Mountains to the base. We will do our best to comfort her in her grief and give her the stipend that we give for each fallen chaplain, which can take care of her for years. Ismail was around 55 years of age and served in the war for 37 years. In his life, he had brought many men and

women to Christ. He had planted a church in a radical Muslim area where the people were some of the most violent, but to this day, his church is still alive with over 200 converted Muslims.


He never knew the comforts of this world but will know great peace throughout eternity, having given his all to protect his people and serve Christ.

I cannot live with myself knowing this is going on, and I am willing to spend the rest of my life protecting and caring for those who do not have the ability to protect and care for themselves.

I have always thought that if I reached an age when I was too old to travel, I would enjoy restoring a classic car. I enjoy watching shows that take an old car that is a wreck and bring it back to life. Truthfully, I would enjoy having a garage with half a dozen cars that I could slowly restore. Watching shows that bring a wreck back to a thing of beauty reminds me of how the Lord takes broken lives and restores them. But I would far more desire to save these children and set up places of refuge for the handicapped and children of all ages, including babies and toddlers. Please understand we plan on starting what does not exist in Ukraine, and when we find children who are being abused by parents, we will not allow it to continue. When the laws of the land do not protect women and children, we, as believers, answer to a higher law, God's law, and will do what is necessary to ensure these children are not harmed by parents or anyone, such as a boyfriend.

In March of last year, we wrote about children who were being sexually abused in Central and South America, and I was truly stunned by how the body of Christ responded. It was far beyond what I ever expected. Because the response was so tremendous, many children are being rescued, but now we need people to come alongside and help us build the infrastructure to save children in Ukraine. You can sign up for a monthly amount of whatever you feel led to give. It could be \$25, \$50, \$75 or \$100. And if you can give far more because of how God has blessed you, we welcome the gift and assure you that these funds will be used solely for this project. I want to let you know that as we begin this project, we cannot send you a biography and photo of a specific child. Once we have children in our care, we will send you information about a child for whom you can pray. So please consider joining us in the rescue of these children.

Hopefully, in time, we will have the ability to facilitate adoptions. It would be my heart's desire that the homes would be a place of love until we can find a family that will care for these children.

Folks, I have some investments that should bring a great return in the next couple of years, and if the Lord blesses I will willingly give it to care for these children.

The Bible says in Psalm 68:5-6 that He is a father to the fatherless and sets the lonely in families.

We will actively seek to follow every lead to find the children who are abandoned and abused. A few years ago, a couple was arrested, and when the police came, they found that the couple had a little girl. When the officers asked her what her name was, she responded, "Stupid." The child had a black eye and deep-purple

WHEN MY HEART IS OVERWHELMED

I have too much to share once again but let me just give you an update on Afghanistan first.

On our Afghanistan operation, we have rescued around 2,700 individuals. During this operation, we raised about \$5.5 million, but we will have spent close to \$6.5 million by the time our last refugees are safely resettled. Brent came to me and asked what I wanted to do when the money had run out, and I told him that we would spend what was needed to get every last person the Lord had entrusted us with to relocate to a safe country. For all of you who have given, thank you, I believe you have touched the heart of God. And I would like to give a special thanks to North Country Chapel for helping to save so many lives. Far Reaching Ministries is in the final stages of shutting down operations in Afghanistan.

In March, Luke, Vicky, and I were at the chaplain refresher course in Ukraine. The time was far better than

I could have imagined. We had brought eight pastors from the U.S., most had been with us the last time men like Pastor Lloyd Pulley, Pastor James Class, and Pastor David Mercer to name a few. The fact that many of us returned had great meaning to the Ukrainians. One of the chaplains said that the last year had been "hell on earth". And when he was traveling with his family, his son said, "Dad, where are we going?" His father replied, "Paradise!" I was told that the Radisson Resort we were staying at, in the Carpathian Mountains, was considered by many Ukrainians to be a once in a lifetime destination. One brother told me that if you had stayed at this resort, you had arrived and were considered to have lived a life worth living. It was a nice hotel, but by U.S. standards it would be considered average. But for our chaplains and their families, these retreats are a great blessing.

After the conference the pastors traveled back to the U.S.,

Second, I want to share an update on our orphanage project in Ukraine. We have found a great location that is even better than the first. It not only has room for an orphanage but future Bible school as well as a chaplain base. The property is seven acres and has a natural waterway. When the owner found out believers from the U.S. wanted to help Ukrainian orphans, he lowered the price from \$180,000 to \$140,000. We have raised the complete amount to purchase the property so that the next phase will be the construction of the first dorm for 100 children. For another \$250,000, we will be able to complete a kitchen and cafeteria, and the new children's dorm. We have already raised the first \$100,000 and only need another \$150,000 to complete the initial phase of



the project. One of the ideas is to build the buildings in an Austrian or German Bavarian style so that the children will grow up in a beautiful home and have many happy memories.



We are also looking for pastors to come to Ukraine to train the chaplains.

The third thing I need to share is that Far Reaching Ministries (FRM) has shipped a container of Bibles into China. We can share no details so as not to hamper future operations.

The fourth thing we must report is the loss of two more chaplains—Chaplain Jacob Wuoi and Chaplain John Ebele. With the death of three more chaplains in the last year, this brings the total to 76 chaplains lost since the beginning of the ministry.



Jacob joined the chaplaincy program in 2019. He fell ill one evening and was gone by morning. Being in South Sudan, he was buried the next day, and whatever took him, we will never know. Jacob had graduated in Class 11 and served for four years before he was summoned home by our Lord Jesus Christ.

Q 1. How many members or offerings are at CCAH?

A 1. People say, "How many people have been saved?" we don't know, but God knows, although we acknowledge that God has arranged over 1,000 units of communities, 7 sober living facilities, over 200 units of veteran community, KJV English & RVR Spanish Scriptures & 200 lunches per week for the homeless, and over a million online visitors (Mat 25:40 "unto one of the least of these"). It doesn't matter. It's something we leave the numbers with God. He knows those that are His and that's the important thing (e.g. David's motive for census in 1 Chro 21:1). Therefore, we don't worry about the numbers of the members and of tithes and offerings because the Lord has given the increase, He has added them to CCAH so far (1 Cor 3:7; Acts 2:47; 2 Sam 24:1-3), not as we have done at all, and CCAH is His own church (souls), the Lord's church, "Jesus is all in all," purchased with His blood (Mat 16:18; 1 Cor 6:20; Acts 20:28). Since His foolishness is wiser than men, such as all men's visions/ plans/ programs (1 Cor 1:25; Zechariah 4:6), and His thoughts unto each soul are more in number than the sand (Psalm 139:17-18), we are just active obedient followers of the Lord, venturing out in faith, "**Let CCAH go, let God.**"

And if you did indeed receive the increase, why do you boast as if you had not received it? (1 Cor 4:7) For we are not, as so many, peddling the word of God; but as of sincerity, but as from God, we speak in the sight of God in Christ (2 Cor 2:17), CCAH continues faithfully in teaching the entire Scripture simply without alteration, fellowship, communion, and prayers, being the witnesses to Christ, powered with the Spirit, in Jerusalem, all Judea, Samaria, and to the end of the earth (Acts 1:8; 2:42, 47). The truth the Word of God matters wherever - offline, indoor, outdoor, online, at sea, or in sky - and whenever - Sunday, Saturday, weekday, every day, this generation time, or the future generation time (John 5:39; 17:17). The truth shall make us free (John 8:32), from where Christ is named, where commercial capitalism is controlling, where territorial boundaries are lined, or where racial, material, or hereditary partiality underscores. Every Christian is exhorted to go to church at any convenient place unless she is against "the principles of doctrine of Christ" (Heb 6:1) because of "one church (Ekklesia) on the earth" (Eph 1:22-23). Touchable over 1,000 souls by offline and foreseeable over 1 million souls by online at CCAH are being fed by the whole counsel of God throughout the Spirit, living by every His word (1 John 2:27; Luke 4:4). CCAH does care about each soul because we believe that everybody is impartially created by God in His image (Gen 1:26) -- regardless of race, gender, age, wealth, or education such as Caucasian, male, youth, rich, Ivy league graduate, or not-- and that the eternal value of each soul is much greater than the value of any material/ temporal/ perishable things on the earth (James 3:17; Mat 16:26). When God leads, God provides (1 Chronicles 22:11). So, we don't seek money because it follows the faith in the almighty Lord by the love of God. Therefore, we never ask people for money, but would offer what we have to the Lord and pray Him to handle the issues (like Andrew rather than Philip in John 6:6-9). Individually, we can discern our each mind before the Lord, as how much love for Him can be observed (1) by the money index to divide willing expenditures to God by total expenditures (Luke 12:34; 21:2-3), as well as (2) by how much the words of God we love (John 1:1). We know that any offering to God without willing mind is not accepted by God (2 Cor 8:12). The public love money especially in capitalism society because without money capitalism would not exist. However, we as Christians should not love money but should know its nature (1 Timothy 6:10). CCAH has been controlled not by money even in the capitalism society but by sovereign almighty God. The foundation of CCAH finance has begun from a homeless person's 2 dime offering to the Lord for CCAH at the Rock Fortress facility. The willing mind part for an offering should always prevail over its money part. An offering box in a church service or a donation button on websites through CCAH is a way to express a donor's love for God by willing donation, the 1st part rather than 2nd money part, according to the Scripture (Mark 12:43; Luke 21:3-4). In fact, the fund raising or the fund seeking is not necessary for CCAH but the Lord seeking is sufficient because God is continually working through His church, CCAH, in Acts 29 (1 Chronicles 28:9; 2 Chronicles 15:1-2). We have spent offerings/donations about 40% for external ministries (for missions in Philippians 4:15-19 & for charity in Matthew 25:40) based upon our faith of "one church (Ekklesia) on the earth" -- the holy universal church, not unholy ecumenical church -- (e.g. 1st Quarter 2014, 43.15%; 4th Quarter 2013, 55.6 %; 3rd Quarter 2013, 20.11%; 2nd Quarter 2013, 55.91%; 1st Quarter, 2013 43.26%; 4th Quarter, 2012 45.57%, etc.), rather than spent them for additional social/cultural/popular internal programs. But about 60% for the internal ministries following the model of the early church in the Book of Acts is spent for sheep to be fed with spiritual food (Galatians 6:6) and for staff (1 Timothy 5:17-18).

CCAHA is **the poor in material and spirit**, but is the rich to give it away for Christ's sake, e.g., about 40% of annual offerings, with the poor hearts in spirit. The Lord is the shepherd of CCAH who is "as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things" (2 Cor 6:10).

ON OUR WAY TO CLASS A WILD ELEPHANT CROSSED THE ROAD. What a sight! Only tourists want to see wild elephants, not so with the locals, as they can be incredibly destructive, in some cases kill humans. On the Thai/Burma border many elephants come from Burma as they often are poached but are protected in Thailand. The Karen still come in numbers into Thailand for similar reasons being displaced and killed by the Burmese military. Pray for these hurting people.

SORROW GREETS US ON THE BORDER. Two horrific accidents occurred days before we arrived. Poor people often travel in the back of pick-up trucks, this was the case and all in the back were thrown out, 4 died (all young people) most hospitalized. They all lived in the Karen community (18 in one truck, 10 in the other). We became part of the pastoral team, visited 3 hospitals, bringing comfort, prayer and some financial assistance (God provided). Next came the memorial services in which the unbelievers present were all able to hear the message of eternal life available to all who put their trust in Jesus.




This mother survived the accident, but her son did not.

Pray for Ukrainians to be Protected from Explosions and for Peace in Christ

Luke and I met with Ukrainian officers in charge of training their chaplains and showed them pictures of our base and training center in South Sudan. We showed them videos of the chaplain silent drill team we use for evangelical outreach. Just like the Marine Corps silent-drill team, our men do a 15-minute drill without any verbal command. The men then share God's Word, and many soldiers get saved. I am not sure if the officers that Luke and I met with are truly saved, but both were very respectful. At the end of our conversation, the senior officer asked how I would motivate his men as their military is very demoralized.




At this moment in our conversation, I knew this was a time to give them something of substance that they could relate to. I said that at the future chaplain training school there would be a large aquarium, and on the bottom, there would be a sunken battleship with the word Moskva on it. I knew that this would be meaningful to them. You see, at one of the worst times in the war with Russia, when it looked as if all might be lost, Ukraine miraculously got two Neptune missiles working. They fired them at the Moskva, the flagship of the Russian fleet while it was in port, and amazingly, they hit the ship. Not wanting to accept defeat, the Russians pulled the ship out to sea and said it had sunk in heavy seas, but truthfully, it was the damage the Ukrainian army inflicted on the ship that sank it. This was the largest ship in the Russian fleet, and nothing like this has happened since the Second World War. I told the officers about the war in South Sudan and said that we refused to surrender when we were outmanned and outgunned but not outfought, and we won the war. The two men laughed and said that we had a great strategy for encouraging the men. Sometimes, men need to be reminded to never give up and never surrender. They need to understand that they have a God given role to protect women and children, even at the cost of one's life. See folks we do not fear men, we fear the Lord. As men we were made for battle; we were made to protect

those that cannot protect themselves. It is important that Luke and I live trusting the Lord so that those around us can see what true faith looks like. This is why we go to the frontlines. Many times, non-believers do not understand why we would go to such dangerous places, but you see this action opens the door to share about the Lord.



I was in Europe when a Russian missile hit a children's hospital and maternity ward in Ukraine, killing mothers and children. One photo, in particular, troubled me.



ONE LONG JOURNEY

When I first met Tirza in Russia, it was probably in 1994. She was from the Dutch office of a sister organization, and I was leading a team into the Russian prisons. At that time, I never thought that she would still be in my life 30 years later. When we met, Tirza spoke six languages and worked harder than any two men on my team. Today, she speaks 12 languages. She began working as an assistant to the director of the Dutch office right out of high school and had always worked for minimum wage so as not to be a burden to the ministry.

She and her husband, Hans, have been married for 37 years, as he likes to say, because they love each other. Hans wrote for a newspaper, and they humbly lived off his salary.

In the early days in Russia, when I traveled from prison to prison, it was hard to find food. I would go for weeks only eating Borsch, a Russian cabbage and beet soup.


And, often, I would only eat twice a day. When I would return to Moscow after each of my trips, I would run to the only McDonald's in the city to find food. Every month, when I would travel, I would lose at least 20 pounds, but it was never a problem; instead, it was a great joy.

I often traveled with Mark Piester, who also worked alongside Tirza in Holland. Mark, an American, had worked for years smuggling Bibles behind the Iron Curtain. He and I would spend days on trains and buses—going from prison to prison sharing Christ—most of the time in the dead of winter. I would stare out the window for hours, looking at the snow drifts and Russian countryside, but I loved every minute. I never felt alone; it was me and the Lord, and I will always remember it as the most enjoyable time of ministry. Vicky knows the look when she sees me in this state. She always says, “What part of the world are you

planning to conquer next?" I respond back and just say, "I am lost in my thoughts, Love." But she smiles back and says, "You might as well tell me." Which makes me smile at how well she knows her husband. Then I tell her what I believe is God's next plan for the ministry.

Once, I got very sick in Russia and could find no medicine, so I traveled to Holland to stay with Tirza and Hans, and they took great care of me. The Dutch climate during winter is always rainy and overcast, but I did not mind because the rainy weather has always been my favorite. I stayed in the third-story attic of Tirza and Hans's home. The attic had been turned into a nice bedroom with a window that I could open at night and listen to the rain. Tirza made great meals to nurse me back to health. When I got better, we rode bicycles to the Dutch office every morning, and we would stop at a bakery on the way to get something warm. The Dutch bakeries are the best in the world!

Tirza and Hans have been close friends of mine ever since. Hans loved American peanut butter, but it was unavailable in their home country 30 years ago. At the time, I worked at a food bank in America, and they would give me whatever food I wanted to give away. Back then, I had no money, but KLM Airlines would allow me to take two 75-pound boxes with me, so I brought Hans 140 pounds of peanut butter—my way of saying thanks to them for their hospitality. Vicky and I just recently visited them on a trip to Europe.



When I told Tirza that we were going to buy her a much-needed car, she spent two days trying to talk me into giving it to other missionaries, but I knew it was God's will for her to have this car. This is why when she calls and says she has a great need, I know it is from the Lord.

Tirza shared with me that in Burma, the Junta Army is attacking and killing the Karen, Karenni, and Kachin Christian people. They bomb schools and kill for no reason. The Burma Army is Buddhist-backed, which dispels the image of Buddhists as being peace-loving. But the game the soldiers love is the rape of Christian women, often in front of their husband. Many women have been raped by as many as 20 men to the point they pass out and wake up naked hours later to find that their husband was killed during the rape.

One commander raped a woman and then told 20 of his men that if they did not also rape her, he would kill them; the men did as ordered. When she was finally released, the woman went home and told her husband what happened. He was not a good man and kicked her out of the house. Because she was in so much despair, she took her own life. How I wish the woman had met

Why does CCAH use an online donation button or donation basket?

1. CCAH is the Lord's Church

Calvary Chapel Anaheim Hills (CCA) belongs to God, as expressed when Jesus told Peter, "I will build My church" (Matthew 16:18). This affirms that CCAH is not a human institution seeking financial gain but a group where followers of Christ gather to worship Him and advance His kingdom. The church's focus is to fulfill God's calling, ministering through the provision and guidance He provides, rather than through conventional fundraising methods or material wealth.

2. The Lord Doesn't Need Money but Your Heart

God, being self-sufficient, does not require human wealth. In Acts 17:25, Paul reminds us that God is not served by human hands, "as though He needed anything," because He gives life and all things. Therefore, offerings, tithes, gifts, or donations are not payments to God but expressions of love, faith, and obedience to His Word. God desires our hearts, and giving is a demonstration of where our heart is with Him. As Jesus taught in Matthew 10:37, loving God above all else—including family and possessions—is essential to being worthy of Him. It is not the amount we give but the love and devotion that accompany our giving.

3. A Donation Basket or Online Donation Button as a Reflection of Your Love for God

In today's world, shaped by capitalism and materialism, money has become central to human life. However, how we allocate our financial resources reflects the priorities of our heart. As Matthew 6:21 states, "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." These tools are not for fundraising but rather to encourage believers to align their financial priorities with their faith, recognizing that where one's money goes often indicates where their heart lies.

Many scholars agree that the King James Version (KJV), based on the Textus Receptus, is one of the most accurate translations. However, it can be difficult to understand for modern readers. Therefore, it is recommended to skim over the New Living Translation (NLT) for a fresh perspective, read the New International Version (NIV) for accessibility, and study the New King James Version (NKJV) to grasp the meaning better. Ultimately, the KJV should be searched and studied for its accuracy to the original texts (Acts 17:11; 2 Timothy 2:15).

AI can serve as an essential tool in this journey, helping us to dive deeper into Scripture. For example, AI tools can analyze and compare different translations, provide historical context, and even offer insights into the original Greek and Hebrew languages. This can greatly enhance our understanding of the Bible and make study more efficient and effective.




Calvary Chapel Trujillo has a great team that wants to get involved in helping these young ladies. What impressed me was that Cory already had top lawyers





In October 2024, we started a construction project in Uganda to build a new Bible school. One of the great things about Africa is that you can do so much for very little. Our existing school in Uganda was built to resemble a castle and sits on a compound that covers about 150-200 square yards. It has two three-story buildings that house 700 children, a kitchen, a dining hall, an administration block, and classrooms. If we had built the same building in the U.S., it would probably cost a fortune, but we were able to construct it for about \$300,000. We built the school to train up future leaders. I tell the community I will most likely be gone in 10-15 years, but this school will serve for years to come.

Now, my heart is to invest in the people training the leaders of the church. I want this new Bible school to house and train up to 200 students and staff. I recently met with Pastor Jerel Hagerman and Pastor Don McClure about registering this facility as a Calvary Bible Institute (CBI). In many African nations, the only training for a pastor is to learn how to listen to a sermon and repeat as much as you can in order to excite your audience. This Bible school will be a year-long resident

program, taking students verse by verse from Genesis to Revelation. We will also give practical ministry training in four areas: evangelical outreach, Children's Ministry, discipleship for adults, and counseling and visitations (spending three months in each module). In addition, students will learn about church government and financial administration, so they will have all the tools and training to build a healthy church family.

The new school will be built to have the look of a true European castle built 500 years ago. The reason this is important is that every nation has places like Cambridge



one mixed martial arts (MMA) fighter in Peru, so he is famous in the nation. He told me that when he started fighting, he did not even have enough money to eat. After training when all the gym broke for a walk, because he did not have any money for food, and he did not want others to know how poor he was. After winning many fights, he started to get sponsors and could buy food and better provide for himself, but he said this was a blessing in disguise because the struggles made him stronger.

Luis' gym is only a block from Calvary Chapel Trujillo, and he was invited to visit one weekend. He met Jesus Christ and received eternal life almost immediately. Soon after, Luis felt the Lord asking him to give up fighting and serve Him, and he obeyed without question. He has completed his first year of Bible school and just started his second. He is not a prideful, aggressive, or loud fighter as one may expect; instead, I saw a brother, humble and committed to serve Christ with all his heart. Cory wants to eventually move him into full-time ministry. The Lord spoke to Vicky and me and told us to give him \$1,000. He later said that his wife had called and was looking for their last four dollars. With the gift they were able to get caught up on all their bills and they are celebrating their fourth anniversary. I believe the Lord wants us to support Luis; I would ask for 10 to 20 people to sponsor him so he can be in full-time ministry.

I want to encourage all of you to invest in others serving the Lord, and I have no doubt you will reap great treasures in heaven. Far Reaching Ministries is involved in multiple clandestine operations to save believers and innocent lives. I have shared in previous newsletters about our work in Afghanistan.

During the Afghanistan evacuation operation, we were contacted by Shannon Spann, a former CIA agent, and she asked us to help extract 28 people who worked for the agency. These were people who had worked for the U.S. government but were left behind. The entire intelligence world was caught by surprise when the withdrawal from Afghanistan was done with no advanced notice. What was done resulted in tens of thousands of men, women, and children being tortured, raped, and brutally murdered. Folks, I do not have any knowledge of the inner workings of the CIA, but I did know what would happen to these people.

During the Vietnam war both the Hmong and Montagnards indigenous people helped the CIA and the 5th Special Forces Group, which are Green Berets trained hard to fight Viet Cong forces. The Hmong and Montagnards were Christians fighting against communism, so they created deep bonds with the U.S. soldiers. When the United States pulled out of Vietnam, our government abandoned them, and they suffered horribly in what is referred to as the forgotten genocide. To others, promises made might not matter, but to me they do.

Darius: trained leader equips new believers with God's Word

Faithful Darius chased a car through the streets of his city to deliver a precious copy of the Bible. As a result, a small group of new believers is now equipped to grow in their faith.

Trained church planter Darius was halted at a red light on his bike one day when something in an adjacent car caught his eye. It was a small cross hanging from the rear-view mirror.

Darius knew this symbol was popular among the increasingly non-Islamic people of Iran and was not necessarily indicative of an active Christian faith. Yet his heart quickened.

In that moment, Darius decided to give the driver of the car the Persian Bible that was stashed in his backpack. This precious Bible was one of only ten that had escaped attention when his home was raided earlier that year by intelligence agents. Darius had spent six weeks in prison following the raid, yet his passion for giving others the Word of God had not been diminished.

As Darius was about to knock on the car window, the light turned green, and the car sped off. Undeterred, Darius gave chase on his bike. As the car stopped at a second red light, Darius was relieved to have caught up. But once more, the lights changed. Darius was starting to give up hope when he saw the car pull over.

Now hot and tired, Darius pulled over too. As he approached, he could see the driver had his head bowed. The driver looked up and lowered the window when Darius knocked. "I want to give you a gift," Darius explained breathlessly. He reached into his bag for the Bible. "This book is about Jesus," he said. "Your cross is a symbol of what He has done for us."

The face of the man - whose name was Farhad - lit up. "Do

you know what I was just doing?" Farhad asked, excitedly. "I was praying because my friends and I became Christians, but we had no idea how to find a Bible!"

Through God's providence and Darius' boldness, Farhad and his friends now have access to the Bible as well as to discipleship and fellowship resources like *Safar* and *Weekly Fellowship*. This group of new believers has been equipped to not only believe the Gospel, but to actively follow Jesus as Lord.

Farhad and his friends are one group out of many that have been equipped with the Bible and other resources to help them grow this year. Please pray for their continued walk with Christ and for Darius as he continues in ministry.




with them, but we had given them \$5,000 once to help feed them. While I could have said they are not my responsibility, I know the heart of the Lord. In the end, 17 Haitians, mostly women and children, were saved, and it cost \$411.76 for each soul. I would hope if my family were in danger and needed help, believers would not let money stop them from helping.

I heard Alistair Begg share that when he met the woman who would be his future wife, she had a bunch of guy friends who were U.S. Marines, and he said they had muscles in places that he did not even have places. It makes us laugh at his humor, but whatever he lacked in physical strength, he seems to have far more in spiritual strength. One of the great things about following Christ is if you are diligently seeking the Lord, you can be used greatly. While the Lord seems to be tasking us with caring for so many, I never lose sight that the Bible says it is the love of God that compels people to repentance, and I do care for people who are lost in darkness.

Often, Vicky tells me she never thought she could be so happy in marriage, and I love taking care of her. But, as believers, I believe that our hearts should have enough room for those who have never felt loved. Getting people to support missionaries in dangerous countries or children is very easy, but few are inclined to support the elderly. Sadly, in Ukraine many abandon their mothers and fathers, dropping them off at a home owned by Pastor Fedor, who cares for those too old to care for themselves. Many want their parents' apartment to start a life with whatever man or woman they are involved with and willingly abandon both mother and father. I want to encourage many of you to join us in caring for people like this. The Bible says as much as you do it unto them it will be done unto you.





The men respected Phillip because he lived what he taught, and they said he was on fire for Christ. During his military service, he rose to the rank of Sergeant Major. Though we believe he died of an illness, we will never truly know what took him.

In the Second World War, when Nazi Germany and the Empire of Japan were defeated, the first groups of men who came home were greeted with great celebrations and parades. By the time the other men, who had to stay after the war ended, came home six months to a year later, the parades and parties were over. They were content with seeing families and friends. For those who fought in the longest-running war in Africa, the men never came home to celebrations because the country had suffered too much from war and genocide, and the general population was traumatized from suffering through so many years of war. But it makes my heart happy to think of the reception that Phillip and Justine received when they stood before the Lord Jesus and the angels and the glory of His heavenly kingdom.

DANGEROUS PLACES PRAY FOR

Nigeria Operations:

On Christmas Eve in 2023, in typical African villages in Plateau State, Nigeria, brothers, sisters, relatives, and friends had arrived from towns and cities near and far away. As preparations were in top gear for the Christmas celebration, out of nowhere came the shout of Allah hu Akbar (God is great). Next, the sounds of AK-47s and other automatic weapons of war suddenly cut short the celebration of joy in the middle of the night.

The attacks on these villages continued throughout the night until dawn. There was no intervention by soldiers or security, so the terrorists had their field day raping, maiming, and killing as they wished. In barely 48 hours, over 200 had been killed in a cluster of villages by radical Islamic militias.

In one of the villages, following the shouts of Allah hu Akbar, about 16 close relatives, including men, women, and children, were either hacked down by double-edged swords or gunned down by AK-47s. Following the sudden massacre, their homes were destroyed and some set on fire. All the relatives were killed except for one survivor—a little girl whose mother managed to hide her just behind a window blind. Her name is Nanpa. Nanpa's father, mother, and four siblings were gruesomely murdered. Miraculously, she did not make a single noise as her father, mother, and siblings were



slaughtered by these very wicked and evil terrorists. The following day, after the terrorists had wreaked their havoc, Nanpa was rescued. When she was picked up, she was soaked from her feet to her shoulders in the blood of her parents and siblings that had flowed to where she was hiding.

Nanpa's story touched many hearts and made many cry. When a head pastor (whom we are supporting to train former Muslims to be followers of Jesus) and his wife visited the IDP camp where Nanpa was, they knew that they had to take her with them. Later, Nanpa was adopted by the pastor and his wife. When they thought the chapter of having more children was closed, God

brought them this little girl. When she was first brought into their home, she would awaken every night in terror, but through love, she has become a happy little girl again.

Far Reaching Ministries has been involved in supporting over 100 former Muslims who have converted to Christianity. Most of them had witnessed Christians be tortured and killed for the name of Christ when they refused to deny their faith. The former Muslims had seen the evil of Islam and murder and wanted nothing to do with it. They also witnessed the love and forgiveness Christians had. After leaving Islam, they were inspired to not only follow Christ but also to be trained to become missionaries. All they asked for was training and \$50 a month so they could eat while sharing their faith. What is even more remarkable was that they wanted to go back to their people, knowing that they could very well suffer torture and death. Some missionaries spoke of an incident that changed everything for them.

One of the Muslim militants, who had been the biggest killer of Christians, had come to Christ. He knew returning to his people would mean death, but he had counted the cost. An extremist told the new Christian that if he did not return to Islam, he would be tortured and skinned alive. But he told the extremist that he would not deny the One who died for him. The new Christian suffered a long, horrible night of torture, but he never wavered. The Muslims who watched said no man could have endured if God had not been with him. This act of torture backfired when over 100 of them converted to Christ after watching this brother sacrifice himself so others might know the Lord. And they have chosen to be willing to suffer the same fate.

South Sudan Operations:

We have lost two more men in South Sudan. One was Samson Ohiede, who was a great brother in the Lord. He had been sent to South Africa to train as a pilot for transport planes and as a fighter pilot. I had known him for at least 20 years, since he was a young man. He was flying passengers into Darfur from the United Arab Emirates, Canada, and the United States. As his plane

that. I may not yet know how to save these women, but I believe the Lord can give us a plan, and with prayer and determination, these women can be freed.

I am pursuing a meeting with members of the Trump administration. The new Syrian president, Ahmad al-Sharaa, desperately wants U.S. sanctions lifted. If America insisted that every abducted woman be returned before sanctions are even considered, I believe we would see quick results.




God may already be opening doors. A former F-35 fighter pilot, now a top-level official and regular guest on Tucker Carlson and Fox News, supports Far Reaching Ministries. I spoke with him, and he is committed to helping. If diplomacy fails, and I have to buy these women's freedom, I will. Please pray with me; I believe in a God who makes a way when there is none.

Since leaving Ukraine, I have committed to praying daily that God would bring an end to Putin's slaughter. For the next 40 days, would you join me personally and pray every evening with your family at dinner?

The suffering is deep and widespread. A female staff member's brother was recently killed at the front, and she and her family are in tremendous pain. Over 70,000 Ukraine soldiers are missing in action, and their wives are waiting in anguish for husbands who may never return because 99% will never be found. Without confirmation




of death, the family receives no compensation for their loved ones. One woman keeps paying her husband's phone bill, calling it daily, hoping he will answer, but he never does.

When a father dies in Ukraine, they say the family dies. Chaplains bring hope, but the weight is crushing. One mother told me her body feels like an open wound, but she goes on only for her children's sake.

In Sudan's Nuba Mountains, once again, the Islamic north is trying to take what is not theirs. Fighting has intensified, and our chaplains are under fire again. I received a video from the frontline—one man's head was gone from the chin up, and another man's body was missing from the waist up. This year alone, we have lost three more chaplains—bringing our total to over 70 who have died in service to Christ. South Sudan continues to suffer; food is scarce, and the need has become critically urgent.

I have been praying about writing a book for Ukrainian soldiers. I would probably call it *Living in the Valley of the Shadow of Death*. Next year, I will have been in South Sudan for 30 years, and I have a wealth of



In the Hope We Will Save a People Group from Extinction

Before you read this newsletter, I want to warn you that what we are sharing is beyond shocking. And if you cannot handle this, then do not read on, then call and complain.

Luke, who served internationally for 33 years, is a former Marine officer and FBI agent in intelligence. His expertise is in counterterrorism, international operations, rapid deployment, and special operations, with SEALs, Raiders, Delta, and Tier One operators. Needless to say, I give Luke difficult and critical operations. One of his key contacts is a Druze man and his family in Israel. When Luke was in the FBI, he had three immersions in the Middle East for both learning Arabic and intelligence to deal with terrorists. One of those immersions was when he met a Druze family. In Israel, the Druze community is a distinct group that neither identifies as Jewish nor Muslim but is allied with Israel and is said to have a

special "Blood-Bond" with the Jewish nation. They are citizens of Israel who serve in the Israeli military and pay taxes. They describe themselves as Muwahadin, coming from the Arabic and Hebrew word meaning as one. They share some roots with Abraham, Moses, and Muhammad, and became a new faith in the eleventh century.

Luke's friend recently sent us a video that was about seven minutes long. Within the first minute, a soldier takes a young man, pushes him to the ground, and cuts his head halfway off. The man who did this was acting as if it were no big deal.



SYRIA RESCUE



Syria is facing an immediate humanitarian crisis with the rise of Hay'at Tahrir al-Sham (HTS) into government power. HTS is a radical Islamic military faction progressing out of al-Qa'ida. Designated as a Terrorist Organization by the U.S., HTS has initiated a violent and widespread campaign against Christians, as well as ethnic cleansing. There are numerous ongoing reports of door-to-door attacks, widespread rape, and mass executions.






Dear Friends and Family,


